synonym: flashlight, lantern, flare

#### imprison

v. to confine a person to a prison, a detention facility, or a place of involuntary confinement

*synonym*: incarcerate, detain, confine

#### beacon

n. a light or other visible object serving as a signal, guide, or warning

*synonym*: lighthouse, guidepost, marker

#### pomp

 a display of ceremonial splendor; formal or ostentatious display or a show of magnificence

*synonym*: splendor, grandeur, ceremony
