depress

#### relate

 to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

#### invention

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventing

*synonym*: creation, design, innovation

(1) the **invention** of new techniques, (2) common **invention** Necessity is the mother of **invention**.

### puppet

 a doll or figure that is manipulated by strings, wires, or hands to represent a person or animal; a person who is controlled or manipulated by someone else

synonym: marionette, dummy, mannequin

(1) puppet theater, (2) corporate puppetThe politician was merely a puppet for the wealthy elite.

### journalism

*n.* the profession or activity of writing or reporting news for publication or broadcast

synonym: reporting, news media, writing

(1) **journalism** ethics, (2) tabloid **journalism**She plans to study **journalism** in college and become a reporter.

#### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

*synonym*: suitable, timely, practical

#### weave

v. to make cloth, a carpet, a basket, etc., by repeatedly crossing a single thread through two sets of long threads at a right angle to them

synonym: braid, unite, contrive

#### tale

 a story made up in someone's imagination, especially one full of action and adventure

synonym: canard, fiction, fable

#### narrative

 a story or a description of a series of events or process of telling a story

synonym: the tale, chronology, annals

(1) narrative poetry, (2) personal narrative

#### celebrity

n. someone who is well-known, particularly in the entertainment industry

synonym: figure, star, VIP

(1) baseball **celebrity**, (2) **celebrity** known worldwide The popularity of the show made her an instant **celebrity**.

### percentage

 the number, amount, or rate of something, which is usually the amount per hundred

synonym: rate, ratio, portion

(1) the **percentage** of the gold content, (2) a high **percentage** 

What is the **percentage** of the consumption tax in the United States?

#### chronicle

 a historical account of events arranged in order of time, typically without analysis or interpretation

synonym: record, history, annals

(1) **chronicle** of the war, (2) heroic **chronicle** The **chronicle** of the kingdom's history was passed down through generations of royalty.

#### impetus

a force, motivation, or stimulus that causes something to n. happen or be done; the driving force behind a particular action or change

synonym: stimulus, momentum, drive

(1) political **impetus**, (2) technological **impetus** Getting a raise at work was the **impetus** to start looking for a new place to live.

### margin

the space around the edge of a page or document; (finance) the net sales minus the cost of goods and services sold

*synonym*: edge, border, periphery

(1) margin error, (2) a profit margin Unfortunately, the book's **margin** was too small to make notes.

#### revisit

- to go to a place again, especially after a long period synonym: reexplore, review, reexamine
- (1) revisit a place, (2) revisit an old friend We need to **revisit** this proposal as soon as the budget is more apparent than before.
- a conspicuous disparity or difference separates something such as a figure, people, their opinions, situation, etc.

synonym: opening, lacuna, spread

(1) the gap between ideal and reality, (2) distance gap Many people are working together to close the gender gap.

#### lens

a transparent optical device with curved sides, used in an optical instrument that makes objects seem larger, smaller, clearer, etc.; (metaphor) the basic thoughts or mindsets through which someone sees or understands

#### the environment or situation

synonym: glass

a convex lens,
 a lens with a wide angle
 the photographer took this photo using a telephoto lens.

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

roll

v. to move in a particular direction by turning over and over or from side to side

synonym: spin, swirl, wheel

(1) roll a ball, (2) roll down his cheeks

He was exhausted and **rolled** into bed as soon as he got home.

#### conversation

 an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

#### gender

n. the range of characteristics of femininity and masculinity and differentiating between them, especially when considering social and cultural differences rather than differences in biology

synonym: sexuality

## inequality

n. the unfairness of a society in which some people have more opportunity, money, etc. than others;

(mathematics) relation between two values when they are different

synonym: imbalance, prejudice, unfairness

(1) **inequality** in salary, (2) algebraic **inequality**There are several causes of economic **inequality** within societies.

#### **bubble**

n. a thin, round, and often transparent mass of gas that is surrounded by a thin layer of liquid; a state of economic or social prosperity that is unsustainable and eventually collapses

synonym: blob, balloon, mania

### journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

#### advance

- v. to go or move forward; to develop in a positive way synonym: progress, boost, come along

#### shadow

n. a dark area or shape cast by an object blocking the passage of light; an area in darkness or shade; a reflected image or copy of something; a person, activity, or influence that follows or accompanies someone or something closely and persistently, often in a secretive or ominous manner synonym: shade, silhouette, outline

### injustice

- a violation of the rights of others or the laws of a society synonym: unfairness, bias, discrimination

### colleague

one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

- to ask someone to come or join; to offer an opportunity or possibility for something to happen or take place synonym: ask, request, summon

### satisfy

to make somebody pleased by giving them what they want or need

synonym: please, amuse, meet

(1) satisfy a desire, (2) satisfy a user's needs Did this response **satisfy** your request?

