# disrupt

v. to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

*synonym*: interrupt, disturb, break into

(1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

### patriarchy

 a social system in which men hold primary power and predominate in roles of political leadership, moral authority, and control of a property

*synonym*: male-dominated society, male domination

(1) patriarchy system, (2) ancient patriarchy

The feminist movement aims to challenge and dismantle **patriarchy** society and promote gender equality.

# perch

mover

v. to sit, stand, or rest on something, particularly a narrow or elevated surface; to position oneself confidently or dominantly; to place something in a high or elevated position; (noun) a branch or other elevated place where a bird can rest or roost

synonym: sit, roost, squat

- perch on a ledge, (2) perch of a bird of prey
   The bird perched on the branch, watching the world below.
- a person or company that specializes in moving goods or possessions from one location to another; a professional moving service or an individual who

performs this task for friends, family members, or

customers

synonym: removalist, proposer

(1) market **mover**, (2) the **movers** and shakers
The professional **mover** helped us pack and transport our furniture and belongings to our new home.

#### immerse

v. to become fully involved in a particular activity; to dip or submerge in a liquid, especially so that they or it are entirely covered

*synonym*: dip, inundate, submerge

(1) **immerse** the cloth in the dye, (2) completely **immerse** the ingredient

He **immersed** himself in his research.

# oppress

v. to treat people in a cruel and authoritarian way, especially by denying them the same freedoms, rights, etc. as other people

synonym: antagonize, distress, burden

(1) **oppress** the minority, (2) **oppress** the people with force Historically, many countries have often **oppressed** certain religions to gain the support of the majority of the population.

### pedestal

a base or support on which something, typically a statue, column, etc., is placed

synonym: base, stand, platform

(1) pedestal sink, (2) a stone pedestal

The statue was placed on a **pedestal** in the center of the park.

# provocative

adj. arousing anger, interest, or another strong reaction, especially deliberately

synonym: instigating, provoking, inciting

provocative questions, (2) a provocative smile
 provocative style frequently sparked controversies.

# augment

v. to increase the size, extent, quantity, etc. of something by adding something to it

synonym: boost, increase, expand

(1) **augment** the reality, (2) **augment** immunity Economic factors and monetary policy **augmented** inflation.

### atrocity

- n. brutal act; an extremely wicked or cruel actsynonym: evil, horror, iniquity
- commit atrocity, (2) cold-blooded atrocity
   The atrocity of the war left many children orphaned.

## genesis

- n. the origin or beginning of something; the first book of the biblical scriptures of both Judaism and Christianity, describing the creation of the Earth and humankind
- synonym: beginning, creation, provenance
- (1) the **genesis** of civilization, (2) in the Book of **Genesis** The politician's remarks became the **genesis** of the clash between the two countries.

#### transatlantic

 adj. relating to or situated on the other side of the Atlantic Ocean, especially about travel communication or cultural exchange between Europe and North America

synonym: intercontinental, across-the-pond

(1) **transatlantic** cable, (2) **transatlantic** partnership **Transatlantic** cooperation is important for global security and stability.

#### commemorate

v. to honor the memory of someone or something by ceremony or tribute

synonym: honor, remember, celebrate

(1) **commemorate** her long life, (2) **commemorate** a deed The country **commemorated** the war heroes on Memorial Day.

#### reroute

v. to redirect or change the course or direction of something

synonym: redirect, divert, detour

(1) reroute traffic, (2) reroute path

Due to the traffic, the delivery truck had to **reroute** to avoid the congested roads.

# quarterback

n. the player in American football who typically leads the offense and is responsible for calling plays, passing the ball, and directing the team's overall strategy on the field

synonym: signal caller, field general

(1) elite quarterback, (2) backup quarterback

The coach decided to bench the starting **quarterback** after multiple turnovers.

#### beret

 a soft, round, flat-crowned felt or woolen hat, typically worn by men and associated with French or Basque culture

synonym: cap, tam, military hat

(1) military **beret**, (2) woolen **beret** 

The French painter wore a black **beret** as a symbol of his artistic identity.

#### anthem

 a rousing or uplifting song identified with a particular group, body, or cause

synonym: hymn, song, paean

(1) a national **anthem**, (2) **anthem** singer

The **anthem** of the country was played during the ceremony.

#### blackball

 to reject or exclude someone from a particular group, organization, or activity; to vote against or reject a proposal or idea

synonym: ban, veto, reject

(1) **blackball** a member, (2) **blackball** a proposal

The charity organization chose to **blackball** the donor with a history of making controversial statements.

#### trump

- a playing card with a picture of a trumpeter on it, used in certain card games
- (1) **trump** card, (2) choose **trump**

The **trump** suit in the game of bridge is determined at the beginning of each hand.

#### empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

#### smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of **smartphones**.

#### app

 n. (abbreviation for application) software designed to run on smartphones and other mobile devices or inside a web browser on a PC

synonym: application, software

(1) killer app, (2) cannot log in to the app

The discovery of a critical bug caused the company to delay the **app's** release.

#### institutionalize

to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

(1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

### reimagine

v. to imagine or conceive of something in a new or different way

synonym: re-conceptualize, re-envision, re-create

(1) **reimagine** the future, (2) **reimagine** the possibilities The company is trying to **reimagine** its business model to stay competitive.

prioritize

v. to assign a higher level of importance to something compared to other things

synonym: rank, order, arrange

(1) **prioritize** tasks, (2) **prioritize** people over cars

The organization **prioritized** the needs of the community in its decision-making.
