#### limitless

#### expanse

#### condense

to reduce the volume or size of something, often by removing water or other liquid; to make something shorter, more concise, or more concentrated

jaguar

a large animal of the cat family that has a n. yellowish-brown coat with black spots, mainly found in parts of Central and South America

#### cavern

a large, natural underground space