#### submission

the act of giving a document, proposal, etc., to somebody for consideration or judgment; the act of giving in or yielding to a superior force or authority

synonym: obedience, yielding, compliance

(1) **submission** agreement, (2) **submission** of a final report The **submission** deadline for the project is next week.

invite

#### scour

v. to clean thoroughly and vigorously by scrubbing or rubbing; to search or examine something thoroughly and systematically

synonym: cleanse, scrub, clean

(1) **scour** a pot, (2) **scour** the Internet

She had to **scour** the kitchen to find a clean dish to use for dinner.

#### swirl

- v. to move in a circular or spiral pattern
- synonym: spin, whirl, turn
- (1) swirl the wine, (2) swirl up dirt and dust

The chef expertly **swirled** the sauce onto the plate.

#### creditor

- n. a person, company, etc. to whom a debtor owes money
- the creditor's claims, (2) bankrupt creditor

### introductory

adj. intended as an introduction or preliminary; serving as a base or starting point

synonym: beginning, preliminary, initial

(1) **introductory** biology text, (2) product **introductory** sale The **introductory** class was designed to give students a basic understanding of the subject.

#### doe

 a mature female of mammals of which the male is called a buck, such as a deer or a rabbit

synonym: rabbit, bunny, hare

(1) doe rabbit, (2) buck and doe

Hunters use a whistle that makes the **doe** sound to lure stags.

#### spoil

- v. to ruin the taste, appearance, or quality of something; to become or cause something to become rotten or bad
- synonym: rot, decay, deteriorate
- (1) **spoil** a person's sport, (2) **spoil** the surprise

If you leave the milk out of the refrigerator for too long, it will spoil.

alert

to warn or arouse to a sense of danger; (adjective) paying close attention or being in a state of readiness for action

synonym: warn, inform, (adjective) vigilant

- (1) alert consumers to the dangers, (2) alert system The company's cybersecurity team **alerted** the CEO to potential threats.
- to jump into the water with your head and arms going in first, or to move down to a deeper level underwater synonym: dip, leap, plunge
- (1) dive into anime communities, (2) dive off a cliff The sperm whale can **dive** to 1,000 meters.
- a collection of historical documents or records providing n. information about a place, institution, or group of people synonym: records, documents, repository
  - (1) historical archives, (2) digital archives The **archives** at the library contain a wealth of information about the city's history.

### pioneering

- adj. involving new ideas or methods; being the first of their kind; leading the way in a particular field synonym: innovative, groundbreaking, trailblazing
- (1) pioneering research, (2) pioneering spirit The **pioneering** scientist developed a breakthrough technology that revolutionized the industry.

# lynch

to put to death or punish (usually by hanging) without ν. legal authorization or due process, often as an act of mob justice or vigilante action; (noun) a violent punishment, often extrajudicial, in which a mob or group of people seize and kill someone, usually by hanging, as a form of punishment or vengeance

dive

archives

synonym: hang, execute, mob

The mob wanted to **lynch** the suspect before he could be tried in court.

#### brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

(1) brilliant idea, (2) brilliant performance

#### poet

- n. a person who writes poetrysynonym: versifier, rhymer, writer

#### mathematics

 the science dealing with the logic of quantities, shapes, spaces, and arrangement

synonym: arithmetic, calculation, calculus

### recognize

### buy-in

 to buy something in large quantities for future use; to accept or adopt something

synonym: invest, buy, prepare

#### weird

adj. extraordinary, unexpected, or difficult to explain synonym: bizarre, creepy, peculiar

#### worthwhile

 adj. having value or benefit; sufficiently important or beneficial to be worthy of time or effort; deserving of attention or consideration

synonym: valuable, rewarding, significant

(1) **worthwhile** investment, (2) **worthwhile** endeavor Volunteering for a **worthwhile** cause is important for building a sense of community.

launch

to send or propel something into the air or space using a device such as a rocket, missile, or spacecraft; to make something available or on sale for the first time

synonym: start, initiate, begin

(1) **launch** a spaceship into orbit, (2) **launch** a big attack The company is set to **launch** its new product line next month.

#### remarkable

*adj.* worthy of attention because unusual or special *synonym*: outstanding, exceptional, extraordinary

(1) **remarkable** achievement, (2) the **remarkable** breadth of knowledge

The election was a **remarkable** success for the Whigs.

#### achieve

to successfully complete a task or goal, often through hard work, perseverance, and dedication; to attain or accomplish something that one has set out to do

synonym: accomplish, attain, reach

(1) achieve success, (2) achieve milestonesI will work hard to achieve my goals and realize my dreams.

#### overlook

v. to fail to notice something; to watch over someone; to provide a view from above

synonym: disregard, look down, supervise

(1) overlook a street, (2) overlook that fact

We cannot **overlook** an opportunity for great success.

#### survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

#### domestic

adj. relating to or inside a particular country, not foreign or international

synonym: endemic, private, household

- (1) domestic airline, (2) a domestic animal
- GDP stands for gross domestic product.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

### recognition

 the action or process of recognizing or being recognized, especially by remembering; an agreement that something is true or legal

synonym: acknowledgement, identification, credit

(1) recognition award, (2) joint recognition

He was given **recognition** for his outstanding work in the field of medicine.

