synonym: disturbance, turmoil, upheaval

#### recession

### long-lasting

*adj.* existing or continuing for a long time *synonym*: enduring, abiding, durable

#### downturn

 a period of decline, typically in an economy, characterized by reduced trade and business activity and a fall in prices and employment synonym: decline, fall, drop

(1) the **downturn** in auto sales, (2) **downturn** in health The global economy experienced a sharp **downturn** in the wake of the pandemic.

#### ramification

the act or process of branching out or dividing into branches

*synonym*: fork, branching, complication

(1) **ramifications** of the scenario, (2) political **ramification** The court's decision had many unforeseen **ramifications**.

### pinpoint

v. to locate or identify the exact position in space or time of something

synonym: name, direct, identify

(1) **pinpoint** the problem, (2) **pinpoint** signs of manipulation This radar quickly **pinpoints** the position of the enemy.

### disrupt

 to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

synonym: interrupt, disturb, break into

(1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

#### mismatch

v. to put together or match items that are not compatible or do not fit well together; to be different from or not correspond to something else

synonym: mismatch, discord, clash

(1) **mismatch** expectations, (2) **mismatch** socks
The colors of the shirt and pants totally **mismatch**, making the outfit look ridiculous.

#### creditor

- n. a person, company, etc. to whom a debtor owes money
- (1) the **creditor's** claims, (2) bankrupt **creditor** I asked the lawyer to initiate **creditor** negotiations for voluntary liquidation.

#### fluctuation

 a change, or the process of changing, that frequently happens, especially from one extreme to another; the quality of being unsteady and subject to changes

synonym: change, instability, flux

(1) price **fluctuations**, (2) **fluctuation** of water level Temperature **fluctuations** are often milder in oceanfront areas.

### geopolitical

- adj. of or relating to political activity or relations between countries and groups of countries, as influenced by the physical features of a country or area
- (1) the **geopolitical** situations, (2) reduce **geopolitical** risk The country holds dominant **geopolitical** power over its neighbors.

#### discotheque

 a nightclub or restaurant where recorded music is played, and people dance

synonym: nightclub, dance club, disco

(1) **discotheque** party, (2) **discotheque** scene He couldn't wait to hit the **discotheque** and dance the night away.

## prophecy

- n. a statement or prediction that something will happen in the future, typically one made by a religious leadersynonym: prediction, foretelling, divination
- (1) **prophecy** fulfillment, (2) **prophecy** of doom

  The fortune teller's **prophecy** that I would meet my soulmate next year has yet to come true.

#### reliant

adj. needing something or something to continue, to work correctly, or to succeed

*synonym*: dependent, subservient

(1) heavily **reliant** on oil, (2) export- **reliant** economy

The company is heavily **reliant** on its overseas operations for revenue.

#### revolutionize

 to bring about a complete or radical change in something, often through the introduction of new methods or ideas

synonym: transform, innovate, modernize

(1) **revolutionize** the industry, (2) **revolutionize** the technology

The invention of the smartphone **revolutionized** the way we communicate with each other.
