#### consort

 a spouse, typically the wife or husband of a reigning monarch; a companion or partner, especially one who is a member of the same group or organization

synonym: companion, mate, partner

The politician's advisors counseled him to choose a more suitable **consort** to enhance his public image.

# monastery

 a building or complex of buildings in which members of a male religious community, called monks, live and worship

synonym: abbey, convent, friary

This ancient **monastery** was founded in the 13th century and had a long history of religious devotion.

#### cleanse

v. to purify or get rid of impurities or toxins; to wash or scrub thoroughly, often in a ritualistic or symbolic context; to purge or remove negative or harmful influences or substances from something; (noun) an act of cleaning or purifying something, typically the body

synonym: purify, detoxify, sanitize

## villager