#### broom

 a cleaning tool that typically consists of a long handle with a bundle of stiff bristles or fibers at one end, used for sweeping or cleaning floors or other surfaces

synonym: sweeper, brush

(1) broom closet, (2) broom handle

### geography

- a field of science devoted to the study of the lands, features, inhabitants, and phenomena of the Earth
   synonym: landscape, terrain, topography
- (1) **geography** class, (2) economic **geography** She did well on her **geography** exam.

#### hike

 a long walk or journey, especially for pleasure or exercise; an increase in cost

synonym: walk, trek, excursion

(1) go on a hike, (2) a hike in prices

The family decided to **hike** in the mountains to enjoy the beautiful scenery.

trail

 a path or track roughly through a countryside, mountain, or forest area, often made or used for a particular purpose; (verb) to lag or linger behind

synonym: footpath, track, course

(1) a warm trail, (2) follow the trail

The storm left a **trail** of destruction behind it.

#### entirety

 the state of being complete or whole; the total extent or scope of something

synonym: totality, completeness, wholeness

(1) the **entirety** of the situation, (2) the **entirety** of the book They refused to accept the proposal in its **entirety**, demanding revisions.

### rough

adj. not quite exact or correct; having or caused by an irregular surface

synonym: inelegant, coarse, barbarian

(1) **rough** and tough, (2) **rough** estimation

The vehicle bounced along the **rough** mountain road.

### plague

 any epidemic disease with a high death rate; (also called pest) a serious, sometimes fatal, infection spread by rats that causes fever and swellings on the body

synonym: epidemic, pandemic, pest

(1) catch the **plague**, (2) deadly **plague** 

Our farm experienced a plague of locusts this year.

### lingering

 adj. continuing for a long time; persistent; remaining in a place or situation for longer than is usual or necessary; unwilling to leave

synonym: prolonged, persistent, enduring

(1) **lingering** illness, (2) **lingering** doubts

The **lingering** smell of smoke clung to his clothes even after he left the campfire.

### diversify

v. to make something include more different types or things; to spread out activities or investments

synonym: branch out, expand, broaden

(1) diversify my portfolio, (2) diversify energy sources This inclusive environment has allowed the plant species to diversify.

#### basement

a room or a part of a building that is partly or entirely below ground level

synonym: cellar, storage, vault

(1) four basement floor, (2) church basement Underground rivers flow over a **basement** layer that is impervious to water.

### morgue

a place where dead bodies are kept, particularly in preparation for burial or identification by their relatives or authorities

synonym: mortuary, funeral home, charnel house

(1) clinical morgue, (2) overcrowded morgue The attendant at the **morgue** was responsible for cataloging the bodies and their respective information.

### quidance

advice or instructions given to help direct someone's n. behavior or decision-making

synonym: advice, direction, support

- (1) vocational guidance, (2) guidance counselor The mentor provided **guidance** to the young entrepreneur, helping her navigate the business world.
- a curved structure with two supports that holds the n. weight of something above it, such as a bridge or the upper part of a building

synonym: turn, bow, arc

(1) the **arch** of a person's foot, (2) an **arch-shaped** stone structure

The **arch** bears the weight of the overhead bridge.

#### index

a list of items, such as names, subjects, or keywords, n. that is arranged in a particular order and is usually found at the end of a book or document; a number or symbol

#### arch

that indicates the value or level of something, such as a stock index or a temperature index

synonym: list, directory, indicator

(1) a full-text **index**, (2) health **index** 

The stock market **index** measures the performance of a group of stocks.

### genealogy

- n. the study of family history and the tracing of lineagessynonym: lineage, ancestry, family history

### digit

 a heading at the top of a newspaper or magazine story or page

synonym: title, caption

#### define

 to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

synonym: characterize, depict, express

(1) **define** a word, (2) **define** my position

To advance this discussion, we must **define** "success" rigorously.

### diversity

 the quality or fact of many different types of things or people being included in something; a range of different things or people

synonym: variety, multiplicity, variousness

(1) the **diversity** policy of the university, (2) lingual **diversity** He was impressed by the range and **diversity** of the collection.

### analyze

v. to think about in-depth and evaluate to discover essential features or meaning

synonym: explore, examine, investigate

(1) **analyze** a chemical compound, (2) **analyze** your real motives

The teacher attempted to **analyze** the root cause of our mistake.

#### calculate

v. to judge or find out the amount or number of something by using mathematics

synonym: compute, figure, estimate

(1) **calculate** the distance, (2) **calculate** his credit score He couldn't **calculate** the actual value of the artwork.

#### awesome

adj. inspiring fear, admiration, or respect; very good, nice, fun, etc.

synonym: miraculous, marvelous, astounding

#### parity

 the state or condition of being equal, especially in status or payment

synonym: equality, sameness, equivalence
