### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

#### onset

n. the beginning or early stages of unpleasant something;a military attack

### crush

# electrocardiogram

n. a test that uses electrodes placed on the chest, arms, and legs to record the electrical signals of the heart and create a graph that shows the heart's rhythm and activity

The hospital invested in state-of-the-art **electrocardiogram** machines to improve patient care.

# myocardial

*adj.* relating to the muscular tissue of the heart *synonym*: cardiac, heart-related, ventricular

### infarction

 the obstruction or blockage of blood flow to a specific area or organ, leading to tissue damage or death, commonly used to describe a myocardial infarction (heart attack)

# parlance

# progressive

wane

# regenerative

clot

 a thick mass or lump of coagulated liquid, especially blood; a group of people or things that form an obstructive, unsympathetic, or resistant force

#### corona

# artery

v. to cause an egg, female animal, or plant to develop by joining sperm from the male with them; to add a natural or chemical substance to land to make plants grow well

synonym: pollinate, inseminate, enrich

### cardiovascular
