#### brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

synonym: intellect, mind, encephalon

#### interconnect

v. to connect similar things

synonym: interlink, complect, annex

(1) directly interconnect with those systems, (2) human activities interconnect with the environmentOur system can now interconnect with other databases.

#### neuron

 a cell that is specialized to carry information within the brain and between the brain and other parts of the body

synonym: nerve cell

(1) excite the **neurons**, (2) **neuron** cell bodyOur body transfers information along each **neuron** using an

electrical impulse.

#### encode

v. to convert information into a code or format suitable for storage or transmission

synonym: transcribe, convert

(1) encode data, (2) encode information

The software can **encode** and decode encrypted messages.

## perspective

a confident attitude toward something; a particular style of thinking about something

synonym: viewpoint, standpoint, outlook

(1) a **perspective** view, (2) the **perspective** of the battle His father's death changed his whole **perspective** on life.

amaze

v. to fill with wonder, surprise, or admiration synonym: astound, surprise, stagger

(1) **amaze** and entertain visitors, (2) **amaze** everyone

The magician's tricks **amazed** the audience.

## ordinary

adj. not different, exceptional, or unexpected in any way, especially in quality, ability, size, or degree

synonym: mundane, prosaic, average

(1) an **ordinary** school, (2) **ordinary** annual revenue The **ordinary** session of the Diet opened.

## revolutionary

adj. relating to or characterized by a complete or dramatic change

synonym: radical, innovative, groundbreaking

(1) **revolutionary** change, (2) enforce **revolutionary** justice The **revolutionary** leader inspired others to join the fight for freedom and democracy.

#### neuroscience

- the scientific study of the function, structure, and disorder of the brain and the nervous system
- (1) the branch of **neuroscience**, (2) a theoretical concept in **neuroscience**

Our university is famous for its professors, who are well-versed in behavioral **neuroscience**.

## congress

 a formal meeting of the representatives of different countries, constituent states, organizations, trade unions, political parties, or other groups

synonym: legislature, parliament, assembly

(1) an international **congress**, (2) peace **congress Congress** must consider this proposal in an unusual situation.

sect

 a group of people who follow a particular religious or philosophical belief system, especially one that is regarded as outside the norm or mainstream

synonym: group, faction, cult

(1) sect beliefs, (2) secret sect

The minority **sect** believed in a set of unconventional religious practices.

#### clitoral

adj. relating to or involving the clitoris, a sensitive organ in female sexual anatomy that is key to sexual pleasure

synonym: vaginal, vulval, genital

(1) clitoral hood, (2) clitoral orgasm

Some women report increased sexual pleasure from clitoral stimulation.

#### stimulation

the act of arousing interest or activity in something; the action of providing a stimulus

synonym: activation, arousal, excitation

(1) **stimulation** of the economy, (2) **stimulation** of the senses

The **stimulation** of certain chemicals activates the brain's reward system.

#### induce

to persuade someone to do something; to cause to act in a specific manner

synonym: cause, encourage, persuade

(1) **induce** a crisis, (2) **induce** him to see a doctor The lack of sleep **induces** both physical and psychological diseases.

#### stimulate

to encourage something to develop or become more active; to stir the feelings or emotions

synonym: excite, provoke, arouse

(1) **stimulate** the economy, (2) **stimulate** the nervous system

The book **stimulated** my imagination.

## repetition

- the act of doing or saying something many times synonym: duplication, iteration, recurrence
- (1) **repetition** of the word, (2) habitual **repetition Repetition** is the mother of all learning.

## skeptical

adj. doubting that something is accurate or useful synonym: doubtful, distrustful, suspicious

# (1) a **skeptical** attitude, (2) **skeptical** scientists His religious and philosophical beliefs were utterly **skeptical**.

## investigate

v. to conduct a systematic or formal inquiry to identify and evaluate the facts of a crime, problem, statement, etc. to establish the truth

synonym: examine, analyze, look into

(1) **investigate** the matter, (2) **investigate** a data leak The committee **investigated** several apparent inconsistencies.

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

#### communicate

 to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

*synonym*: convey, share, transmit

- (1) **communicate** his anxieties to the psychiatrist,
- (2) **communicate** well with my advisor

Dolphins use sound to **communicate** with each other.

#### taboo

*adj.* prohibited or restricted by social custom *synonym*: forbidden, prohibited, proscribed

(1) a taboo word, (2) academic taboo

In this society, discussing politics in public is a taboo subject.

### medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of diseasesynonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) **medicinal** chemistry, (2) traditional **medicinal**The **medicinal** properties of this herb have been known to help with various ailments.

#### hormone

- a chemical substance made by organs that encourages or influences the development, growth, sex, etc., of an animal and is carried around the body in the blood
- hormone secretion, (2) female hormone
   The doctor diagnosed me with a hormone disorder.

#### desire

- n. a strong feeling of wanting to have or do somethingsynonym: ambition, appetite, greed
- unsatisfied desire, (2) fleshly desire
   Low sexual desire typically correlates with low testosterone levels.

#### convinced

- adj. completely certain about something; having a strong belief or conviction in a particular religionsynonym: confident, positive, indoctrinated
- (1) **convinced** of the idea, (2) **convinced** criminal The public is **convinced** that the prime minister has committed fraud.

## physiological

adj. relating to the normal functioning of living organisms and their organs and systems; concerning the physical or biochemical processes and activities that occur within the body

synonym: biological, organic, bodily

(1) **physiological** response, (2) **physiological** activity The doctor explained the various **physiological** changes that occur during pregnancy.

## psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

#### relate

v. to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

synonym: connect, link, associate

(1) relate a story, (2) relate a message

He tried to **relate** his experience to the group, but they couldn't understand.

## **lancet**

 a sharp, pointed surgical instrument used for making incisions or punctures, typically in medical procedures

synonym: scalpel, blade, surgical instrument

(1) lancet device, (2) surgical lancet

The doctor used a **lancet** for a small incision on the patient's skin.

## approximately

adv. close to a specific number or time but not exactly that number or time

synonym: about, around, roughly

(1) **approximately** 3 feet long, (2) **approximately** same This trail takes **approximately** 2.5 hours.

#### testosterone

- a male hormone that is responsible for the development of male secondary sex characteristics
- (1) **testosterone** enhancer, (2) a synthetic derivative of **testosterone**

Training with sufficient intensity increases blood **testosterone** levels.

## dopamine

- a chemical substance produced by nerve cells as a neurotransmitter; as a drug, it is used to treat shock and hypotension
- (1) **dopamine-inhibiting** agent, (2) antagonism of **dopamine**

The drug controls the level of **dopamine** in the brain.

#### prolactin

- a hormone secreted by the pituitary gland that stimulates milk production in mammals, especially in females, after giving birth
- (1) **prolactin** inhibitor, (2) **prolactin** receptor High levels of **prolactin** in men can cause infertility and decreased libido.

## oxytocin

- a hormone secreted by the pituitary which stimulates contractions of the uterus during labor (= the process of pushing out a baby) and the ejection of milk
- (1) **oxytocin-degrading** enzyme, (2) **oxytocin** receptor Women may increase **oxytocin** production through romantic love.

## segregate

- v. to separate or set apart from others, often based on race, gender, or some other characteristic
- synonym: isolate, separate, divide
- (1) **segregate** by race, (2) **segregate** boys and girls The school board decided to **segregate** students by the ability to meet their needs better.

## orgasm

- the peak of sexual pleasure during sexual activity, which typically involves intense physical and emotional sensations
- synonym: climax, peak, ejaculation
- (1) experience **orgasm**, (2) genital **orgasm**Upon reaching **orgasm**, the body releases a surge of hormones, including oxytocin and endorphins.

## ignore

- v. to intentionally not listen or pay attention to synonym: neglect, disregard, shun
- (1) **ignore** her advice, (2) **ignore** a ban Since independence, the area has been completely **ignored**.

#### internal

- adj. of or relating to the inside of something synonym: interior, inner, domestic
- (1) internal organs, (2) the internal economy

The prime minister canceled visits to other countries to resolve **internal** disputes.

#### exterior

adj. situated in or suitable for the outdoors or outside of something

*synonym*: external, outward, outer

(1) glass exterior, (2) new exterior design

Four **exterior** walls surround the courtyard.

## glans

 the sensitive, rounded end of the penis or clitoris, often covered by a foreskin or hood in males and females, respectively

synonym: tip, head

(1) glans sensitivity, (2) glans clitoris

The **glans** of the penis are the most sensitive part and are often stimulated during sexual activity.

tip

n. the top or extreme point of something slender or tapering, usually a mountain or hill; a piece of advice about something practical; a small amount of money given for services

synonym: edge, advice, gratuity

(1) the tip of a paintbrush, (2) give the waiter a tip.I will introduce some tips on learning English in this class.

iceberg

a large piece of ice floating in the sea, detached from a glacier

synonym: glacier, ice mass, floe

(1) hit an iceberg, (2) iceberg melting

The ship encountered a series of **icebergs** and had to change its course.

