#### degree

award

#### gender

n. the range of characteristics of femininity and masculinity and differentiating between them, especially when considering social and cultural differences rather than differences in biology

synonym: sexuality

gender-blind policies, (2) dual gender

## inequality

 n. the unfairness of a society in which some people have more opportunity, money, etc. than others; (mathematics) relation between two values when they are different

synonym: imbalance, prejudice, unfairness

#### divide

- v. to separate or cause to separate into parts or groups synonym: separate, disconnect, split

#### probable

*adj.* likely to happen or likely to be true *synonym*: likely, possible, potential

## synonymous

adj. having the same or a similar meaning as another word or phrase

synonym: equivalent, interchangeable, similar

#### advancement

 the development, improvement, or progress of something

synonym: progression, breakthrough, improvement

(1) **advancement** of knowledge, (2) career **advancement** Competition between countries resulted in fast technological **advancement**.

#### needle

 a thin, pointed object typically used for sewing or medical purposes; a metal or plastic instrument used for administering injections or drawing blood

synonym: thorn, spike, pin

(1) needle prick, (2) sewing needle

The acupuncturist inserted **needles** into specific points on my body to alleviate my pain.

## compass

 a navigational instrument for finding directions with a needle that can move easily and that always points to the north; the limit or range of capability

synonym: guideline, borderline, ambit

## suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedly

synonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

#### disorient

lag

## roughly

adv. approximately but not precisely; with a violent manner synonym: approximately, more or less, around

#### intersection

#### elite

#### grasp

stark

*adj.* empty, simple, or apparent; devoid of any qualifications *synonym*: crude, blunt, desolate

#### affluent

adj. rich and wealthy; having a lot of money and material wealth

*synonym*: wealthy, rich, prosperous

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

#### racial

- adj. of or related to the race (= classification of humans into groups based on physical traits or social relations)
- synonym: ethnic, tribal, ethnical
- (1) **racial** prejudice, (2) **racial** and ethnic backgrounds A minor **racial** conflict later led to a civil war.

#### injustice

- n. a violation of the rights of others or the laws of a societysynonym: unfairness, bias, discrimination

#### obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

adj. done, made or performed with purpose and intent synonym: deliberate, intended, preplanned

#### **feminist**

 adj. describing a belief in and advocacy for achieving gender equality in social, political, and economic spheres; advocating for the rights and empowerment of women; (noun) a person who believes in and advocates for gender equality between men and women

synonym: egalitarian

(1) **feminist** movement, (2) **feminist** perspective The **feminist** ideals of inclusivity and diversity are important in creating a more just and equal world.

## conspiracy

 a secret agreement between two or more people to perform something harmful or illegal

*synonym*: plot, collaboration, scheme

(1) political **conspiracy**, (2) **conspiracy** theory There was a **conspiracy** of silence about Illegal police interrogation.

## eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

*synonym*: finally, someday, ultimately

#### **overtake**

v. to catch up to and pass by someone or something that is in front of you, usually about moving vehicles; to come to a point where you become more successful, important, or influential than someone or something else

#### barrier

## advantage

rev

a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

He stepped on the gas pedal, and the engine released a loud **rev**.

#### structural

adj. associated with the way on construction or organization of anything

## disadvantage

n. a drawback or a negative aspect of something; (verb) to put someone or something in an unfavorable position

#### brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

#### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

## impulse

 a sudden strong and unreflective wish or need to do something; the electrical discharge that travels along a nerve fiber

synonym: stimulation, provocation, urge

(1) a combative **impulse**, (2) profound religious **impulses**Nerve **impulses** cross a synapse through the action of neurotransmitters.

#### associate

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

#### prefrontal

- adj. in or about the foremost part of the frontal lobe of the brain

- n. the outermost layer of an organ, especially the brain

#### adolescent

 a young person who is in the process of developing from a child into an adult

#### refer

#### etcetera

 used to indicate that some other unspecified items or things could be included besides those already mentioned; and so on

The museum contains a variety of artifacts, from ancient pottery to medieval armor, **etcetera**.

#### cognitive

*adj.* of or relating to mental processes of understanding *synonym*: perceivable, mind, mental

(1) improve **cognitive** function, (2) research on **cognitive** 

psychology

His **cognitive** faculties were getting worse because of a lack of sleep.

#### chemistry

- the branch of the natural sciences dealing with the composition of substances and their properties and reactions
- (1) professor of **chemistry**, (2) the **chemistry** of soil He is familiar with **chemistry** and biology.

## assignment

 a duty or task given to someone, usually as part of their job or studies

synonym: task, duty, designation

#### suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

#### entice

v. to attract or lure someone with something desirable or tempting

synonym: lure, tempt, attract

(1) **entice** foreign investment, (2) **entice** shoppers

The salesperson tried to **entice** the customer into buying a new car.

## psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

## urge

v. to spur on or encourage someone, especially by cheers and shouts; (noun) a strong desire or impulse, especially one that is difficult to control or resist

synonym: push for, advise, (noun) impulse

(1) urge a total ban, (2) a sexual urge

The lobbyist **urged** Congress not to approve the measure.

#### exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement synonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

(1) exciting football player, (2) exciting news

The findings of the experiment were both **exciting** and unexpected.

