# legendary

adj. famous or well-known, especially through long-standing popular stories or tradition

synonym: mythical, fabled, storied

### orchestrate

#### cofounder

#### nonviolence

# democracy

 a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

#### convention

 a large formal assembly of people who do a particular job or have a similar interest or of a political party; something regarded as a normative example

### jail

 a facility where criminals are kept to be punished for their crimes; a prison

# registry

empower

# devastating

### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

#### reclaim

 to take back something previously lost, given, or paid, or ask to have it back

### heroic

 adj. courageous and daring; having or displaying qualities appropriate for legendary figures that is courage and daring

synonym: brave, courageous, daring

# footstep

 a step, or the sound generated by a person walking when their foot hits the ground

synonym: footfall, step

# blueprint

 a photographic print of an early plan for a building or machine

synonym: draft, prototype, sketch

#### bold

adj. brave, daring, and confident; not frightened of danger or afraid to say what you feel or to take risks

synonym: brave, courageous, fearless

(1) a **bold** design, (2) big, **bold** piano sounds

The effort to alleviate climate change needs **bold** action.

#### tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

(1) a **tradition** of a culture, (2) against **tradition**It is a **tradition** in many families to have a big Thanksgiving dinner with all their relatives.

#### lean

adj. having a noticeably small amount of body fat; (verb) to bend or move from a straight to a sloping posturesynonym: skinny, slender, (verb) slant

(1) a lean horse, (2) lean athletic figure

**Lean** operational improvements often lead to better environmental performance.

#### ridiculous

adj. very silly or unreasonable and deserving to be laughed at

*synonym*: absurd, fatuous, foolish

(1) a **ridiculous** amount of money, (2) a **ridiculous** suggestion

Everyone regarded the theory he advocated as **ridiculous** but was later proven correct.

### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
  As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

# permit

- v. to allow for something to happen or be done; (noun) the act of giving a formal, usually written, authorization
- synonym: allow, authorize, concede
- permit application, (2) work permit
   teacher will not permit any students to lear

The teacher will not **permit** any students to leave the classroom early.

# fundamental

adj. forming an essential base or core from which everything else develops or is affected

synonym: basic, essential, entire

(1) **fundamental** education, (2) **fundamental** rights Human behavior has **fundamental** characteristics.

#### crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angrysynonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

(1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

audit

n. an official inspection of the accounting procedures and records of business by a trained accountant or CPA that is independent of the subject; a methodical inspection or review of a specific condition or situation

synonym: review, examination, inspection

(1) audit the books, (2) audit accounts

Our company will be **audited** by an accountant next week.

blighted

adj. damaged or affected negatively, often resulting in decay, deterioration, or a lack of growth

synonym: ruined, destroyed, devastated

(1) blighted city, (2) blighted area

The abandoned building was **blighted** and had become an eyesore in the town.

pray

- v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat
- (1) pray devoutly, (2) pray for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

flint

n. a hard, gray stone that can produce sparks when struck with steel used historically to start fires; a type of microcrystalline quartz used for making tools, weapons, and jewelry

synonym: hardstone, tinder, firestone

(1) **flint** tools, (2) the **flint** on my lighter

The archeologist found a flint arrowhead on the dig site.

trauma

 an emotional wound or shock often has long-lasting effects caused by a highly upsetting or shocking experience

synonym: agony, injury, ordeal

# (1) psychic trauma, (2) trauma care

Many civilians have suffered **trauma** as a result of the war.

### traffic

 the movement of vehicles, people, or goods along a route or through a transport system; the amount of such movement in a particular place or at a particular time

synonym: congestion, jam, flow

(1) traffic jam, (2) heavy traffic

We decided to take a detour to avoid the construction **traffic** on the main road.

### commitment

 a promise or firm decision to do something or to behave in a certain way

synonym: burden, obligation, promise

(1) a **commitment** to an alliance, (2) meet his **commitments** 

His business commitments took him to the United States.

#### broad

adj. very wide; general

synonym: wide, expansive, comprehensive

(1) attract broad attention, (2) a broad mind

He accumulated wealth across a broad spectrum of assets.

#### critic

 someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

(1) art critic, (2) severe critic

Advocates for legal reform hear less harsh words from their **critics**.

#### mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

synonym: abundance, crowd, mob

(1) a mass of molten rock, (2) critical mass

The **mass** of people who do not own property is politically

# impotent.

### audacious

 adj. showing a willingness to take bold risks or to do something that is considered unconventional or daring; marked by originality, creativity, or boldness

synonym: bold, daring, fearless

(1) audacious stunt, (2) audacious decision

The young entrepreneur had an **audacious** plan to start his own company.

### intervention

- n. the action or process of being done to improve or help a circumstance, often they have not been asked to do sosynonym: interference, intercession, treatment
- (1) **intervention** by foreign powers, (2) surgical **intervention**

This **intervention** does not require the patient's consent.

## frontline

- adj. in the most critical or dangerous position; in the military line or part of an army closest to the enemy
- synonym: battlefront, cutting edge
- (1) **frontline** health workers, (2) at the **frontline** of the war Within days, the new aircraft was in **frontline** service.

