dropout

 a person who leaves school, college, or a training program before completing it

synonym: noncompleter, quitter, school leaver

hightail

- v. to move, run, or flee at high speed or with great urgency;to depart quickly or suddenly from a place or situationsynonym: flee, scamper, bolt

We'll miss our flight if we don't **hightail** it to the airport right now.

outrun

v. to run faster or farther than someone or something else, often to escape from danger or capture; to outpace or outmaneuver someone or something in a competition or pursuit

synonym: outpace, outrank, outdistance

(1) **outrun** competitors, (2) **outrun** the cops I'll need to **outrun** the rainstorm to make it home without getting soaked.

restless

adj. unwilling or unable to stay still or relax because you are worried and uneasy

synonym: agitated, anxious, disturbed

(1) a restless person, (2) restless waves

He felt **restless** and constantly changed his postures.

tweak

v. to pinch or squeeze something sharply; to adjust something finely

synonym: nip, pinch, fine-tune

(1) **tweak** his cheek, (2) **tweak** the economy

He didn't **tweak** the plan, even though he had time.

adversity

- n. difficulties or hardships that someone facessynonym: hardship, difficulty, trial
- (1) environmental **adversity**, (2) struggling with **adversity** The team demonstrated great resilience in the face of **adversity** and won the game.

empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle

indecision

 the inability to make a decision; a state of uncertainty or hesitation

synonym: hesitation, vacillation, ambivalence

quote

v. to repeat or reproduce the words or statement of someone else, often acknowledging the source; to give an estimated cost or price for goods or services

synonym: cite, reference, mention

(1) quote a source, (2) quote a price

In his speech, he **quoted** a famous philosopher to emphasize his point.

catapult

- a device used to hurl an object a long distance *synonym*: launcher, trebuchet, slingshot
- (1) powerful catapult, (2) catapult mechanism The army used a **catapult** to launch large rocks over the castle walls.

paralyze

to cause a person or part of the body to become unable to move or feel

synonym: immobilize, disable, numb

(1) paralyze a city, (2) paralyze a person

The venom from the snake bite **paralyzed** his arm.

intimidate

to make someone fearful or uneasy so that they will do something that you want them to do

synonym: frighten, threaten, terrify

(1) **intimidate** an opponent, (2) effectively **intimidate** a thief The boss tried to **intimidate** his subordinate with threats.

daunting

adj. looking challenging to manage in prospect; making someone anxious and less confident about carrying out something

synonym: intimidating, stunning, disheartening
