### royal

adj. relating to or belonging to the king or queen or a member of their family

### coronation

#### thunderous

adj. producing or accompanied by a loud, deep, rumbling sound, like that of thunder; intense, forceful, or impressive

synonym: thundering, booming, loud

The **thunderous** applause lasted for several minutes after the performance.

# applause

 a demonstration of approval or praise by clapping the hands together

*synonym*: clapping, cheering, acclaim

(1) round of **applause**, (2) earn **applause**The **applause** burst from the audience.

ornate

*adj.* elaborately or excessively decorated *synonym*: decorative, elaborate, fancy

- (1) **ornate** ceiling, (2) depicted in **ornate** detail. She wore an **ornate** necklace to the formal event.
- a circular ornamental headdress, worn as a symbol of authority by a king, usually made of gold and precious stones

synonym: tiara, headdress, royalty

- (1) the imperial **crown**, (2) the **crown** and throne The bishop bestowed the golden **crown** on the king.
- a ceremonial staff or rod that represents authority or power, often carried by monarchs or other high-ranking officials; a symbol of royalty or sovereignty

synonym: royal staff, staff, wand

- (1) hold a **scepter**, (2) royal **scepter**The royal palace had a room designed to store the king's **scepter** and crown jewels.
- v. to go or move upward; to become king or queen; to inherit something, such as a power

synonym: rise, climb, go up

- (1) **ascend** the ladder, (2) **ascend** to power The plane began to **ascend** into the sky.
- a chair or seat of state for a monarch or other high-ranking person; the position of being a king or queen

*synonym*: seat, throne, chair

(1) abdicate the **throne**, (2) imperial **throne**The king sat on his **throne**, surveying his kingdom.

# towering

- adj. very tall or high, often to an impressive or intimidating degree; powerful or dominant in influence or staturesynonym: lofty, tall, excessive
- (1) **towering** trees, (2) **towering** mountain

  The **towering** skyscraper blocked out the sun on the street below.

#### cheer

- v. to give a loud shout to show support, praise, or approval synonym: comfort, encourage, hearten
- (1) **cheer** for the home team, (2) **cheer** me up Supporters in the stands **cheered** at every goal.

#### onlooker

- n. a person who watches an event or situation without directly participating, often as a spectator or bystander synonym: bystander, spectator, watcher
- (1) curious **onlooker**, (2) spectating **onlooker**Many **onlookers** gathered at the beach to witness the rare sea turtle hatching.

#### enslave

v. to make someone a slave; to deprive someone of their freedom of choice or action

synonym: coerce, deprive, imprison

(1) **enslave** poor peasants, (2) **enslave** indigenous people Her beauty **enslaved** me completely.

# accompany

- v. to go somewhere or travel with someone or something synonym: follow, escort, attend
- (1) **accompany** a chicken dish, (2) **accompany** the book Please let me know if you want to **accompany** me to my hometown.

aid

 things sent to help countries in need, notably food or money; support

synonym: helper, resource, assistance

(1) financial **aid**, (2) country-by-country **aid** programs Pakistan's **aid** budget was still being reviewed.

### revolutionary

adj. relating to or characterized by a complete or dramatic change

synonym: radical, innovative, groundbreaking

(1) **revolutionary** change, (2) enforce **revolutionary** justice The **revolutionary** leader inspired others to join the fight for freedom and democracy.

#### savannah

n. a mixed forest and grassland ecosystem where the trees are far enough apart that the canopy doesn't closesynonym: grassland, plain

(1) **savannah** region, (2) tropical **savannah**The birds live in tropical forests, **savannahs**, and arid semi-desert environments.

# prolong

v. to extend the duration or length of something, particularly a period of time or an event

synonym: extend, lengthen, stretch

(1) **prolong** the agony, (2) measures to **prolong** the lifespan

We need to **prolong** the meeting for another hour to discuss all the issues.

# siege

n. the surrounding of a place and isolating it by an army to defeat those defending it

synonym: blockade, encirclement, barricade

(1) hostage siege,(2) lay siege to his housePeople began storing up food and supplies for the siege.

#### encounter

v. to face something, particularly something unpleasant or difficult, while attempting to do something else; to meet, especially unexpectedly

synonym: meet, run into, come across

(1) **encounter** a crisis, (2) **encounter** a storm I'm prepared to **encounter** challenges throughout this adventure.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a violent crime, (2) violent incident

The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

#### revolution

a large-scale attempt to overthrow the government of a country, often using violence or war;

synonym: coup, innovation, rebellion

(1) beginning of the industrial **revolution**, (2) a political **revolution** 

The **revolution** by the citizen resulted in a redistribution of wealth.

#### survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

# immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately** 

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

#### mason

 a skilled worker who builds structures with stone, brick, or concrete

synonym: bricklayer, stonemason, masonry worker

(1) mason jar, (2) the craft of a mason

The accomplished **mason** expertly crafted the stone walls of the castle.

### colony

 a country or an area that is governed by a more powerful country that is often far away

*synonym*: settlement, territory, plantation

(1) plant a **colony**, (2) a **colony** of bacteria The **colony** declared its independence and became a republic.

#### slave

 a person who is, either legally or illegally, owned by someone; a person entirely dominated by some influence or a person

synonym: captive, bondservant, hard worker

(1) a **slave** of drink, (2) a **slave** trader

You should work hard but not be a **slave** to it.

### rebellion

 an act of violent or open resistance to an established government or ruler

synonym: insurrection, uprising, revolt

(1) **rebellion** leader, (2) excite **rebellion** 

The antigovernment **rebellion** was put down quickly by the government's military forces.

# opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

rebel

 someone who resists or opposes authority or control, especially by fighting against it

synonym: insurgent, dissenter, mutineer

(1) rebel uprising, (2) group of rebels

The **rebels** fought against the government for their independence.

### span

 the entire length of something, such as time or space from beginning to end; the amount of space that something covers

synonym: interval, period, length

(1) the **span** of a bird's wings, (2) the average life **span** 

He slightly modified the **span** of training because it was just before a match.

#### rank

 a position in a hierarchy of status or authority; (verb) to take or have a position relative to others

synonym: position, status, standing

(1) rank amateur, (2) high rank

He was promoted to the **rank** of captain in the military.

#### liberate

v. to set free; to release or rescue from captivity or oppression

synonym: emancipate, release, set free

(1) **liberate** people from oppression, (2) **liberate** potential The prisoners were **liberated** after the war ended.

### autonomous

*adj.* capable of governing or controlling its affairs *synonym*: independent, self-governing, self-reliant

(1) development of **autonomous** vehicles, (2) an **autonomous** judiciary

Five of the six provinces will become **autonomous** regions under the new federal system of government.

#### assume

 to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

### slavery

 the practice or system of owning, buying, and selling people as property and forcing them to work

synonym: bondage, servitude, enslavement

(1) slavery labor, (2) institution of slavery

The abolition of **slavery** in the United States was a major

achievement in the fight for human rights.

# empire

- n. a group of countries ruled by one leader or government synonym: imperium, conglomerate, kingdom
- (1) **empire** building, (2) **empire** of the Maya He has built a thriving e-commerce **empire**.

# attempt

 an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt** 

The third attempt was far more successful.

#### reinstate

 to restore or bring back to a previous position, status, or condition; to return someone to a former job or position which they previously held

synonym: restore, bring back, revive

(1) **reinstate** a policy, (2) **reinstate** a team member The boss decided to **reinstate** the recently fired employee after realizing their mistake.

### fierce

*adj.* severe and violent in a way that is frightening *synonym*: ferocious, convulsive, forceful

(1) **fierce** competition, (2) a **fierce** animal The **fierce** thunders echoed across the plain.

### resistance

 the act of defending oneself from an aggressor or refusing to accept something

synonym: opposition, antagonism, defiance

(1) **resistance** movement, (2) **resistance** to insulin The bill to increase the consumption tax had passed despite much **resistance** from the public.

# military

adj. relating to or characteristic of members of the armed forces; of or relating to war or warfare

synonym: armed, martial, warlike

(1) a **military** operation, (2) a **military** leader

The **military** academy was known for its strict discipline and training.

# occupation

*n.* a person's job or profession; the act of taking possession

*synonym*: job, profession, vocation

(1) occupation disease, (2) occupation of a building

The police stopped the suspicious person and asked him to give his name, address, and **occupation**.

### outbreak

 a sudden start of something, usually a disease or something dangerous or unpleasant

synonym: eruption, outburst, explosion

(1) infectious disease **outbreaks**, (2) the **outbreak** of hostilities

The government predicts an epidemic **outbreak** of multiple viruses, including coronaviruses and influenza.