# deploy

- v. to move troops or weapons into a position or military action; to bring into something in an effective way synonym: set up, expand, launch
- (1) **deploy** troops for battle, (2) **deploy** safety measures This country **deployed** its weapons in the east region.

# disrupt

- to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance
- synonym: interrupt, disturb, break into
- (1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

# unparalleled

adj. without parallel, equal in size, amount, quality, etc.; better or worse than any other

synonym: outstanding, phenomenal, remarkable

(1) **unparalleled** views, (2) an **unparalleled** achievement Several American technology companies have achieved **unparalleled** success in terms of customer numbers.

#### revival

an instance of bringing something back to life,
 popularity, or prominence; a period of renewed interest or enthusiasm in something that was previously considered outdated or old-fashioned

synonym: resurgence, reawakening, renaissance

(1) **revival** meeting, (2) **revival** of the economy The town's economy experienced a **revival** after opening a new factory.

#### festival

 a celebration or event, usually marking a particular religious or cultural occasion, often involving processions, music, dancing, and the performance of plays or other artistic works

synonym: fair, holiday, celebration

(1) **festival** attendee, (2) international film **festival**The music **festival** attracts visitors from all over the world.

#### announcement

 a public statement or declaration, often made in writing or through the media, that conveys important information or news

*synonym*: declaration, notification, statement

(1) public **announcement**, (2) **announcement** date The company made an **announcement** about its new product at a press conference.

#### culminate

v. to reach a peak or climax synonym: end, finish, conclude

(1) **culminate** in a heart attack, (2) **culminate** in failure The event will **culminate** in a grand fireworks display.

sacred

adj. connected with religion or religious purposes; worthy of respect or dedication because of a connection with a god

synonym: holy, inviolable, hallowed

(1) **sacred** music, (2) the halo of a **sacred** image
This space is a private office **sacred** to the President

pilgrim

 a person who journeys, especially a long distance, to a sacred place as an act of religious devotion

synonym: traveler, wayfarer, sojourner

(1) shrine for pilgrims, (2) pilgrim site

The group of **pilgrims** walked in silence, deep in thought and prayer.

rigorous

adj. allowing or demanding no deviation from a standard; extremely careful, thorough, or accurate

synonym: severe, exact, strict

rigorous standards, (2) have rigorous criticism
 The way he manages his employees is extremely rigorous.

recruit

v. to persuade someone to work for a company; to find new members for an organization, the armed forces, etc.

synonym: raise, enroll, enlist

(1) **recruit** a good worker, (2) **recruit** a new hire The colonial government **recruited** militia support when civil war broke out.

strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

military strategy,
 develop a strategy
 our plan includes a comprehensive marketing strategy.

nutrition

 the substances or the process that organisms take into their bodies as food for their growth and health

synonym: alimentation, nourishment, sustenance

(1) **nutrition** condition, (2) **nutrition** intake

This food contains all the **nutrition** your dog requires.

# storytelling

- n. the act or art of narrating or writing storiessynonym: narrating, relating, recounting
- (1) **storytelling** performance, (2) courtroom **storytelling** She was skilled in **storytelling** techniques, such as using different voices for other characters.

# certify

v. to formally state, especially in writing, that something is true

synonym: accredit, approve, authorize

(1) **certify** product quality, (2) **certify** the authenticity of the painting

As a witness, I can **certify** his innocence.

#### outdo

- v. to do better than someone; to surpass synonym: excel, surpass, outshine
- (1) **outdo** him in trickery, (2) **outdo** the competition He tried to **outdo** his rival by breaking the world record.

### advocate

- n. a person who supports or suggests an idea, development, or way of doing somethingsynonym: proponent, exponent, promoter
- (1) an **advocate** of disarmament, (2) public education **advocates**

**Advocates** of abolishing the death penalty often argue that the alternative heaviest sentence should be life in prison.

# unprecedented

adj. never having been seen, done, or known before synonym: novel, outstanding, unparalleled

(1) **unprecedented** boom, (2) **unprecedented** business opportunity

**Unprecedented** amounts of heckling and slogan-shouting took place throughout the event.

#### institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

(1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

# healing

 n. the process of becoming or making somebody or something well again

synonym: recovery, recuperation, convalescence

(1) natural **healing** ability, (2) part of the **healing** process Each ancient tribe has its **healing** traditions.

# urgent

adj. requiring immediate attention or action; pressingsynonym: pressing, critical, immediate

(1) an **urgent** telegram, (2) **urgent** situation It is **urgent** that we leave for the airport now to catch our flight.

# plain

adj. without being decorated in any way; (Noun) a vast expanse of flat land with few trees

synonym: basic, straight, bare

(1) plain answer, (2) delta plain

The lowest lowland region is mostly flat plain.

# sight

- n. the ability to see; anything that is seensynonym: vision, spectacle, view
- an unexpected sight, (2) dull sight
   Many famous sights are within walking distance.

#### refuse

- v. to show that one is not willing to do or accept something synonym: turn down, deny, decline
- refuse a request, (2) refuse the company
   my initial reaction was to refuse.

