tackle

sigh

environment

lean

armpit

stale

detect

complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

bombard

smelly

sludge

individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self

cycle

an interval during which a recurring sequence of events occurs; a bicycle or motorcycle

parasite

- an organism that lives on or in another organism and benefits by deriving nutrients at the other's expense

gut

cyst

saliva

transmission

 n. the act or process of sending something from one person or place to another; the process of broadcasting over the airwaves, as in radio or television

synonym: transportation, communication, broadcast

Education is the **transmission** of civilization.

onward

adj. moving or continuing forward; progressingsynonym: forward, continuing, progressing

(1) **onward** journey, (2) **onward** progress

When traveling to some countries, you may be required to show proof of an **onward** ticket as a condition of entry.

hypothesis

 a proposed idea or explanation that is based on a few known facts but has not yet been proven to be true or accurate

synonym: assumption, conjecture, theory

attractive

 adj. immensely appealing in look or sound; having characteristics or qualities that make something appealing and valuable

colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

experiment

 the scientific test conducted to observe what happens and gain new knowledge

synonym: experimentation, investigation

(1) **experiment** design, (2) series of **experiments** His **experiments** showed highly positive results.

participate

v. to take part in something

synonym: take part, partake, enter

(1) **participate** fully in conversation, (2) **participate** in the program

The majority of students actively **participated** in the college's intramural sports program.

chamber

 a large room used for a formal, public, or particular purpose; one of the parts of a parliament

synonym: association, cabin, legislature

(1) a gas **chamber**, (2) the lower **chamber**

The surgeon made an incision in the **chambers** of the patient's heart.

whatsoever

adv. not at all; no matter what

synonym: in any way, at all, in any respect

(1) **whatsoever** it be, (2) without impact **whatsoever** He refused to do anything **whatsoever** to help her.

graph

 a picture consisting of a line, lines, points, etc., that shows how two or more sets of certain quantities are related to each other

synonym: chart, diagram, figure

(1) graph theory, (2) a graph sample

This bar **graph** shows sales over the past five years.

represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

synonym: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understandsynonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

trait

n. a particular feature of your nature

synonym: attribute, feature, quality

(1) chemical trait, (2) personality traits

Multiple genes may influence behavioral traits concurrently.

disappear

v. to cease to exist or be visible

synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish

(1) **disappear** without a trace, (2) **disappear** after a week They watched the train **disappear** into the distance.

beacon

 a light or other visible object serving as a signal, guide, or warning

synonym: lighthouse, guidepost, marker

(1) an aerial **beacon**, (2) **beacon** of hope

The lighthouse served as a **beacon** to guide ships safely into port.

wrap

v. to cover or enclose something entirely with paper, cloth, or other material

synonym: surround, cover, bandage

(1) wrap a fish in foil, (2) wrap up a meeting

Wrap the bandage tightly around the injured arm.

olfaction

the sense of smell; the ability to detect and perceive odors or scents

synonym: smell, scent, aroma

(1) **olfaction** testing, (2) **olfaction** receptors

Some animals have better **olfaction** than humans, enabling them to detect prey from farther away.

concentration

n. the ability to focus all your time and energy on one thing without thinking about anything else.

ratio

combination

composition

- n. the different parts of something's elements or ingredients; the way in which the different components are organized; a piece of music written by someone

recipe

a set of instructions for preparing a dish, including the ingredients and the method of cooking

ingredient

synonym: element, component

lab

 a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

laboratory

 a workplace for doing scientific research or teaching science; a lab

synonym: lab, workshop, testing room

(1) **laboratory** accident, (2) anthropology **laboratory**Animal protection groups call for an end to animal testing in a **laboratory**.

electrode

- either of two points or ends of a conductor at which electricity enters or leaves an object, substance, or region
- (1) platinum **electrodes**, (2) **electrode** corrosion It is important to place the **electrodes** in the correct position for accurate electro-cardiogram recording.

antenna

 an electrical device that sends or receives radio or television signals; (biology) one of one or more pairs of appendages used for sensing in insects

synonym: feeler, receiver

(1) **antenna** of insect, (2) extend the TV **antenna** He had a special **antenna** for public relations

fiddle

v. to continuously touch or manipulate something with someone's hands, mainly when bored or nervous; to act dishonestly to try to get money, information, etc., or gain an advantage

synonym: tinker, diddle, play

(1) **fiddle** with a PC, (2) **fiddle** away the whole afternoon She was able to **fiddle** a free trip to the United States.

incredible

adj. unbelievable; enormous

synonym: unbelievable, fantastical, inconceivable

sneeze

to make a sudden, involuntary expulsion of air from the nose and mouth, usually due to irritation caused by the presence of dust, pollen, or other irritants

synonym: exhale, whiff, blow

(1) **sneeze** into my hand, (2) **sneeze** loudly Whenever I get a cold, I tend to **sneeze** a lot.

electrical

adj. relating to electricity

(1) an **electrical** storm, (2) degree in **electrical** engineering Actuators convert **electrical** pulses into motion.

receptor

- an organ having nerve endings that respond to stimulation such as heat or cold and makes the body react in a particular way
- (1) cellular **receptor**, (2) **receptor** for HIV in humans Hay fever occurs when a substance called histamine binds to **receptors** in the nose and eyes.

insect

- any small creature that has six legs and a body divided into three sections
- (1) **insect** antenna, (2) **insect** biology

These **insects** are more prevalent above a certain latitude.

tick

 a light, sharp, repetitive sound or action; a mark indicating that something is correct or has been done; any of two families of small parasitic arachnids with barbed proboscis

synonym: sound, noise, beat

I always put a **tick** mark next to the items on my grocery list after buying them.

crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry

synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

(1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

raspberry

 a sweet and tart edible fruit that grows on bushes, usually with a soft red or black color and a rough texture on the outside

synonym: blackberry, bramble, dewberry

(1) raspberry flavor, (2) raspberry tea

The **raspberry** cheesecake at that restaurant is out of this world.

crackle

v. to make a succession of slight popping sounds, often due to the heating or drying of some materials, such as firewood, paper, plastic, or food; to snap, crack, or crunch; (noun) a series of sharp, popping sounds that are caused by the rapid expansion and contraction of a material, such as wood or paper, due to changes in temperature or humidity

synonym: sizzle, hiss, snap

(1) **crackle** on the gravel road, (2) the **crackle** of the thunder

The firewood **crackled** and popped into the fireplace, sending sparks up the chimney.