#### withdraw

 to remove or take back something; to stop participating in something

synonym: retract, remove, back out

(1) withdraw from public life, (2) withdraw \$500 from my account

The company decided to **withdraw** its proposal due to public opposition.

# casualty

 a person who has been killed or injured in a war, accident, or other disasters; a victim

synonym: victim, injured, fatality

(1) civilian casualty, (2) military casualty

Unfortunately, the driver was the only **casualty** in the car accident.

# capture

v. to catch a person or an animal and confine them in an area which they cannot escape

synonym:

catch, arrest, imprison

(1) **capture** a glimpse, (2) **capture** customers' hearts I was able to **capture** the moment on film.

# prominent

*adj.* important, well-known, or noticeable *synonym*: notable, distinguished, prominent

(1) prominent figure, (2) play a prominent roleThe media frequently interviewed prominent scientists.

# government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

synonym: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

# proclaim

- v. to announce or state something publicly and forcefully synonym: announce, declare, trumpet
- (1) proclaim victory, (2) proclaim law

The leader **proclaimed** a state of emergency in the country.

# emperor

- n. the male ruler of an empiresynonym: ruler, king, dictator
- (1) **emperor** of Rome, (2) former **emperor** The **Emperor** once lived in the vast palace.

# independence

- n. freedom from another's or others' control or influencesynonym: freedom, liberty, autonomy
- (1) financial **independence**, (2) **independence** ceremony There is nothing more valuable than **independence** and freedom.

#### desire

- n. a strong feeling of wanting to have or do somethingsynonym: ambition, appetite, greed
- (1) unsatisfied desire, (2) fleshly desire

Low sexual **desire** typically correlates with low testosterone levels.

#### exclusive

adj. not divided or shared with others synonym: sole, deluxe, limited

(1) **exclusive** authority, (2) **exclusive** clubs

The condo offers **exclusive** access to the beach.

#### alienated

- adj. feeling isolated, estranged, or disconnected from others, often due to a sense of difference or lack of belongingsynonym: isolated, estranged, disconnected
- (1) **alienated** from my parents, (2) become **alienated**The new employee felt **alienated** from the rest of the team, as they didn't try to include him in their conversations.

# eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

incite

v. to encourage, stir up, or provoke someone to do something; to urge, instigate, or stimulate someone to take action, often negative or aggressive

synonym: provoke, stimulate, encourage

(1) incite violence, (2) incite rebellion

The politician's speech seemed designed to **incite** anger and unrest among the crowd.

# conspiracy

 a secret agreement between two or more people to perform something harmful or illegal

synonym: plot, collaboration, scheme

(1) political **conspiracy**, (2) **conspiracy** theory

There was a **conspiracy** of silence about Illegal police interrogation.

#### assassination

n. the act of killing a public figure, especially a political leader, usually for political or religious motives

*synonym*: murder, killing, execution

(1) failed **assassination** attempt, (2) **assassination** plot The **assassination** of the president sent shockwaves through the nation.

### subsequent

*adj.* happening or occurring later or after something else *synonym*: later, following, ensuing

(1) over **subsequent** months, (2) reduce **subsequent** mortality

In the **subsequent** meeting, the team discussed ways to improve productivity.

# struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not struggle against temptation.

# split

v. to divide, or to make something divide into two or more parts, especially along a particular line

synonym: break, divide, break apart

(1) **split** a bill, (2) **split** a reward equally

Companies often **split** their shares to lower the stock price and encourage investors to buy.

### govern

 to legally control and direct a country, city, group of people, etc. and be responsible for introducing new laws, organizing and maintaining public services

synonym: control, rule, preside

(1) a nation's right to **govern**, (2) **govern** a public enterprise The regulations **governing** medical malpractice claims are rigorous.

### president

n. the leader of a republic, for example, the US; the person in charge of the organization such as a company, university, club, etc.

synonym: leader, CEO, chairperson

president emeritus, (2) vice- president for finance
 The club president does not have absolute power.

# democracy

 a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

*synonym*: self-government, republic, commonwealth

(1) **democracy** advocate, (2) principles of **democracy Democracy** often entails inclusive capitalism as well.

# republic

 a state or country in which the people and their elected representatives hold supreme power and which has an elected or nominated president rather than a monarch

synonym: democracy, federation, commonwealth

(1) **republic** democracy, (2) the **republic** of art The United States is a federal presidential constitutional **republic**.