#### crucial

adj. extremely vital or necessary synonym: essential, pivotal, vital

#### balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a **balance** between work and off.

## grade

- n. a particular level of quality, size, importance, etc.synonym: score, rate, degree
- (1) boys in the twelfth **grade**, (2) students at all **grade** levels Departments may set requirements for a higher **grade** point average.

## backpack

 a bag or pack that is worn on the back, often used for carrying books, equipment, or supplies

synonym: knapsack, rucksack, pack

(1) backpacker's hostel, (2) backpacking trip

I packed my **backpack** with all the necessary camping gear for our trip.

#### label

 a small piece of paper, fabric, or other material attached to an object and giving information about it; (verb) to assign to a category

#### bind

 to tie or fasten someone or something tightly with rope, string, etc. so that they cannot move or are held together strongly

synonym: tie, stick to, adhere

(1) **bind** the man's hands, (2) **bind** old letters into a bundle The company's rules **bind** the employee's working hours.

#### resemble

- v. to look like or be similar to someone or something synonym: look like, be similar to
- (1) **resemble** each other, (2) **resemble** her mother The brothers **resemble** each other in the hobby.

## intelligence

*n.* the ability to learn, comprehend, or make judgments or conclusions based on reasons

synonym: brains, brightness, cleverness

(1) an **intelligence** test, (2) field of artificial **intelligence** In terms of **intelligence**, he was head and shoulders above his classmates.

#### ignore

- v. to intentionally not listen or pay attention to synonym: neglect, disregard, shun
- (1) **ignore** her advice, (2) **ignore** a ban Since independence, the area has been completely **ignored**.

## policy

n. a set of rules, guidelines, principles, or procedures that govern decision-making or action, often used in the context of business or government; a course of action or plan of action adopted or followed by an organization or individual to achieve a goal or objective synonym: strategy, plan, guideline

(1) health **policy**, (2) foreign **policy** 

The company's new **policy** on remote work has made it a more inclusive workplace.

#### sensitive

 adj. able to notice slight changes, signals, or influences; able to feel or perceive other's feelings; susceptible to the things people say or do

synonym: exposed, susceptible, keen

(1) **sensitive** documents, (2) baby with **sensitive** skin The teacher is very **sensitive** to children's feelings.

## specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

synonym: particular, definite, distinct

(1) **specific** instructions, (2) industry- **specific** regulations The scientist conducted a study that provided **specific** details about the species' behavior.

#### vivid

adj. producing very clear, powerful, and detailed images in the mind

synonym: intense, powerful, dazzling

vivid colors, (2) still vivid in my memory
 She made a vivid impression.

## incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

synonym: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

(1) **incredibly** cheerful character, (2) get **incredibly** insecure

Several cities are experiencing **incredibly** high unemployment rates.

## primary

adj. first or highest in rank, order, or importance; most fundamental or essential; pertaining to the initial or introductory stage of something, such as a school year or election cycle synonym: chief, main, fundamental

(1) **primary** school, (2) **primary** education

The **primary** cause of the accident was due to the icy road conditions.

#### interactive

adj. acting reciprocally; mutually responsive synonym: reciprocal, responsive, mutual

(1) **interactive** experience, (2) an **interactive** device The new video game has an **interactive** storyline that allows players to make choices that affect the game's outcome.

#### dispel

to remove something, especially a feeling of fear, doubt, and false idea

synonym: chase away, allay, disperse

(1) **dispel** a painful feeling, (2) **dispel** baseless rumors This program aims to **dispel** certain misconceptions about the disease.

#### historic

*adj.* famous or significant in history, or potentially so *synonym*: memorable, momentous, historical

(1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

#### stem

n. the central part of something from which other parts can develop or grow; the part of a word common to all its inflected variants; (verb) to grow out of, have roots in, or originate in

synonym: branch, limb, (verb) come from

(1) **stem** from a belief, (2) the **stem** of a matchstick A rose has thorns on its **stem**.

#### peg

n. a small cylindrical or tapered pin used to fasten or secure something, such as clothing, on a line, or in carpentry and woodworking; (verb) to fasten or secure something using a peg or similar object; to mark or indicate a level or position using a peg or similar object synonym: pin, dowel, spike

(1) **peg** in the ground, (2) **peg** an exchange rate

The sheep were tagged with numbered plastic **pegs** in their ears.

#### diagnose

v. to determine or distinguish the nature of a problem or an illness through a careful analysis

*synonym*: identify, analyze, interpret

## disability

 a physical or mental condition that makes it difficult for someone to do some things that other people do

#### medic

 a person trained to provide medical care, especially in an emergency

#### medication

 a drug or other form of medicine that treats, prevents, or alleviates the symptoms of the disease

synonym: cure, drug, medicine

#### disable

 to cause someone or something to become unable to function properly or as intended; to incapacitate or immobilize

synonym: cripple, impair, incapacitate

#### disabled

adj. having a physical or mental condition that limits someone's specific actions that most other people can do

synonym: handicapped, impaired, incapacitated

recruit

v. to persuade someone to work for a company; to find new members for an organization, the armed forces, etc.

*synonym*: raise, enroll, enlist

#### movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

launch

v. to send or propel something into the air or space using a device such as a rocket, missile, or spacecraft; to make something available or on sale for the first time

## scholarship

a grant or payment made to support a student's

an occupation or vocation requiring advanced education or specialized training

## difficulty

## inadvertently

## recognize