## triangular

adj. having three angles or sides; forming or shaped like a triangle (= a three-sided polygon)

synonym: three-cornered, trilateral

(1) a triangular alliance, (2) triangular form

The triangular shape of the pyramid was an important

architectural feature.

#### erect

v. to construct or build something; to cause to rise; (adjective) upright or vertical

synonym: build, set up, construct

(1) **erect** structure, (2) keep the flagpole **erect** 

The workers were able to **erect** the tent in just a few minutes.

## vagina

- n. the passage in the body of a woman or female animal that connects her outer sex organs to her uterussynonym: genitalia, vulva, pudenda
- (1) **vagina** cancer care, (2) infection of the **vagina**The muscle around the **vagina** is elastic enough to allow the passage of a fetus.

#### **spot**

- a particular location or place; a small round or roundish area, differing in color or feels from the surface around it
   synonym: dot, mark, place
- beauty spot, (2) a spot on his honor
   This remote spot is rarely visited.

#### arouse

- v. to awaken strong feelings or emotions in someone; to excite or inspire a physical or emotional response
   synonym: excite, stimulate, stir
- (1) arouse desire, (2) arouse suspicion

The rousing speech by the politician **aroused** the audience to action.

#### centimeter

- a unit of measurement of length in the metric system, equivalent to one-hundredth of a meter
- (1) **centimeter** measurement, (2) thirty **centimeters** tall The room was only one **centimeter** wider than the piano, making it a tight fit.

### upward

adv. toward the top or highest point, or a higher position or level; (adjective) extending or moving toward a higher place synonym: skyward, uphill

(1) look **upward**, (2) demonstrate an **upward** trend The company adjusted the revenue **upward**.

## sympathetic

 adj. feeling, showing, or expressing kindness or compassion to somebody who is hurt, sad, or in a problematic situation

synonym: compassionate, empathetic, understanding

(1) **sympathetic** nervous system, (2) **sympathetic** toward poor people

She is very **sympathetic** to our project.

#### nervous

adj. worried and anxious about something; relating to the nerves

*synonym*: neural, anxious, uneasy

(1) development of the **nervous** system, (2) get **nervous** He suffers from **nervous** breakdowns.

#### norm

- n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standard synonym: criterion, mean, standard
- (1) **norm** of action, (2) cultural **norm**

The systems we have developed has accepted as industry **norms**.

## parasympathetic

adj. relating to the part of the autonomic nervous system that counteracts the effects of the sympathetic nervous system, slowing the heart rate, increasing digestive and glandular activity, and relaxing the sphincter muscles

synonym: relaxing, calming, soothing

(1) parasympathetic nerve inhibitor, (2) parasympathetic response

The **parasympathetic** nervous system helps to regulate the body's involuntary functions, such as digestion and relaxation.

#### relax

v. to become or cause someone to become less active or tense and calmer

synonym: soften, comfort, soothe

(1) **relax** a series of muscles, (2) **relax** at home

The rules were **relaxed** after the new executive arrived.

## pupil

 the black circular opening in the center of the iris of the eye, through which light enters the eye; a student in school or university

synonym: iris, eye aperture, student

(1) pupil constriction, (2) attentive pupil

The **pupil** of your eye dilates in response to different light levels.

#### dilate

- v. to make something wider, larger, or more open synonym: widen, open, enlarge
- (1) **dilate** the bronchial tubes, (2) **dilate** blood vessel The pupils of the eyes **dilate** in low light.

#### release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air
  The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

#### intercourse

 communication between individuals; the sexual activity between individuals, especially the insertion of a man's penis into a woman's vagina

synonym: copulation, intimacy, communication

(1) diplomatic **intercourse**, (2) extramarital **intercourse**That meeting markedly improved commercial **intercourse**between the two countries.

#### groan

v. to make a low, moaning sound, often indicating pain, discomfort, or dissatisfaction

synonym: moan, grunt, sigh

(1) groan in pain, (2) groan for water

The sight of the huge pile of laundry made me groan with

#### dread.

## tachycardia

 a condition characterized by an abnormally fast heartbeat or pulse, usually defined as a resting heart rate of greater than 100 beats per minute

synonym: rapid heartbeat, palpitation, racing heart

(1) paroxysmal **tachycardia**, (2) atrial **tachycardia**His symptoms indicated a case of ventricular **tachycardia**, which can be life-threatening if not treated promptly.