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

#### colonial

adj. of or relating to a colony (= a territory that is controlled by a more powerful country); to the period of time during which a country or region was a colony

synonym: imperial, immigrant, gregarious

(1) oppressive **colonial** rule, (2) **colonial** style The city has a rich **colonial** history, with many historic buildings and landmarks.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) **nation-state**, (2) a seafaring **nation** 

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

# policy

n. a set of rules, guidelines, principles, or procedures that govern decision-making or action, often used in the context of business or government; a course of action or plan of action adopted or followed by an organization or individual to achieve a goal or objective

synonym: strategy, plan, guideline

(1) health **policy**, (2) foreign **policy** 

The company's new **policy** on remote work has made it a more inclusive workplace.

### endear

 to make someone loved or appreciated or to cause someone to feel fondness or affection for someone or something

synonym: fondle, cherish, love

(1) **endear** a character to young readers, (2) **endear** to everyone

The baby's smile **endeared** her to everyone who saw her.

# economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

(1) economy of scale, (2) economy class

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

#### converse

v. to talk informally

synonym: discourse, discuss, exchange

(1) **converse** with an acquaintance, (2) ask a **converse** question

She enjoyed the opportunity to **converse** with a person who spoke her language.

# aggressive

adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quickly

synonym: assertive, combative, threatening

(1) an **aggressive** war, (2) an **aggressive** tumor An **aggressive** tide wrecked the ship.

#### redistribute

- v. to share something among people in a different way synonym: rearrange, readjust, reconstruct
- (1) **redistribute** income fairly, (2) **redistribute** data

  The general **redistributed** the troops more strategically.

#### retain

- v. to keep or continue to possess or maintain something synonym: possess, hold, keep on
- retain information, (2) retain a lawyer
   Computers help people retain specific memories.

# agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

synonym: farming, husbandry, agribusiness

organic agriculture,
 intensive agriculture
 Agriculture is the foundation of our economy.

# pledge

- v. to make a formal promise to give or do something synonym: promise, assure, guarantee
- (1) **pledge** my fidelity, (2) **pledge** military assistance At this ceremony, We will **pledge** allegiance to the country's flag.

#### interference

n. the act or process of getting involved in and trying to influence a specific situation; the state of being affected and influenced with

synonym: obstruction, hindrance, impedance

(1) officious **interference**, (2) **interference** wave Unfortunately, the radio **interference** made it difficult to hear the broadcast.

#### massive

adj. enormous amount; very heavy and solid synonym: enormous, giant, immense

(1) **massive** amounts, (2) **massive** stars

The recent economic downturn has resulted in **massive** layoffs.

### citadel

 a fortress, typically on high ground, used to protect and defend a city, town, or other strategic location

synonym: fortress, stronghold, bastion

(1) medieval citadel, (2) fortress citadel

The ancient **citadel** provided a vantage point for soldiers to watch over the city.

#### invade

v. to enter aggressively into another's territory by military force for conquest and occupation

synonym: intrude, raid, overrun

(1) **invade** other tissues, (2) **invade** his privacy. I have no intention to **invade** your privacy.

### accomplish

 $\nu$ . to finish or achieve something successfully

synonym: achieve, complete, execute

(1) **accomplish** a goal, (2) **accomplish** military operations Humankind took centuries to **accomplish** true democracy.

# institute

 an organization that has a specific purpose, particularly one dealing with science, education, or a particular profession; (verb) to initiate, introduce, or establish something

synonym: academy, university, college

(1) institute a lawsuit, (2) research institutes

This region has many **institutes** offering higher education.

# mandatory

adj. required by a rule or law, compulsory synonym: compulsory, obligatory, required

(1) a mandatory clause, (2) mandatory training

Attendance at the meeting is **mandatory** for all employees.

### labor

n. productive work, especially physical work done for wages; the people who do manual or physical work in a country or company for wage; (verb) to work hard or to strive and make an effort to reach a goal

synonym: toil, moil, donkeywork

(1) seasonal labor, (2) manual labor

In several countries, child **labor** is a serious social problem.

# strengthen

v. to become stronger or more effective; to make someone or something stronger or more effective

synonym: reinforce, harden, boost

(1) **strengthen** the immune system, (2) **strengthen** a border patrol

Difficulties **strengthen** the mind, as labor does the body.

