coral

- a rock-like substance created in the sea by groupings of specific types of small animals, commonly used in jewelry

reef

- a long chain or range of rocks or sand near the ocean's surface
- barrier reef, (2) coral reefs

sand

finely granulated particles of rock or mineral material typically found along beaches, deserts, or riverbeds; used in construction, landscaping, and other applications requiring drainage or abrasive action

synonym: grit, dust, powder

# octopus

jet

 a type of aircraft that is powered by one or more jet engines and can fly at high speeds, typically over long distances

synonym: plane, aircraft, flier

reverse

v. to change something's direction, order, position, decision, etc., to the opposite one; (adjective) directed or moving toward the rear

develop

camouflage

# chromatophore

# bump

# papilla

# argue

# dynamic

# complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

# precision

- n. the quality or condition of being exact and accurate synonym: accuracy, exactness, rigor
- (1) a **precision** instrument, (2) speak with **precision**. This operation requires both patience and **precision**.

# astonishing

adj. surprising or shocking; difficult to believesynonym: surprising, shocking, astounding

#### mimic

#### norm

cuttlefish

- a sea creature with eight arms and two tentacles (= long parts like arms) that has a wide and flat shell inside its body

# display

to exhibit or show something to others, often to attract attention or demonstrate its features, properties, or value

*synonym*: show, exhibit, present

crab

 a sea creature with two large claws and a flattened back (e.g., blue crab or king crab); a sour or grumpy person who is prone to complaining or criticizing

I ordered a plate of fresh **crab** at the seafood restaurant.

prey

the object of a hunt; an animal hunted or trapped for eating

synonym: target, quarry, chase

flamboyant

adj. showy, bold, or striking in appearance or behavior;
 characterized by extravagance, eccentricity, or ostentatiousness

shift

- n. a slight transition in position, direction, or trendsynonym: transition, change, modification

instantly

adv. immediately

synonym: immediately, right away, directly

warn

v. to make someone aware of potential danger or difficulty, particularly one that may occur in the future

synonym: alert, caution, admonish

(1) warn a reckless driver, (2) warned me of the plan I attempted to warn him, but he ignored me.

slide

v. to move or cause to move smoothly along a surface without interruption

synonym: glide, drift, drop

continuum

 a series of similar items in which no part or portion is distinct or distinguishable from adjacent parts

synonym: continuation, continuity

# conspicuous

*adj.* visible or observable; likely to draw attention *synonym*: apparent, noticeable, evident

lobe

# checkerboard

 a board having 64 squares of two alternating black and white colors used for playing draughts, also known as checker

# squid

mate

a person's partner in marriage or romantic relationship;

# simultaneously

# extraordinary

#### two-faced

# unusually

#### diver

# refined

#### movement

#### mammal

- any animal of which the female gives birth to live young, not eggs, and feeds her young on milk from her own body


