## centimeter

- a unit of measurement of length in the metric system, equivalent to one-hundredth of a meter
- (1) **centimeter** measurement, (2) thirty **centimeters** tall The room was only one **centimeter** wider than the piano, making it a tight fit.

# sneaky

adj. behaving in a deceptive or underhanded way; characterized by stealth or secretiveness

synonym: sly, crafty, deceitful

(1) **sneaky** tactics, (2) **sneaky** behavior

The **sneaky** thief slipped into the house through an unlocked window.

# pave

to cover something with a hard, flat material such as stones, bricks, or concrete, to make it suitable for travel or use

*synonym*: surface, coat, cover

(1) **pave** a new path, (2) **pave** a smoother road They **paved** the courtyard with bricks, giving it a more polished appearance.

creep

to move slowly, quietly, and carefully, usually to avoid being seen or heard

synonym: crawl, glide, encroach

(1) **creep** along the leaf, (2) **creep** toward the mouse Aging **creeps** up slowly with time.

sneak

to go somewhere, or take someone or something somewhere secretly or stealthily; to steal or do something secretly or stealthily

synonym: creep, tiptoe, smuggle

(1) **sneak** a cigarette, (2) **sneak** out of danger The children tried to **sneak** out and eat the candy.

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

*synonym*: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

# amphibious

- adj. able to function both on land and in water; able to live in or move between two different environments or settings
- (1) **amphibious** creature, (2) **amphibious** warfare

  The **amphibious** vehicle seamlessly transitioned from land to water.

## fertilize

- v. to cause an egg, female animal, or plant to develop by joining sperm from the male with them; to add a natural or chemical substance to land to make plants grow well
- synonym: pollinate, inseminate, enrich
- (1) **fertilize** the soil, (2) **fertilize** the female egg
  The couple decided to use the non-husband sperm to **fertilize** a wife.

# displace

v. to force someone or something to leave their home or place of origin, especially as a result of conflict, natural disaster, or manipulation

synonym: evict, exile, remove

(1) **displace** workers, (2) **displace** the explosive power The construction of the new dam will **displace** hundreds of families living downstream.

# terrify

- v. to frighten someone very much
- synonym: unnerve, scare, horrify
- (1) **terrify** people, (2) the threats **terrify** him It would be best not to **terrify** your associates into doing complex tasks.

# electrify

v. to make a machine or system work by using electricity; to make someone extremely enthusiastic about or interested in something

synonym: wire, amaze, astonish

(1) **electrify** the audience, (2) **electrify** a manufacturing process

The product developed through years of research continues to **electrify** the market.

#### centenary

a hundredth anniversary or celebration of a hundred years

synonym: centennial, hundredth anniversary

(1) **centenary** event, (2) **centenary** of a book
The country celebrated its **centenary** with parades and fireworks.

# capita

 a Latin word meaning "head," used to express the amount for each person; any head or headlike expansion on a structure, as on a bone

*synonym*: head, headcount, person

(1) per **capita** sales, (2) the agricultural yield per **capita** GDP per **capita** shrunk by almost 10 percent for the third consecutive year.

# megacity

- a huge city, especially with a population of more than 10 million people
- (1) megacity pollution, (2) megacity projectThe fishing village grew rapidly into a bustling megacity.

# beautify

v. to enhance the physical appearance of something by making it more attractive or aesthetically pleasing; to make something more attractive or appealing in general synonym: embellish, enhance, decorate
