### jokingly

adv. done or said in a playful, humorous, or lighthearted manner, often intended to make others laugh or to avoid taking oneself too seriously

synonym: tongue-in-cheek, jestingly, facetiously

(1) jokingly mocked, (2) jokingly asked

She **jokingly** suggested they quit their jobs and run to a tropical island.

### hijab

 a headscarf traditionally worn by Muslim women to cover their hair and neck

synonym: veil, headscarf, cover

(1) woman's hijab, (2) hijab garment

Many Muslim women wear a **hijab** as a symbol of their religious beliefs.

### insecure

adj. not firm or firmly fixed; likely to fail or give way, or not assured of safety

synonym: uncertain, unsure, unconfident

(1) an **insecure** future, (2) **insecure** attachment

Children in an unstructured environment often feel **insecure**.

#### hustle

v. to cause someone to move quickly by pushing them in a rough, aggressive way

synonym: bustle, rush, haste

### apologetic

adj. feeling or expressing regret, remorse, or sorrow for one's actions; making an apology or expressing an excuse for something

*synonym*: sorry, regretful, remorseful

#### memorize

v. to learn something carefully so that you will remember it exactly

*synonym*: learn, remember, remind

### mosque

- a Muslim place of worship that usually has a minaret (= slender tower with balconies)
- (1) domed **mosque**, (2) the sacred **mosque**Jumeirah **Mosque** is one of the most beautiful buildings in the United Arab Emirates.

### bully

 a person who uses strength or power to harm or intimidate those who are weaker; (verb) to intimidate, harass, or mistreat someone weaker or less powerful

synonym: tormentor, intimidator, aggressor

(1) bully bystander, (2) bully the weak

The schoolyard **bully** terrorized the other children and made their lives miserable.

### yank

v. to pull something or someone forcefully with a sudden movement

synonym: draw, jerk, tug

(1) yank out a tooth, (2) yank at a rope

He tried to **yank** the memories from his brain.

#### Muslim

n. a follower of the religion of Islam

synonym: Islamic, believer

(1) predominantly **Muslim** country, (2) **Muslim** culture The **Muslim** community in the city is small but growing.

### horrify

v. to shock or disgust greatly

synonym:

shock, dismay, terrify

(1) horrify audience, (2) horrify victims

The series of terrorist attacks **horrify** the entire nation.

#### karate

a Japanese martial art that emphasizes hand and foot strikes, blocks, and evasions, often using a combination of techniques to overpower an opponent, also seen as a form of self-defense and physical training

synonym: martial art, self-defense discipline

She has been practicing **karate** for years and has won many tournaments.

#### sisterhood

 a close association of women based on shared interests or goals; the sense of solidarity and loyalty that exists among women

synonym: sisterliness, sisterly relationship, sorority

### swoop

 to rapidly or forcefully descend upon something or someone from a great height or distance; to rush or pounce upon

synonym: dart, pounce

#### instruct

v. to teach someone practical skills or knowledge; to formally order or tell someone to do something

synonym: train, coach, guide

The facility manager **instructed** the security guards to be on high alert.

#### overwhelm

v. to defeat someone or something by using a great deal of force; to have a strong emotional effect on somebody

synonym: conquer, crush, dominate

(1) he was **overwhelmed** with gratitude, (2) **overwhelm** opponents by numbers

Too much variety may **overwhelm** and confuse viewers.

#### undocumented

- adj. not supported by written evidence or having the necessary written permission
- (1) **undocumented** worker, (2) **undocumented** command The border patrol has recently been focusing on cracking down on **undocumented** non-citizens.

### empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

### potluck

 a meal or gathering where everyone brings a dish to share; a situation or activity in which people contribute or participate unpredictably without prior planning or preparation

synonym: community meal, shared meal

(1) potluck dinner, (2) potluck party

Everyone brought a dish to share for the office **potluck**.

### takeaway

 a message or conclusion that can be taken away from a situation or piece of information

synonym: conclusion, message, insight

(1) takeaway pizza, (2) takeaway message

The main **takeaway** from the meeting was the need for better communication.

#### escalate

v. to increase in intensity, size, or severity; to make something greater, worse, or more serious

*synonym*: increase, intensify, expand

(1) **escalate** into a major international incident, (2) to **escalate** 

The situation quickly **escalated** and turned violent.
