#### tweet

 a short, high sound made by a small bird; a message sent using Twitter, the social media application

### argue

v. to express differing opinions or points of view, often in a heated or contentious manner; to present a case or reasoning to persuade or convince others

### aim

- v. to try or plan to get or achieve something synonym: aspire, direct, target

### empirical

### mathematics

### photoelectric

### panel

### introductory

### equation

### simultaneously

adv. at the same time

#### creative

### slow-motion

 an effect in film-making whereby time appears to be slowed down

### counterintuitive

### backward

### lapse

### routine

### emerge

 to move out of or away from something and become visible

synonym: arise, occur, appear

### reclaim

### progression

n. the act or process of changing to the next stage or phase or moving forward

### ubiquitous

adj. being or existing everywhere at once

#### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

#### clamber

v. to climb or move in an awkward, laborious, or ungraceful way, often using one's hands and feet

### eureka

### wrestling

### displacement

 the act of forcing someone or something to leave their home or place of origin, especially as a result of conflict, natural disaster, or manipulation

The **displacement** of the residents was a consequence of the construction of the new highway.

#### athlete

 a person who competes in one or more sports that involve physical strength, speed, or endurance

synonym: player, contestant, jock

#### random

adj. made, done, or happening without method, conscious decision, or any regular pattern

synonym: incidental, arbitrary, unanticipated

(1) a random choice, (2) bombs fell at random

To find drunk drivers, police conduct **random** tests.

#### medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

*synonym*: health, disease, treatment

(1) a **medical** opinion, (2) temporary **medical** treatment The **medical** team worked quickly to save the patient's life.

### enroll

v. to officially register or sign up for something, particularly a course of study, an organization, or a service

synonym: register, enlist, join

(1) **enroll** at a college, (2) **enroll** in a school

I need to **enroll** in a cooking class to improve my culinary skills.

### critic

 someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

(1) art critic, (2) severe critic

Advocates for legal reform hear less harsh words from their **critics**.

### analyze

v. to think about in-depth and evaluate to discover essential features or meaning

synonym: explore, examine, investigate

#### visual

adj. relating to seeing or sight

synonym: optical, graphical, visible

visual navigation, (2) field of visual arts
 The building makes a remarkable visual impact.

### fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as you

synonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior fellow, (2) nice fellow

He is the kind of **fellow** who only works for his success.

### substantially

adv. to a great extent or degree

synonym: considerably, essentially, largely

(1) the price went up **substantially**, (2) the house was **substantially** built

The proportion of female engineers has **substantially** increased.

### diagnose

v. to determine or distinguish the nature of a problem or an illness through a careful analysis

*synonym*: identify, analyze, interpret

(1) **diagnose** the problem, (2) **diagnose** with CT scans This device is used to **diagnose** brain cancer and other tumors.

#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

### photograph

 a picture or image that is produced by a camera; a visual representation or record of a person, object, or scene that has been captured electronically or on film

#### distinct

adj. noticeable from something else of a similar type synonym: different, special, characteristic

### ophthalmology

 the branch of medicine that deals with the anatomy, physiology, and diseases of the eye

synonym: eye care, optometry, eye medicine

### intimidate

v. to make someone fearful or uneasy so that they will do something that you want them to do

synonym: frighten, threaten, terrify

### origin

n. the first existence or beginning of something

synonym: root, source, ancestor

#### novel

 an extended fictional work in prose; usually in the form of a story; (adjective) original and of a kind not seen before

synonym: fiction, story, (adjective) innovative

### nonfiction

 a genre of literature that deals with the factual representation of real or historical events, people, or places; prose writing that presents or discusses true life events or experiences synonym: fact, reality, truth

This **nonfiction** book about the history of jazz is a must-read for music fans.

### medicinal

adj. of or relating to the treatment or cure of disease synonym: curative, therapeutic, healing

(1) medicinal chemistry, (2) traditional medicinal The medicinal properties of this herb have been known to help with various ailments.

#### commerce

the activity of buying and selling things, especially on a large scale

synonym: trade, transaction, dealings

(1) interstate **commerce**, (2) the local chamber of commerce

This company has invested heavily in Internet **commerce**.

#### stick

to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

*synonym*: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) **stick** a key in a lock, (2) fire **stick** 

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

#### instant

adj. happening immediately, with no delay *synonym*: immediate, urgent, moment

(1) get instant access, (2) an instant reply His pleasant face turned cold in an **instant**.

#### crossword

- a word puzzle consisting of a grid of black and white n. squares and blanks into which words crossing vertically and horizontally are written according to clues
- (1) do a **crossword** puzzle, (2) good at **crossword** puzzles

### puzzle

 a situation that is difficult to follow or solve; a game, problem, or toy that tests a person's ingenuity or knowledge; (verb) to cause someone to feel confused because of something difficult to understand

*synonym*: plight, maze, (verb) perplex

(1) crossword **puzzle**, (2) mathematical **puzzle**This jigsaw **puzzle** is challenging because there are no pictures.

#### timescale

 a period or interval of time, particularly one used as a standard for measuring or comparing other periods of time; a reference point or benchmark for the duration or length of a particular event or process

synonym: time frame, schedule, duration

(1) long- **timescale**, (2) realistic **timescale**The **timescale** for completing the construction project is three years.

### rocket

 a large tube-shaped object that moves very first by a stream of gases let out behind it, used for space travel or as a weapon

synonym: projectile, missile

fantasy

a fiction with a large amount of imagination in it; a
pleasant situation that you imagine but that is unlikely to
happen

- ard n. a person who is skilled in magic or a particular technical field

synonym: sorcerer, magician, alchemist

### wizard

### (1) a wizard at chess, (2) financial wizard

He was a wizard at solving complex mathematical equations.

