### evolve

### separate

# planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

### flesh

 the soft substance composing the body of a person or animal, as opposed to bones and other structures

synonym: meat, muscle, tissue

### munch

v. to chew or eat something noisily, often with the sound of crunching or crunching

# boggy

# pitcher

### vivid

adj. producing very clear, powerful, and detailed images in the mind

#### scent

- n. a distinctive smell, especially a pleasant one synonym: fragrance, aroma, perfume
- natural scent, (2) scent memory
   The scent of freshly baked bread filled the bakery.

# slurp

 to eat, drink, or consume with a loud or messy sucking noise; to make a loud or messy sucking noise while eating, drinking, or consuming

synonym: sip, gulp, drink noisily

(1) slurp tea, (2) slurp noodles

The child couldn't resist **slurping** her soup loudly at the dinner table.

### nectar

 a sweet liquid produced by flowers that attracts and provides food for bees and other insects; any sweet liquid that is enjoyed as a drink or used as a flavoring

# ingredient

one of the things used to make something, especially one of the foods used to make a particular dish

synonym: element, component

#### narcotic

n. a drug or substance that dulls the senses and induces a state of lethargy or sleep; a drug that is illegal or highly regulated for medical use due to its ability to cause addiction or harm

synonym: drug, sedative, opiate

The doctor prescribed a **narcotic** painkiller to alleviate her chronic pain.

# sluggish

adj. lacking energy, vitality, or motivation; slow or inactive in response, movement, or progress

### funnel

a tube or pipe that is wide at the top, sloping sides, n. narrow at the bottom, used for pouring liquids or powders into a small opening; a smokestack on a ship or steam engine

(1) separatory funnel, (2) a funnel-shaped device We have to use a **funnel** to pour petrol into the tank.

liquid

a substance, such as water or oil that flows freely and is neither a solid nor a gas

synonym: fluid

(1) colorless liquid, (2) hazardous liquid The sponge takes up the **liquid** well.

### drown

to die or cause to die by being unable to breathe underwater

synonym: douse, drench, overwhelm

(1) **drown** in a bath, (2) I was **drowned** in work Floods have the potential to **drown** any subsurface animals easily.

### enzyme

- a substance produced by a living organism that acts as a catalyst to bring about a specific biochemical reaction synonym: catalyst, activator, accelerator
- (1) **enzyme** reaction, (2) lack of digestive **enzymes** A deficiency in the **enzyme** can lead to a medical condition.

### bacteria

n. single-celled or noncellular spherical or spiral or rod-shaped organisms that exist in large numbers in the air, water, and soil, and also in living and dead creatures and plants, and are often a cause of disease

synonym: microorganism, microbe

(1) pathogenic **bacteria**, (2) harmless **bacteria Bacteria** prevalent in hospitals are often resistant to antibiotics.

# microscopic

adj. tiny; exceedingly precise and detail-oriented; of or used in microscopy

# particle

 a small piece of something; a word or piece of a term with grammatical function but little or no significance

synonym: atom, grain, bit

#### consume

v. to spend something, especially fuel, energy, or time, in a large amount

synonym: absorb, ingest, use up

# occasionally

adv. now and then; sometimes but not oftensynonym: periodically, sometimes, from time to time

### tumble

v. to fall suddenly, often uncontrollably; to topple or turn over; to decline sharply and quickly in value, quality, or performance

victim

 a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

sticky

adj. made of or covered with an adhesive substance; hot or warm and humid

sundew

 a small carnivorous plant that captures and digests insects using sticky hairs on its leaves

synonym: carnivorous plant, drosera

equip

 to provide a person or a place with the things that are needed for a particular purpose or activity

*synonym*: prepare, furnish, provide

### viscous

adj. having a thick, sticky consistency between solid and liquid; exhibiting resistance to flow

synonym: thick, syrupy, gooey

# mucilage

a type of viscous, gel-like substance produced by some plants, often used for medicinal or culinary purposes
 synonym: gel, slime, goo

The **mucilage** in aloe vera gel can help soothe sunburned skin.

ant

 a very small insect that lives under the ground or in a mound in highly organized groups

synonym: pismire, insect

swift

 a sticky or slimy substance, often of indeterminate or unknown composition; a slang term used to describe something messy, chaotic, or confusing

synonym: slime, muck, gunk

# struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) struggle against discrimination, (2) struggle to get the

job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

### specification

 a detailed description of the characteristics, features, or requirements of something, typically a product or system; a written statement that outlines the standards, procedures, or requirements for a project or job

synonym: description, requirement, guideline

(1) functional **specification**, (2) engineering **specification**The project's **specifications** outlined the goals and requirements for the team to complete.

### tentacle

- a flexible, mobile, and long arm-like organ used for feeling and holding things, catching food, or moving
- (1) a squid's **tentacle**, (2) posterior **tentacle**The police caught the fugitive criminal in the **tentacles** of an expanded investigation.

#### movement

n. a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

curl

 to form or make something form into a curved or spiral shape; (noun) a round shape formed by a series of concentric circles

synonym: coil, curve, spiral

curl around street corners, (2) a curl of smoke
 The cat curled into a ball and went to sleep.

clench

v. to close tightly or grip firmly; to contract or stiffen, especially as in response to stress or pain; to tighten or compress

synonym: grasp, clasp, tighten

(1) clench teeth, (2) clench muscles

He **clenched** his fist in anger when he heard the bad news.

### suffocate

v. to die or cause someone to die from lack of air or inability to breathe; to be overwhelmed or constricted by a feeling or situation, such as anxiety or oppression

synonym: choke, smother, stifle

(1) suffocate to death, (2) suffocate fire

People can **suffocate** from a lack of oxygen in confined spaces.

# grip

n. the act of holding onto something firmly with your hands, or the ability to do so; (verb) to hold fast or firmly

synonym: grasp, clasp, (verb) hold

He had a firm **grip** on the rope as he climbed the mountain.

# asphyxiate

v. to make someone unable to breathe, usually resulting in unconscious or death

### unfurl

#### snare

# underground

adj. under the surface of the ground; a secret group organized to achieve a specific purpose, such as overthrowing the government or occupying a force

synonym: subterranean, subsurface, confidential

### corkscrew

coil

 a twisting device used for opening bottles or jars with a cork or other stopper, typically consisting of a spiral metal rod attached to a handle

# oxygen

# tadpole
