synonym: bohemian, beatnik, free spirit

#### distracted

#### pothole

 a hole or depression in a road surface, usually caused by wear, weathering, or erosion; can be dangerous to drivers and cause damage to vehicles

synonym: chuckhole, pit, depression

(1) deep **pothole**, (2) **pothole** repair

The car hit a **pothole** and caused a flat tire.

#### envision

v. to imagine or expect what a situation will be like in the future

synonym: anticipate, foresee, picture

(1) **envision** the future, (2) **envision** the project's success We cannot **envision** her as President.

#### stereotype

- a fixed and unvarying idea or image that people have about what someone or something is like, but which is often not true in reality and may cause hurt and offense
- avoid stereotype,
   negative stereotypes
   changing stereotypes about LGBTQ requires considerable effort.

### downplay

v. to present or represent as less important or severe; to minimize the significance of something

synonym: minimize, downsize, play down

(1) **downplay** my ability, (2) **downplay** mistakes

The company tried to **downplay** the significance of the issue.

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

#### disenfranchise

v. to prevent someone from having the right to vote or from having an equal opportunity to vote

synonym: deny, exclude, marginalize

- (1) **disenfranchise** voters, (2) **disenfranchise** citizens The new citizenship laws will **disenfranchise** many immigrants.
- natural and impressive talent or ability, particularly in creativity or self-expression; a distinct style or appearance that is unique and eye-catching

synonym: talent, aptitude, gift

(1) **flair** for design, (2) creative **flair**The chef's artistic **flair** was evident in the beautifully presented dish.

#### tirelessly

flair

- adv. without getting tired or fatigued; persistently,energetically, and continuously working with great effortsynonym: inexhaustibly, indefatigably, unceasingly
- (1) dedicated **tirelessly**, (2) **tirelessly** help out She worked **tirelessly** for hours to finish her project on time.

#### befriend

- v. to become a friend of someone, especially when in need synonym: support, advise, patronize
- (1) **befriend** a young boy, (2) **befriend** other members I'm willing to **befriend** the weak and the poor.

#### bartender

 a person who serves drinks, especially alcoholic beverages, at a bar

*synonym*: barman, mixologist, server

(1) professional **bartender**, (2) moonlight as a **bartender** The chief **bartender** mixed the ingredients to create a new and exciting cocktail.

#### grocer

 a person who owns a shop that sells foodstuffs and some household supplies

synonym: storekeeper

a green- grocer, (2) an old grocer

craze.

#### elated

adj. extremely happy, joyful, or excited, often as a result of success or achievement

synonym: joyful, thrilled, ecstatic

(1) elated mood, (2) elated expression

She was **elated** when she found out she got the job she had hoped for.

#### outlaw

v. to make something illegal; (noun) a person who has committed a crime or has been legally convicted of a crime

*synonym*: ban, prohibit, (noun) bandit

(1) **outlaw** racial discrimination, (2) **outlaw** cloning of human cells

Some communities began to **outlaw** alcohol consumption.

#### sentimental

adj. connected with or resulting from someone's emotions, rather than reason or realism

*synonym*: bathetic, drippy, maudlin

#### unfit

adj. not suitable or good enough for a particular purpose or standard

synonym: inadequate, unsuitable, improper

(1) unfit for the post, (2) physically unfit

The doctor declared him **unfit** for work due to his illness.

#### incandescent

adj. emitting light as a result of being heated; shining brightly; passionate or enthusiastic

*synonym*: glowing, radiant, brilliant

(1) **incandescent** emotion, (2) **incandescent** personality The **incandescent** lights in the room created a warm and inviting atmosphere.

#### landslide

*n.* a large, sudden movement of a mass of rock, earth, or other material down a slope

synonym: avalanche, mudslide, rockfall

(1) landslide victory, (2) prevent a landslide

The massive **landslide** buried the small village under a thick layer of rock and dirt.

#### assassin

- n. a person who murders a prominent or well-known person for political reasons or in exchange for moneysynonym: killer, manslayer

#### deviate

#### resent

v. to feel anger, bitterness, or indignation towards someone or something as a result of unfair treatment or perceived injustice; to harbor negative feelings towards someone or something

synonym: dislike, begrudge, envy

(1) **resent** being called a fool, (2) **resent** their success
He couldn't help but **resent** his friend for always taking credit for his ideas.

#### candlelight

- n. light provided by a candle or candlessynonym: lamp light, oil light, firelight
- (1) **candlelight** dinner, (2) **candlelight** vigil The room was dimly lit by soft **candlelight**.

#### uproar

 a state of loud and confused noise and excitement, especially caused by public protest or dissent

synonym: commotion, fuss, disturbance

(1) a clamorous **uproar**, (2) political **uproar**The **uproar** caused by the announcement of the layoffs was heard throughout the office.

#### preach