### stasis

 a state of stillness or immobility, often used in a medical context to refer to a lack of change or progress in a condition or disease

synonym: stillness, inactivity, stagnation

(1) renal stasis, (2) stasis in development

The patient's **stasis** in the hospital was concerning to the doctors.

### depression

 a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

*synonym*: recession, slump, despair

(1) the Great **Depression**, (2) the root problem of her **depression** 

**Depression** symptoms might include a decrease in appetite and weight loss.

### exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitementsynonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

exciting football player, (2) exciting news
 The findings of the experiment were both exciting and

unexpected.

### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

### miraculous

*adj.* very effective or lucky, or completely unexpected *synonym*: amazing, astonishing, awesome

(1) a **miraculous** encounter, (2) go through a **miraculous** change

### He made a **miraculous** recovery.

### achievement

*n*. a thing that someone has accomplished, primarily through their effort and ability

synonym: accomplishment, attainment, triumph

(1) student **achievement**, (2) a remarkable **achievement**This **achievement** has never been formally accepted.

#### exhausted

adj. extremely tired

synonym: drowsy, depleted, fatigued

(1) the **exhausted** food sources, (2) **exhausted** parents The **exhausted** runner fell to the ground and gasped.

### propose

- v. to make a proposal, declare a plan for something synonym: suggest, offer, recommend
- (1) **propose** the amendment, (2) **propose** changes I want to **propose** a toast in honor of our longstanding relationship.

### stimming

n. a behavior often exhibited by individuals on the autism spectrum characterized by repetitive bodily movements or sounds, such as hand flapping or rocking, often used as a form of self-regulation or sensory stimulation

synonym: self-stimulation, repetitive behaviors

(1) autistic **stimming**, (2) **stimming** therapy Autistic children may engage in **stimming** behaviors, such as rocking or hand flapping, to self-regulate.

### emission

- n. the act of production or sending out gas, heat, light, etc.synonym: emanation, radiation, discharge
- (1) global **emissions** of greenhouse gases, (2) the **emission** of light

There are five distinct **emissions** at five unique wavelengths.

#### radiation

the energy that comes from a nuclear reaction in the form of rays, waves, or particles and that can be hazardous to health synonym: dissemination, emission, irradiation

(1) exposure to radiation, (2) electromagnetic radiation He tried every possible treatment, including chemotherapy and **radiation** therapy.

laser

a device that emits powerful and narrow light that can be used as a tool to cut metal through a process of optical amplification

synonym: beam, bar, ray

(1) laser printer, (2) pulse laser

The company holds patents on core components of laser jet printers.

adj. relating to the concepts and principles upon which a particular topic is founded, rather than practice and experience

synonym: conceptual, conjectural, ideal

- (1) theoretical models, (2) theoretical physicist Absolute zero is the lowest **theoretical** temperature.
- a long, sturdy piece of timber, metal, or other material used to support a structure or span a distance; a ray or stream of light emitted by a source

synonym: ray, ray of light, shaft of light

(1) **beam** of light, (2) a structural **beam** of a building The sun's **beam** shone through the window and illuminated the room.

imply

to indicate the truth or existence of something without referring to it

synonym: hint, indicate, denote

(1) **imply** a strong correlation, (2) **imply** the presence of alien

The salespeople speak in technical terms to **imply** that they are more knowledgeable than the customer.

#### universe

 everything that exists, especially all physical matter, including planets, stars, galaxies, and all other forms of matter and energy

synonym: cosmos, macrocosm

(1) theory of the **universe**, (2) expansion of the **universe** The **universe** is about 13.8 billion years old.

#### static

 adj. not moving or not capable of moving, not changing or not capable of changing

synonym: immobile, unchanging, fixed

(1) **static** electricity, (2) **static** website

The **static** image on the screen took a lot of work to make out.

### expand

v. to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

synonym: extend, grow, boost

(1) **expand** a lineup, (2) **expand** agricultural output They hope to **expand** their business worldwide.

### roll

v. to move in a particular direction by turning over and over or from side to side

synonym: spin, swirl, wheel

(1) roll a ball, (2) roll down his cheeks

He was exhausted and **rolled** into bed as soon as he got home.

### overwhelming

adj. very great or intense; so powerful that you cannot fight or react against it

synonym: overpowering, astounding, amazing

(1) **overwhelming** majority, (2) an **overwhelming** victory He has shown signs of uneasiness and **overwhelming** worry.

### straight

adj. extending or moving in one direction without bending or curving; having no deviations

synonym: linear, honest, consecutive

### practical

adj. of or connected with actual use or real situation rather than with theory and ideas

synonym: applicable, functional, realistic

### choreograph

### blur

### boundary

### genre

 a particular type or style of literature, art, music, or film that involves a particular set of characteristics

#### exclude

v. to deny someone or something enter to a place or taking part in an activity

synonym: expel, ban, bar

### cardboard

 a stiff, thick material made from compressed paper pulp used to make boxes and other packaging materials

### inspiration

toss

synonym: motivation, drive, encouragement

#### brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

### digital

adj. processing or storing information as a succession of 1 and 0 to show that a signal is present or missing; relating to the use of computer technology, especially the internet

synonym: numerical, computerized, cyber

### equivalent

- n. having the same value, quality, meaning, purpose, etc.synonym: equal, counterpart, match
- (1) **equivalent** amounts, (2) **equivalent** in meaning The European Central Bank is Europe's **equivalent** of the Federal Reserve.

### urge

v. to spur on or encourage someone, especially by cheers and shouts; (noun) a strong desire or impulse, especially one that is difficult to control or resist

### embrace

### burning

synonym: chart, figure, graph

### initially

adv. at the beginning; at first
