congratulation

onstage

adv. onto or on a stage in a theater; in front of an audience

statue

 a sculpture of a person or animal, typically made of stone or metal, that is intended to represent the subject in a lifelike or symbolic way

synonym: sculpture, figurine, monument

(1) a beautiful **statue**, (2) the ancient Egyptian **statues** The **statue** of the famous hero stood proudly in the town square.

pledge

v. to make a formal promise to give or do something synonym:

promise, assure, guarantee

dominate

v. to have or control a lot of power and influence over somebody or something

synonym: govern, rule, prevail

fray

v. to become worn or damaged at the edges or with use; to become angry or upset, especially in a public or noisy way; to fight or engage in conflict

synonym: tangle, brawl, skirmish

imprisonment

- the state of being confined to a prison or jail; a sentence of confinement as a punishment for a crime

 n. the unfairness of a society in which some people have more opportunity, money, etc. than others; (mathematics) relation between two values when they are different

synonym: imbalance, prejudice, unfairness

environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

ethnic
