carve

to create something by cutting wood or stone; to turn sharply

## immediate

synonym: prompt, quick, instantaneous

## ephemeral

adj. lasting or used for only a short time synonym: temporary, momentary, brief

(1) **ephemeral** joys, (2) **ephemeral** materials His success as a famous actor was **ephemeral**.

#### dominate

to have or control a lot of power and influence over somebody or something

synonym: govern, rule, prevail

(1) **dominate** possession, (2) **dominate** over the weak The perspective of his right brain **dominates** his consciousness.

## economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

*synonym*: finance, trade, business

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

### tweet

 a short, high sound made by a small bird; a message sent using Twitter, the social media application

*synonym*: peep, chirp, post (on Twitter)

## high-profile

adj. attracting much attention and interest from the public and media

synonym: notable, prominent, distinguished

## profit

 money that is earned in business or by selling things after deducting the costs involved

synonym: earnings, gain, proceeds

## neglect

## invention

## government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

## fishery

 an area of water where fish are caught in large quantities for living; a business or practice of catching and selling fish

synonym: fishing, piscary, angling

fishery management, (2) commercial fishery
 The majority of the people on the island are fishery folk.

farmland

- n. land used for farming or agricultural purposessynonym: agriculture, cropland
- farmland acreage, (2) fertile farmland

## deplete

sow

v. to plant seeds in the ground to grow crops or plants; to establish or set in motion

#### harvest

## superpower

## responsible

## quarterly

## glue

- n. a sticky substance used for joining things together; a bonding agent made from animal or synthetic materials

## necessarily

adv. in an essential manner; in such a way as could not be otherwise

## curiosity

- n. a strong desire to know or learn about somethingsynonym: interest, inquisitiveness, novelty

#### reward

*n.* a thing given in acknowledgment of service, hard work, achievement, etc.

## disaster

 an unexpected event or series of events that cause widespread damage, destruction, or loss of life

#### announcement

 a public statement or declaration, often made in writing or through the media, that conveys important information or news

#### motivate

#### hurricane

 a violent, tropical, cyclonic storm of the western North Atlantic, having wind speeds of or over 64 knots (74 miles per hour)

#### dismal

adj. depressing or dreary; causing or showing unhappiness or despair

#### inevitable

## telescope

## captain

## yore

 the line at which the earth's surface and the sky appear to meet; the range of interest or activity that can be anticipated

horizon, creating a beautiful orange and pink hue.

#### distance

n. the amount of space between two points, measured in units such as miles, meters, or kilometers; the extent, scope, or range between two things, such as distance or emotional distance

synonym: space, gap, span

(1) driving distance, (2) social distance

The marathon runner covered a long **distance** in a short amount of time.

crop

a plant that is cultivated in large amounts, particularly for food

*synonym*: output, produce, product

strip

v. to remove the surface from something; (noun) a sizeable narrow piece of something such as paper, metal, cloth, etc., or area of land, sea, etc.

fertile

adj. capable of producing abundant vegetation or crops; intellectually productive

topsoil

anchor

n. a device, typically made of metal, that is used to moor a ship or boat in a particular place, typically by being dropped to the seabed; a central cohesive source of support and stability

### erosion

the wearing away of rock, soil, or land by natural processes such as wind or water

yield

synonym: proceeds, harvest, output

cereal

 a type of grain used for food, such as wheat, oats, or corn that is typically ground into flour, cooked into porridge, or used to make breakfast cereals

synonym: grain, oatmeal, breakfast food

(1) cereal grain, (2) cold cerealI always start my morning with a bowl of cereal.

reap

 to harvest a grain crop from a field; to obtain something beneficial as a consequence of something that you have done

synonym: collect, harvest, derive

(1) **reap** the benefits, (2) **reap** crops
He **reaped** a significant profit from the listing of his company's stock.

#### tried-and-true

adj. proven or tested through experience or practice; established as reliable or effective over time; often used to describe methods, techniques, or products that are known to work well

*synonym*: proven, reliable, trustworthy

## strategy

n. a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

Our plan includes a comprehensive marketing **strategy**.

#### carver

 a person who carves, cuts, or sculpts wood, stone, or other materials; a tool or instrument used for cutting or carving

synonym: sculptor, engraver, cutter

The statue was created using a chisel and a skilled **carver's** hands.

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data

## peanut

 a type of legume that grows underground and is widely cultivated and consumed as a food source

synonym: nut, groundnut, earthnut

## recipe

a set of instructions for preparing a dish, including the ingredients and the method of cooking

## tsunami
