## symphony

 a long musical composition in Western classical music for orchestra, usually with three or four main parts called movements

synonym: orchestra, harmony, concert

#### immerse

v. to become fully involved in a particular activity; to dip or submerge in a liquid, especially so that they or it are entirely covered

*synonym*: dip, inundate, submerge

#### jingle

v. to create or make a ringing sound, particularly one that is musical or catchy

synonym: tinkle, chime, ring

#### amazement

a state of great surprise or wonder caused by something extraordinary or unexpected

synonym: astonishment, wonder, surprise
