erode

ache

 to experience a dull, persistent pain or discomfort, typically of moderate or low intensity; to feel a continuous dull pain

synonym: hurt, throb, smart

ache abominably, (2) ache all the time
 ache all over after running a marathon yesterday.

portray

- v. to depict or describe someone or something in a painting, film, book, or other artistic worksynonym: depict, describe, illustrate
- (1) **portray** feelings in words, (2) accurately **portray** the condition

We often portray political problems as religious issues.

deem

- v. to consider or decide something in a particular way synonym: believe, consider, suppose
- (1) **deem** socially responsible, (2) **deem** wrong or inappropriate

Regarding earthquakes, some commercial buildings were **deemed** unsafe.

impart

v. to expose or inform; to provide a portion of synonym: pass on, give, bestow

resonate

- v. to be filled with a deep echoing sound synonym: echo, reverberate, resound

eureka

exclamation of triumph on discovering something;
 realization or sudden insight

synonym: discovery, breakthrough, aha moment

calligraphy

 the art of writing letters, especially an elegant or decorative one

synonym: penmanship, handwriting, script

punctuate

diacritical

transliterate

retouch

typewriter
