absenteeism

- the practice of regularly being absent from work or school, often without a valid reason or justification synonym: truancy, nonattendance, nonappearance
- (1) absenteeism rate, (2) employee absenteeism **Absenteeism** in the workplace can majorly impact productivity and team morale.

stockout

- a situation in which a retailer or supplier runs out of stock of a particular product or item, leaving it temporarily unavailable to customers
- synonym: shortage, depletion, exhaust
- (1) a **stockout** of fresh ingredients, (2) minimize **stockout** The sudden **stockout** of our most popular product caused chaos in the warehouse.

heath

- an area of open uncultivated land, typically covered in heather, gorse, or other shrubs; a low-growing, evergreen shrub found in heathland areas
- *synonym*: moor, bog, swamp
- (1) small **heath**, (2) **heath** habitat

The birdwatcher spotted a rare species on the **heath**.



delve

 to dig or excavate deeply; to investigate or research intensively; to rummage or explore in a thorough or careful manner

synonym: dig, excavate, uncover

(1) **delve** deeper, (2) **delve** into documents

Researchers must **delve** into the intricacies of the human

brain to understand mental illness.

controllable

adj. able to be controlled or directedsynonym: manageable, governable, submissive

(1) computer- **controllable**, (2) **controllable** aircraft The new software is much more **controllable** and user-friendly.

dysentery

- a disease of the bowels characterized by severe and bloody diarrhea (= frequent and watery bowel movements)
- (1) amoebic **dysentery**, (2) **dysentery** epidemic In some communities of the country, **dysentery** was the leading cause of death.

entitle

v. to give someone the right to have or do something; to give a title to someone or something

synonym: allow, permit, enable

(1) **entitle** him to a pension, (2) **entitle** the company to use the logo

The employee was **entitled** to a week of vacation time.

reorder

v. to arrange something in a different or new order; to request or purchase an item or items again

synonym: rearrange, reschedule, redo

(1) reorder priorities, (2) reorder steps

The manager decided to **reorder** the products on the shelf to improve sales.

worsen

v. to become or make something worse

synonym: languish, degenerate, degrade

(1) worsen a relation, (2) worsen the food problem Unilateral import bans have worsened that country's terms of trade.

ache

to experience a dull, persistent pain or discomfort, typically of moderate or low intensity; to feel a continuous dull pain

synonym: hurt, throb, smart

(1) **ache** abominably, (2) **ache** all the time I ache all over after running a marathon yesterday.

dashboard

a control panel set within the central console of a vehicle n. or small aircraft; a diagram that depicts critical information, typically one that provides a business overview

synonym: control panel

(1) auto dashboard, (2) business dashboard He noticed that the oil warning light on the dashboard of his car had turned on.

dilute

to make a substance less concentrated by adding a liquid or another substance to it

synonym: weaken, thin, reduce

- (1) dilute acid with water, (2) dilute a great idea She **diluted** the concentrated juice with water.
- to bring back to life, consciousness, or strength; to revive restore

synonym: reanimate, rejuvenate, renew

(1) **revive** my energy, (2) **revive** an old friendship They **revived** the tradition of holding a parade on the main street every year.

rev

a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

synonym: revolution, RPM, speed

(1) low- rev engine, (2) rev up the crowd

He stepped on the gas pedal, and the engine released a loud **rev**.

fanfare

 a short, loud, and attention-grabbing burst of sound, often to announce or celebrate something special; a flourished or ostentatious display or demonstration

synonym: celebration, parade, ceremony

(1) fanfare announcement, (2) royal fanfare

The team arrived in a flurry of **fanfare** after winning the championship.

embarrass

- v. to cause someone to feel awkward, worried, or ashamed synonym: disconcert, unsettle, agitate
- (1) **embarrass** political enemy, (2) **embarrass** my project He looked for an opportunity to **embarrass** that actor in public.

medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of diseasesynonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) **medicinal** chemistry, (2) traditional **medicinal**The **medicinal** properties of this herb have been known to help with various ailments.

exasperated

adj. feeling intense irritation or frustration, especially over a persistent problem or difficulty

synonym: annoyed, angry, frustrated

(1) exasperated sigh, (2) feel exasperated

The politician's **exasperated** tone reflected her frustration with the lack of progress on the issue.

relegate

 to assign or dismiss to a lower or less important status or place; to demote

synonym: demote, assign, transfer

The underperforming team was **relegated** to a lower division.

vie

v. to compete or contend for something, usually a prize, position, or advantage; to strive for superiority or mastery in one's field or area of expertise

synonym: compete, contend, strive

vie for a trophy, (2) vie for attention

exemplar

 a person or thing that is regarded as a perfect example of a particular quality or type; a model or ideal to be emulated

synonym: model, paradigm, archetype

(1) **exemplar** of leadership, (2) scientific **exemplar** The lawyer cited the famous civil rights leader as an **exemplar** of courage and perseverance.

frontline

adj. in the most critical or dangerous position; in the military line or part of an army closest to the enemy

synonym: battlefront, cutting edge

(1) **frontline** health workers, (2) at the **frontline** of the war Within days, the new aircraft was in **frontline** service.

immunization

 n. the process of making a person or animal immune to a specific disease by administering a vaccine or other preventative measure

synonym: vaccination, shot, inoculation

(1) **immunization** program, (2) childhood **immunization**Due to the success of **immunization** programs, certain diseases, such as smallpox, have been eradicated.

leapfrog

 a children's game in which players take turns jumping over each other's stooped backs

synonym: hopping, jumpfrog

(1) **leapfrog** game, (2) **leapfrog** technology During recess, the children played a game of **leapfrog** in the schoolyard.

inertia

 the quality or state of being inactive, sluggish, or slow to move or act

synonym: sluggishness, lethargy, idleness

cleanliness

 the state of being clean or free from dirt, dust, or foreign substances; the practice of maintaining good hygiene and cleanliness

synonym: neatness, hygiene, sanitation

(1) **cleanliness** standards, (2) **cleanliness** of the kitchen We must prioritize our workplace's **cleanliness** for our employees' safety.

improvisation

 the act of making something up on the spot or creating or performing something without preparation

synonym: spontaneity, ad-lib, extemporization
