dissolve

- *synonym*: disband, disappear, liquefy
- (1) **dissolve** the sugar, (2) officially **dissolved** the marriage The political party **dissolved** after much internal fighting.

drown

- v. to die or cause to die by being unable to breathe underwater
- synonym: douse, drench, overwhelm
- (1) **drown** in a bath, (2) I was **drowned** in work Floods have the potential to **drown** any subsurface animals easily.

homesick

- adj. feeling sad or nostalgic for one's home, family, or familiar surroundings, especially when away from them for a significant length of time
- synonym: nostalgic, longing, yearning
- (1) suffer from homesick, (2) homesick for home

The military personnel stationed overseas often feel **homesick** for their loved ones.
