synonym: purpose, mapping, job

## discovery

## spectacular

#### dementia

a severe decline in cognitive function, especially memory, as a result of disease or injury

fade

- v. to vanish; to fade away; to lose color; to lose freshness synonym: languish, wither

## decline

to become gradually smaller, fewer, worse, etc.; to refuse to accept

synonym: descend, drop, deny

v. to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

#### co-occurrence

 the simultaneous occurrence or presence of two or more things, often used in statistical or scientific contexts

synonym: simultaneity, coincidence, conjunction

(1) **co-occurrence** pattern, (2) **co-occurrence** matrix

The **co-occurrence** of these two events suggests that there may be a causal relationship between them.

#### interrelated

adj. closely connected or related to each other synonym: connected, related, interdependent

## disrupt

v. to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

## cognitive

adj. of or relating to mental processes of understanding synonym: perceivable, mind, mental

#### **Alzheimer**

 a neurodegenerative disease that causes memory loss, cognitive decline, and behavioral issues; is the most common cause of dementia in older adults

synonym: dementia, memory loss, cognitive decline

(1) **Alzheimer's** brain, (2) **Alzheimer's** risk factors My grandmother has **Alzheimer's** disease requires special care and attention from her caregivers.

disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

(1) **disease** prevention, (2) **disease** control

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

#### remarkable

*adj.* worthy of attention because unusual or special *synonym*: outstanding, exceptional, extraordinary

## depress

- v. to make someone feel sad, low in spirits, or without hope; to make markets, businesses, etc., less active

#### associate

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

#### fiend

an evil or wicked person or supernatural being;
 someone who is excessively devoted or addicted to something

synonym: monster, demon, devil

## puzzle

 a situation that is difficult to follow or solve; a game, problem, or toy that tests a person's ingenuity or knowledge; (verb) to cause someone to feel confused because of something difficult to understand

synonym: plight, maze, (verb) perplex

(1) crossword **puzzle**, (2) mathematical **puzzle**This jigsaw **puzzle** is challenging because there are no pictures.

## exciting

- adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement synonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling
- (1) exciting football player, (2) exciting news

## unfortunately

adv. by bad luck; unluckily synonym: regrettably, unluckily, alas

#### blunt

adj. having a dull or rounded edge or point; not sharp;
 straightforward in speech or manner, often to the point of being rude or insensitive

### instrument

 an object used to make musical sounds, such as a piano, guitar, or drum; a tool or device used for a specific activity, particularly in specialist or scientific work

#### naturalism

- a philosophical belief that everything, including human behavior and cognition, can be explained solely by natural causes and laws
- (1) **naturalism** in literature, (2) philosophical **naturalism** The scientific method is often seen as an embodiment of **naturalism**, as it seeks to understand the natural world through observation and experimentation.

## develop

## moonshot
