quicksand

stereotype

labor

unequal

identity

uniformity

 the state or quality of being the same or consistent in form, character, or action; the absence of variation or diversity

synonym: uniformness, consistency, sameness

quo

n. the existing state or condition of something, especially in relation to a particular situation or issue

canon

 a set of rules, principles, or standards by which something is judged or measured

synonym: rule, principle, standard

religion

 a deep conviction in a supernatural power that controls human destiny

synonym: faith, creed, belief

(1) **religion** sociology, (2) freedom of **religion**Their **religion** strictly prohibits them from drinking or gambling.

maintain

v. to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

synonym: preserve, uphold, sustain

hierarchy

 a system in which people or things are organized into different levels of importance from highest to lowest

structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

insider

 a person who has privileged access to special or secret information about a particular organization or field

complicit

authentic