# acknowledge

v. to accept or admit the existence, reality, or truth of something; to accept that someone or something has a particular authority or quality; to express obligation, thanks, or gratitude for someone's help, commitment, etc.;

synonym: accept, agree, declare

(1) **acknowledge** the deed, (2) **acknowledge** his help He never **acknowledged** his fault.

#### crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

*synonym*: concern, problem, emergency

(1) financial **crisis**, (2) **crisis** management The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

# injustice

- n. a violation of the rights of others or the laws of a society synonym: unfairness, bias, discrimination
- (1) gross **injustice**, (2) **injustice** system

  The **injustice** of the court's decision angered many people and led to protests.

# propel

v. to move, drive or push something forward or in a particular direction, often with a lot of force

synonym: drive, push, move

(1) propel growth, (2) propel the ship

An increase in employment helps **propel** economic growth.

## garner

to acquire or accumulate something through effort or attention

synonym: acquire, collect, obtain

(1) **garner** good reviews, (2) **garner** attention

He used his charm and charisma to **garner** support for his campaign.

#### choke

v. to prevent or obstruct the normal breathing or swallowing of someone or something

synonym: strangle, suffocate, clog

(1) **choke** with anger, (2) **choke** off the blood supply The baby started to **choke** on a piece of apple.

#### relate

v. to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

synonym: connect, link, associate

(1) **relate** a story, (2) **relate** a message He tried to **relate** his experience to the group, but they couldn't understand.

# spouse

- n. a person's husband, wife, or partner in marriagesynonym: partner, mate, wife
- (1) **spouse** tax deduction, (2) **spouse** visa

  The **spouse** of the politician was a constant presence at campaign events.

# crumble

- v. to break or fall apart into small pieces or fragments, especially due to age, decay, or lack of supportsynonym: disintegrate, collapse, deteriorate
- (1) **crumble** to dust, (2) began to **crumble** under financial pressure

The old building was starting to **crumble** due to years of neglect and lack of maintenance.

### infrastructure

 the basic systems, services, or features that are necessary for an organization or country, such as transport and power supplies

synonym: foundation, framework

(1) IT **infrastructure**, (2) **infrastructure** cost Aging societies tend to require huge costs for **infrastructure** maintenance.

# inequality

 the unfairness of a society in which some people have more opportunity, money, etc. than others; (mathematics) relation between two values when they are different

synonym: imbalance, prejudice, unfairness

(1) **inequality** in salary, (2) algebraic **inequality**There are several causes of economic **inequality** within societies.

# underground

adj. under the surface of the ground; a secret group organized to achieve a specific purpose, such as overthrowing the government or occupying a force
 synonym: subterranean, subsurface, confidential

(1) water flowing **underground**, (2) **underground** activist Having **underground** parking has been very beneficial throughout the winter.

### railroad

- metal tracks laid with rails on which trains run; a system of tracks with the trains operated by an organization
   synonym: railway, track, railway system
- (1) coast-to-coast **railroad**, (2) **railroad** industry

  The town was founded in the 19th century as a stop on the **railroad**, and it grew rapidly as a result.

#### stream

 a small, narrow river; a continuous flow of something, such as liquid, gas, people, vehicles, etc.

synonym: flow, current, brook

(1) the **stream** of time, (2) an endless **stream** of cars

Jet **streams** are the common name for air currents that form high in the atmosphere.

#### influencer

n. a person or thing that affects or changes someone's or something's behavior, especially a person with the ability to affect potential buyers of a product or service through recommendations on social media

synonym: tastemaker, bellwether

(1) high-profile influencer, (2) influencer marketing

My team measures the effectiveness of advertising with social media **influencers**.

#### urban

adj. relating to or located in a town or city synonym: metropolitan, civic

(1) **urban** planning, (2) **urban** property owners
Only a small number of **urban** utilities offer sanitation services.

#### blast

 explosion, or a strong current of air, usually caused by an explosion; a sudden, thunderous noise

synonym: blow, burst, explosion

(1) a blast of wind, (2) an icy blast

The **blast** shattered the laboratory equipment.

# interrupt

v. to say or do something that causes someone to stop in their speech or action

synonym: disturb, hinder, break in

(1) interrupt a call, (2) abruptly interrupt

Her sleep was interrupted by recurring pain.

### confusion

 the state of being mixed up or unclear, or the state of disorder or uncertainty

synonym: disorder, disarray, chaos

(1) administrative **confusion**, (2) in great **confusion**The sudden policy change has caused **confusion** among employees.

#### historic

*adj.* famous or significant in history, or potentially so *synonym*: memorable, momentous, historical

(1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

#### dense

adj. containing a large number of people or something with little space between them

synonym:

heavy, thick, idiotic

(1) nutrient- **dense** foods, (2) **dense** forests

The entire mountain is covered in **dense** rainforest.

# camouflage

n. an outward appearance that conceals the underlying essence of something; the way of concealing troops or military equipment so they cannot be seen against the surrounding environment

synonym: guise, mask, cloak