#### blush

v. to become red in the face from embarrassment, shame, or modesty

synonym: flush, redden, glow

(1) **blush** bright red, (2) **blush** for my mistake She **blushed** when the boy complimented her.

## chin

*n.* the lowermost part of a person's face, below the mouth and above the neck

synonym: jaw, mandible, mentum

(1) a jutting chin, (2) chin rest

He scraped his chin when he fell off his bike.

#### fake

adj. not genuine; fraudulent or counterfeit synonym: affected, bogus, counterfeit

(1) fake police officer, (2) spread of fake news

The prime minister was not well prepared for the debate and **faked** it

## regulate

 to control something, especially by means of rules or laws

synonym: control, restrain, handle

- (1) **regulate** blood sugar levels, (2) **regulate** our conduct We must manage to **regulate** our expenditure.
- thread or filament used to make a vegetable tissue, mineral material, or textile

synonym: yarn, thread, wool

#### fiber

(1) carbon **fiber**, (2) synthetic **fiber** 

We must consume dietary **fiber** to maintain good health.

#### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate
- (1) **excite** the crowd, (2) **excite** rebellion The news of her promotion **excited** her.

## premature

 adj. occurring or done too early; happening before the appropriate time; born before the end of a full-term pregnancy

synonym: prematurely born, untimely, early

(1) **premature** birth, (2) **premature** death The **premature** baby was small but healthy.

## ejaculation

 a sudden and forceful expulsion of something from the body, especially of semen, during sexual activity; a sudden and forceful expression of emotion or sound, similar to a cry

synonym: climax, orgasm, cry

- (1) **ejaculation** disorder, (2) inhibited **ejaculation**Diabetes and multiple sclerosis are among the medical conditions that can cause retrograde **ejaculation**.
- dominance
- the state or quality of being the most powerful or influential person or group

synonym: control, mastery, supremacy

(1) **dominance** of traits, (2) **dominance** relationship The company has maintained its **dominance** in the market for several years.

#### submission

 the act of giving a document, proposal, etc., to somebody for consideration or judgment; the act of giving in or yielding to a superior force or authority

synonym: obedience, yielding, compliance

(1) **submission** agreement, (2) **submission** of a final report The **submission** deadline for the project is next week.

#### facilitate

- v. to make something easier or more likely to happen synonym: aid, assist, help
- (1) **facilitate** a smooth transition, (2) **facilitate** the process The company implemented a new software system to **facilitate** employee communication and collaboration.

#### tantra

- a mystical Hindu or Buddhist doctrine that seeks to channel the divine energy of the cosmos to achieve spiritual unity, often through ritualized sexual practices
- synonym: esotericism, meditation, ritual
- (1) tantra meditation, (2) tantra philosophy

The practice of **tantra** involves various spiritual and physical exercises.

## entirely

adv. completely

*synonym*: completely, fully, totally

(1) **entirely** satisfied with the meal, (2) he was **entirely** to blame

Later, his claim was found to be entirely false.

#### sensitive

 adj. able to notice slight changes, signals, or influences; able to feel or perceive other's feelings; susceptible to the things people say or do

synonym: exposed, susceptible, keen

(1) **sensitive** documents, (2) baby with **sensitive** skin The teacher is very **sensitive** to children's feelings.

#### eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

## genital

adj. of or relating to the external and internal reproductive organs

synonym: reproductive, genetic, sexual

(1) **genital** bleeding, (2) pain in the **genital** area The **genital** organs of the human body are necessary for reproduction.

#### external

adj. belonging to or situated outside of someone or something

*synonym*: outside, exterior, foreign

(1) external factors, (2) external commerce

When a company discloses information to the market, an **external** auditor verifies them.

#### volunteer

 a person who performs or offers to perform a job or service without being paid for or forced to do

synonym: unpaid worker, draftee, enlistee

(1) seek volunteers, (2) my volunteer work

The teachers make full use of **volunteer** assistance.

#### restrain

 to prevent or hold back from doing something, often by physical or moral force; to limit or restrict one's actions or behavior; to control or moderate strong emotions or impulses

*synonym*: restrict, limit, control

(1) restrain from violence, (2) restrain a child

The police had to **restrain** the suspect after he became violent during the arrest.

## regard

v. to think about or consider somebody or something in a specified way

synonym: consider, see, reckon

(1) **regard** him as an enemy, (2) **regard** the situation as unfortunate

Frugality and industry are still **regarded** as virtues.

