The **genital** organs of the human body are necessary for reproduction.

numb

adj. unable to feel physical sensation and movement; not showing human feeling or sensitivity

synonym: dazed, insensitive, emotionless

(1) **numb** with cold, (2) a **numb** mind

My left arm became **numb**.

sober

 adj. not drunk or affected by alcohol; dignified in manner or character and committed to keeping promises

synonym: calm, lucid, temperate

(1) **sober** discussion, (2) as **sober** as a judge

He led a **sober** life.

pronoun

- n. a word that takes the place of a noun in a sentence,such as "he," "she," "they," or "it"
- (1) pronoun usage, (2) possessive pronoun

In English, personal **pronouns** such as "he," "she," and "they" can replace a person's name to avoid repetition.

medically

- adv. in a way that relates to the practice of medicine and the treatment of illness and injury
- (1) **medically** endorsed method, (2) in a **medically** effective manner

A decade ago, it was **medically** impossible to cure this disease completely.

furious

adj. extremely angry; full of rage

synonym: angry, rageful, livid

(1) furious anger, (2) a furious sea

The coach was furious with the players for their lack of effort

during the game.

disappoint

v. to fail to meet someone or their hopes or expectations; to make someone feel sad

synonym: sadden, dismay, frustrate

(1) **disappoint** the audience, (2) don't **disappoint** me She worked very hard not to **disappoint** her boss's expectations.

nonbinary

adj. someone who does not identify as a man or a woman;not relating to, composed of, or including only two thingssynonym: pluralistic, polyphyletic

(1) **nonbinary** gender, (2) **nonbinary** identities More and more people in various countries believe that the policymaker should change the marriage rules for **nonbinary** people.

low-spirited

- adj. feeling downcast, discouraged, and lacking in energy or enthusiasm; feeling sad or depressedsynonym: gloomy, melancholy, despondent
- (1) **low-spirited** mood, (2) **low-spirited** atmosphere He's been feeling **low-spirited** since his pet passed away.

intersex

adj. having a biological condition in which a person is born with reproductive or sexual anatomy that does not fit typical male or female definitions, often resulting in physical or hormonal differences

synonym: ambigender, nonbinary, hermaphroditic

(1) **intersex** condition, (2) female **intersex**The **intersex** community faces discrimination and marginalization in many societies.

encompass

- v. to surround or cover something completely; to include a large number of or different types of things entirely
 synonym: surround, encircle, include
- (1) **encompass** a broad range, (2) **encompass** the enemy The optimal solution that would **encompass** all these

elements has yet to be proposed.

cisgender

adj. denoting or relating to a person whose sense of personal identity and gender corresponds with their birth sex

synonym: cis, non-trans

(1) **cisgender** identity, (2) **cisgender** person

Cisgender people often don't have to think about their gender identity in the same way that transgender people do

tomboy

 a girl who exhibits characteristics or behaviors that are typically associated with boys, such as a preference for rough play, sports, or wearing boy's clothing

synonym: ladette, hoyden

(1) **tomboy** outfit, (2) **tomboy** personality

The character in the book was a spunky **tomboy** who refused to conform to gender expectations.

transcontinental

adj. spanning or crossing an entire continent or continents *synonym*: cross-country, continental, spanning the nation

confuse

synonym: obstetrics, women's health, women's medicine

empower
