armpit

This stick will deodorize your **armpits**.

dung

n. solid waste from animals, especially from large animals such as cattle and horses; (verb) to fertilize or dress with animals' excrement
synonym: excrement, droppings, manure
(1) ball of **dung**, (2) **dung** the land
You can see the horse **dung** on the country road.

cowhand

n. a person who works on a ranch or farm and is responsible for herding and caring for cows or other livestock, also known as a cowboy or cowgirl
synonym: cowboy, rancher, cattle driver
(1) **cowhand** hat, (2) hardworking **cowhand**
A skilled **cowhand** can recognize signs of distress or disease in the herd quickly.

applause

n. a demonstration of approval or praise by clapping the hands together
synonym: clapping, cheering, acclaim
(1) round of **applause**, (2) earn **applause**
The **applause** burst from the audience.

audition

n. a performance or test given by an actor, musician, or other performers to demonstrate their abilities and suitability for a particular role or position

synonym : tryout, test

(1) music **audition**, (2) dance **audition**

I have an **audition** for a role in a play tomorrow.

dreadful

adj. very bad, unpleasant, or causing fear

synonym : terrible, horrible, awful

(1) **dreadful** accident, (2) **dreadful** news

The conditions of the prison were **dreadful** and inhumane.

panoply

n. a complete or impressive array or collection of things; a splendid or impressive display of objects or people presented together

synonym : display, collection, array

(1) **panoply** of colors, (2) **panoply** of options

The museum had a **panoply** of artifacts from different historical periods.

mantra

n. a word or phrase, often repeated, that is used as a focus for the mind during meditation

synonym : hymn, chant, phrase

(1) campaign **mantra**, (2) chant the **mantra** of structural reform

She repeated her personal **mantra** to herself to stay motivated.

strait

n. a narrow stretch of water or sea connecting two larger bodies of water or seas

synonym : narrows, channel, passage

(1) **strait** passage, (2) **strait** channel

The ship navigated through the **strait** with great care.

excite

v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager

synonym : thrill, exhilarate, animate

(1) **excite** the crowd, (2) **excite** rebellion

The news of her promotion **excited** her.

nonverbal

adj. not involving or using spoken or written language; communicated through body language, facial expression, or other means besides language

synonym : silent, mute, unspoken

(1) **nonverbal** communication, (2) **nonverbal** signal

Many communication skills rely on **nonverbal** cues such as body language and facial expressions.

rev

n. a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

synonym : revolution, RPM, speed

muse
