# replace

- v. to take the place of somethingsynonym: substitute, supersede, displace
- (1) **replace** one word with another, (2) **replace** a phone Eventually, the new design will **replace** all older models.

#### emergency

n. a sudden unforeseen crisis usually involving danger that requires immediate action

synonym: crisis, trouble, difficulty

(1) **emergency** action, (2) acute **emergency**. The president declared a state of **emergency**.

#### abyss

- n. a deep, dark, or seemingly bottomless chasm or voidsynonym: chasm, cavity, gulf

silo

synonym: storage, warehouse, barn

decide

cartoon

# graduate

#### boom

 a sudden increase in economic activity, or a sudden happening that brings good fortune; a deep, loud, and prolonged sound

*synonym*: roaring, prosperity, boost

# underfunded

adj. having insufficient funds to support or carry out an enterprise

synonym: undercapitalized, cash-strapped, insolvent

#### shortfall

#### survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay

# accuse

# tempting

adj. likely to attract or persuade someone to do something, especially something that may not be wise or safesynonym: alluring, attractive, inviting

rifle

 a long-barreled firearm designed to be fired from the shoulder, typically with a rifled bore for accuracy

gap

synonym: opening, lacuna, spread

wage
