### (1) **psychedelic** therapy, (2) **psychedelic** art The Beatles' **psychedelic** music was a hallmark of the 1960s counterculture movement.

#### microscope

an instrument used to see objects or substances that are too small to be seen with the naked eye synonym: lens, magnifier, eyepiece

(1) microscope slide, (2) electron microscope I used an optical microscope to observe the small organisms in the water sample.

### biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

### telescope

- a device like a tube in shape containing lenses used to magnify and observe distant objects
- (1) a binocular telescope, (2) look through a telescope This facility has the largest astronomical **telescope** in the country.

### astronomy

the scientific study of objects and matter outside the Earth's atmosphere, especially the positions, motions, and evolution of celestial bodies

synonym: astrophysics, stargazing, cosmology

- (1) astronomy science, (2) a branch of astronomy He had a deep passion for extragalactic astronomy and spent hours observing the night sky.
- a person who helps and advises a younger or less experienced person over time, usually at work or school

synonym: adviser, coach, tutor

### mystical

#### leak

v. to allow liquid or gas to get in or out from a hole or crack in a pipe or container

#### counterculture

 a subculture whose values and norms of behavior differ substantially from those of mainstream society, often in opposition to it

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

#### unwise

synonym: useful, advantageous, fruitful

#### manifest

v. to show something such as feeling, attitude, quality, etc. clearly through signs or actions

*synonym*: exhibit, make plain, demonstrate

#### relate

v. to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

### psilocybin

 a naturally occurring psychedelic compound found in more than 200 species of mushrooms, which produces various perceptual, cognitive, and emotional effects when ingested

synonym: magic mushrooms, shrooms

#### freshman

 a person who adheres strictly to the basic principles of any subject or discipline

### genocide

n. the intentional killing of a large group of people, especially those of a particular ethnic group or nation

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

### mystery

n. something difficult to understand or explain; a secret or enigmatic quality that adds to the fascination or interest of something; a genre of fiction that involves the solution of a crime or a puzzle

#### conscious

The management must **explore** strategies to increase office security.

#### meditation

n. the act of focusing one's mind on a particular object or thought; activity to train attention and achieve a mentally clear and emotionally calm and stable state

synonym: contemplation, reflection, introspection

(1) **meditation** training, (2) religious **meditation**The **meditation** instructor guided the group through the relaxation and breathing exercises.

### lifelong

adj. lasting for the whole of someone's life synonym: enduring, eternal, permanent

(1) **lifelong** career, (2) **lifelong** commitment

He had a **lifelong** love of reading and spent hours daily with a book.

zen

n. a school of Mahayana Buddhism that originated in China and was later developed in Japan, emphasizing the practice of meditation as the way to achieve enlightenment or awakening; (adjective) characterized by a sense of peace and tranquility, often through the practice of meditation or the use of natural elements

synonym: meditative, peaceful, tranquil

retreat

#### modern

#### demonstrate

v. to display something or give an exhibition to an interested audience

synonym: show, illustrate, display

(1) **demonstrate** a difference, (2) **demonstrate** mastery How can you **demonstrate** that the earth is a sphere?

default

v. to fail to fulfill an obligation or pay a debt when it is due; to fail to meet expectations or perform as required; to choose or accept a predetermined option or condition without making a deliberate selection or choice; (noun) a failure to fulfill an obligation or to meet a requirement; the pre-set or automatic settings that a system or program uses when the user has selected no other options

synonym: fail, neglect, omit

### equivalent

filter

 any of several types of equipment or systems used to separate particles from liquids or gases or to remove specific forms of light

### priority

 something that is more important than other things and should be dealt with first

synonym: importance, precedence, primacy

(1) **priority** call, (2) **priority** seating for elderly Her **priority** is to be a mother.

#### shift

- n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trendsynonym: transition, change, modification
- (1) Doppler **shift**, (2) major paradigm **shift** Could you help me **shift** some furniture?

### foreground

- the part of a view, picture, etc., that is nearest to the viewer
- (1) **foreground** segmentation, (2) **foreground** galaxy A happy group of friends occupies the **foreground** of the picture.

### background

- n. the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem
- synonym: ground, experience, backdrop
- (1) a **background** color, (2) a criminal **background**The company's hiring criteria emphasize personality, not a person's **background**.

#### awareness

- n. the fact or state of knowing something exists and is important
- synonym: understanding, cognition, knowledge
- (1) **awareness** of my ignorance, (2) raise public **awareness**There has been a gradual but steady rise in environmental **awareness**.

#### universe

 everything that exists, especially all physical matter, including planets, stars, galaxies, and all other forms of matter and energy

synonym: cosmos, macrocosm

(1) theory of the universe, (2) expansion of the universe

The **universe** is about 13.8 billion years old.

#### revolve

v. to rotate around a central point

*synonym*: rotate, spin, orbit

(1) **revolve** at high speed, (2) **revolve** around a central axis

The Earth **revolves** around the Sun in an elliptical orbit.

#### altruistic

adj. showing a selfless and disinterested concern for the happiness and well-being of other people

synonym: altruistic, philanthropic, generous

The company tried to build an **altruistic** image.

#### ecstasy

 a state of overwhelming happiness, joy, or pleasure; an emotional or mental state of intense feelings of delight or happiness that is often accompanied by intense physical sensations

#### **fundamental**

#### violent

 a violent physical attack; the crime of forcing someone to submit to sexual intercourse against their will

#### introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

(1) **introduction** education, (2) self- **introduction**The **introduction** to the new class was informative and engaging.

### therapeutic

*adj.* relating to or involved in the treatment of illness or injury *synonym*: healing, remedial, curative

(1) **therapeutic** massage, (2) **therapeutic** administration Yoga is known to have **therapeutic** benefits for the mind and body.

#### recreational

adj. relating to or for leisure or pleasure; done for enjoyment rather than work or duty

synonym: leisure, fun, entertaining

(1) a recreational center, (2) recreational drugsI enjoy recreational activities such as hiking and swimming.

#### trauma

 an emotional wound or shock often has long-lasting effects caused by a highly upsetting or shocking experience synonym: agony, injury, ordeal

(1) psychic trauma, (2) trauma care

Many civilians have suffered **trauma** as a result of the war.

#### flood

a large amount of water flowing beyond its normal limits;
 an overwhelming number or amount

synonym: deluge, downpour, overflow

(1) flood advisory, (2) a flood of questions

These heavy rains caused flash **floods** on several islands.

### intensify

 to increase or make something increase in extent or strength

synonym: amplify, boost, strengthen

(1) **intensify** diplomatic efforts, (2) **intensify** a good relationship

Rebels have pledged to **intensify** the armed struggle against the dictatorship.

#### conversation

n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

#### commit

v. to do something illegal or wrong

synonym: engage, carry out, execute

(1) commit suicide, (2) commit mistakes

#### session

 a formal meeting or series of meetings for the execution of a particular group's functions; a period spent doing a particular activity

synonym: conference, gathering

#### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products
