wart

adj. of or relating to the external and internal reproductive organs

synonym: reproductive, genetic, sexual

- (1) **genital** bleeding, (2) pain in the **genital** area The **genital** organs of the human body are necessary for reproduction.

scrape

v. to draw something along a rough or hard surface, typically to remove dirt or other matter

synonym: scratch, graze, rub

colposcopy

n. a medical procedure that involves using a specialized instrument to visually examine the cervix, vulva, and vagina of a woman to detect and diagnose any abnormality or disease

synonym: cervical screening, pelvic exam

biopsy

n. the process of removing and examining tissue from the body of the sick person to determine the existence or cause of a disease

synonym: examination, autopsy

(1) **biopsy** of bone marrow, (2) liquid **biopsy**The doctor performed an excisional breast **biopsy**.

condom

 a thin rubber or plastic sheath worn over the penis during sexual intercourse to prevent pregnancy or the transmission of sexually transmitted infections (STIs) between partners

synonym: prophylactic, rubber, sheath

(1) **condom** brand, (2) safe **condom** use

Using a **condom** during sexual activity is one of the most effective ways to prevent unwanted pregnancies and sexually transmitted infections.

vaccinate

 to treat with a vaccine, usually by injection, to produce immunity against a disease

synonym: immunize, inject, inoculate
