	to navigate it safely.
rev	<ul> <li>n. a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute</li> </ul>
	synonym: revolution, RPM, speed
	(1) low- <b>rev</b> engine, (2) <b>rev</b> up the crowd

prefer	v. to like, choose, or want one thing or person better than another
	synonym: choose, like, favor

drone	<i>n</i> . a low continuous humming noise; someone who takes more time than necessary; a pilot-less aerial vehicle that is operated by remote control

adapt	<ul> <li>v. to make fit for or change to suit a new purpose or environment</li> </ul>

recall	v. to remember something