# reign

- n. the period of time during which a monarch or government holds power; (verb) to be the king or queensynonym: rule, governance, sovereignty
- (1) reign of a dictator, (2) reign as sovereign

The dictator's **reign** was characterized by widespread human rights abuses and suppression of political opposition.

# elegant

adj. pleasing and graceful in appearance or manner, or showing good taste and refinementsynonym: refined, sophisticated, graceful

(1) **elegant** design, (2) write **elegant** sentences She wore an **elegant** evening gown to the gala.

### palace

 the residence of a high-ranking official such as a king, queen, etc.

synonym: mansion, manor, castle

(1) a palace garden, (2) ancestral palace

The imperial **palace** is currently undergoing reforms.

# kingdom

the country ruled by a king or queen

synonym: empire, realm, land

(1) establish his **kingdom**, (2) a subordinate **kingdom** 

By remaining neutral, this **kingdom** continued to exist.

### oversee

v. to watch and direct someone or something to make sure that it is being done correctly

synonym: manage, command, supervise

(1) **oversee** the process, (2) properly **oversee** the staff A committee was appointed to **oversee** a huge budget.

# develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) industrious worker, (2) industrious student

He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

### renowned

adj. famous and respected for great achievements, qualities, etc.

synonym: noted, prominent, acclaimed

(1) a **renowned** artist, (2) **renowned** as a novelist

This area is **renowned** for its hot springs.

# initially

adv. at the beginning; at first synonym: originally, primarily, firstly

(1) **initially** anticipated, (2) diagnosed **initially** as a tumor This train departed later than **initially** scheduled.

### mandate

- n. an official or authoritative instruction or command; a commission or authority to carry out a particular tasksynonym: command, instruction, authority
- (1) **mandate** obligation, (2) an Imperial **mandate**The **mandate** given to the new government is to improve the economy.

### uncomfortable

adj. providing or feeling physical discomfort or slight pain synonym: comfortless, discomforting, painful

(1) an **uncomfortable** silence, (2) with an **uncomfortable** face

His abusive words made me uncomfortable.

# destroy

v. to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

synonym: demolish, ruin, obliterate

destroy the ecosystem, (2) destroyed evidence
 The building was destroyed in the fire and had to be rebuilt.

# increasingly

adv. more and more

synonym: more and more, progressively

(1) **increasingly** become common, (2) face **increasingly** complicated challenges

Our company found it **increasingly** difficult to keep up with the competition.

### authoritarian

 adj. characterized by strict, absolute control and obedience to authority or rules; dictatorial and lacking in personal freedoms or individual rights

synonym:

# dictatorial, totalitarian, despotic

(1) **authoritarian** practice, (2) **authoritarian** government The **authoritarian** leadership style left no room for dissent or alternative opinions.

# opponent

a person against whom you are playing or fighting in a game, competition, debate, etc.

*synonym*: adversary, competitor, enemy

(1) computer **opponent**, (2) death-penalty **opponent** He was attempting to confuse his **opponent**.

# strength

 the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

synonym: resilience, power, muscles

(1) **strength** of the economy, (2) muscular **strength** Health and **strength** are, above all, gold.

# tragic

adj. causing great sadness or suffering; very unfortunatesynonym: calamitous, disastrous, catastrophic

tragic love stories, (2) tragic death
 tragic events of the war left many families torn apart.

#### conclude

v. to come to an end or close; to reach a judgment or opinion by reasoning

synonym: complete, finish, decide

(1) **conclude** a meeting, (2) **conclude** that he is healthy We **concluded** a cease-fire.

# debilitating

adj. weakening or damaging; causing a loss of strength, energy, or success

synonym: weakening, exhausting

(1) **debilitating** virus, (2) **debilitating** effect His **debilitating** illness made it difficult for him to leave the house.

#### stroke

 a medical condition in which poor blood flow to the brain causes cell death; the act of swinging or striking at a ball with a club, racket, etc.

synonym: blow

(1) suffer **stroke**, (2) a **stroke** of the putter

This year's extreme heat has resulted in many heat **stroke** cases.

#### defect

*n.* an imperfection, shortcoming, or lack of something or someone

synonym: fault, blemish, flaw

(1) visual **defects**, (2) **defects** of character

**Defects** in the design could cause much worse issues.

# despondent

adj. in low spirits; feeling or showing extreme discouragement or gloom

synonym: hopeless, despairing, discouraged

(1) feel despondent, (2) a despondent mood

After her dog passed away, she was **despondent** for weeks, unable to find joy.
