penitentiary

 a prison for people convicted of serious crimes; a place for long-term confinement and punishment for convicted criminals

synonym: prison, jail, correctional facility

mania

 a psychological or emotional state that is marked by excessive enthusiasm, excitement, or delusions; a strong and uncontrollable desire or craving for something

synonym: obsession, craze, frenzy

margarita