#### repress

v. to restrain or control by force; to suppress feelings or memories

synonym: suppress, control, curb

(1) cannot **repress** laughter, (2) **repress** gene expression

He **repressed** the memories of his traumatic childhood.

## participate

- v. to take part in something
- synonym: take part, partake, enter
- (1) **participate** fully in conversation, (2) **participate** in the program

The majority of students actively **participated** in the college's intramural sports program.

#### rebel

- someone who resists or opposes authority or control, especially by fighting against it
- synonym: insurgent, dissenter, mutineer
- (1) **rebel** uprising, (2) group of **rebels**

The **rebels** fought against the government for their independence.

#### **functional**

- adj. designed for or capable of a particular activity, purpose, or task; practical or ready for use or service
- synonym: applicable, practical, usable
- (1) field of **functional** medicine, (2) **functional** deafness The mobile phone was still **functional** even after being dropped.

## magnetic

- adj. having the properties of attracting or repelling certain materials containing iron or steel
- synonym: attractive, drawing, hypnotic
- (1) magnetic field, (2) a magnetic tape

The magnetic force of the earth keeps our planet spinning.

#### resonance

- a deep, full, or reverberating sound or tone; a quality or feeling of a particular emotional or mental vibration or significance; a mutual or sympathetic connection or correspondence between two things
- *synonym*: echo, vibration, reverberation
- (1) **resonance** frequency, (2) harmonic **resonance** The singer's voice filled the auditorium with beautiful

#### resonance.

#### scan

v. to examine something hastily, with the eyes or with a machine, to get information

synonym: look over, scrutinize, browse

(1) **scan** the face of the man, (2) **scan** a document into PDF She stood on the podium and **scanned** an audience.

### perceive

 to become aware or conscious of something through the senses

synonym: sense, discern, feel

(1) **perceive** a threat, (2) **perceive** light

Australia is widely **perceived** as having low levels of corruption.

#### limbic

- adj. of or relating to the system of the brain that supports a variety of functions, including emotion, behavior, long-term memory, and olfaction
- (1) limbic cortex, (2) limbic epilepsy

The **limbic** brain region responded readily to negative or sad sounds.

## hypothalamus

- a basal part of the brain that autonomically controls body temperature, hunger, and the release of hormones
- (1) anterior **hypothalamus**, (2) **hypothalamus** hemorrhage Oxytocin is also produced in the nucleus of the **hypothalamus**.

#### cortex

- n. the outermost layer of an organ, especially the brain
- (1) **cortex** cells, (2) visual **cortex** neuron The cerebral **cortex** consists of six layers.

#### fantastic

adj. extremely good; excellent

synonym: incredible, unbelievable, marvelous

(1) a **fantastic** dress, (2) absolutely **fantastic** event The new amusement park ride was **fantastic**, with twists, turns, and drops that left riders screaming with excitement.

#### alike

adv. similar or identical in nature or appearance synonym: similar, identical, comparable

(1) young and old **alike**, (2) **alike** in nature

The two paintings looked **alike** as if the same artist had done them.

## diversity

 the quality or fact of many different types of things or people being included in something; a range of different things or people

synonym: variety, multiplicity, variousness

(1) the **diversity** policy of the university, (2) lingual **diversity** He was impressed by the range and **diversity** of the collection.

## opposition

the act of disagreeing or resisting; the state of strong disagreement

synonym: resistance, hostility, antagonism

(1) **opposition** campaign, (2) meet with **opposition** The **opposition** party strongly disagreed with the government's proposed legislation.

## complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

## endocrine

 adj. relating to the glands in the body that secrete hormones directly into the bloodstream to regulate bodily functions and processes

synonym: hormonal, glandular, secretory

(1) **endocrine** disorders, (2) **endocrine** cell

The **endocrine** system regulates many bodily functions,

including metabolism and growth.

## peculiar

adj. odd and uncommon, sometimes in an unpleasant way synonym: bizarre, abnormal, odd

(1) peculiar way, (2) peculiar people

The juice has a **peculiar** taste.

#### attraction

a sense of like someone, particularly sexually;
 something that causes individuals to desire to go to a specific area or do a specific activity

synonym: allure, appeal, interest

(1) the big **attraction** of the event, (2) popular tourist **attraction** 

She felt an instant attraction toward him.

#### attract

- v. to draw or entice someone or something towards them through the qualities they have, especially positive ones synonym: lure, entice, draw in
- (1) attract attention, (2) attract customers

The government is eager to **attract** international investment.

## biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

#### aspect
