smartphone

- a mobile phone that functions as a computer and connects to the Internet
- (1) **smartphone** app developer, (2) **smartphone** addict Internet traffic volumes have increased significantly with the advent of smartphones.

stroll

to walk somewhere in a slow, relaxed way and with no apparent aim

synonym: amble, roam, mope

(1) **stroll** across a street, (2) **stroll** through the countryside We could **stroll** into town if you like.

particulate

adj. consisting of small particles, especially those that are suspended in a fluid or air

synonym: granular, dusty

(1) particulate size, (2) particulate pollution Smoke from forest fires is causing an increase in particulate matter in the air.

bloodstream

- the blood flowing through the body
