The wound continued to **throb** with pain, despite the medication.

ingrown

adj. referring to a hair or nail that has grown into the skin surrounding it, causing irritation or infection

synonym: embedded, imbedded, encased

An **ingrown** toenail can be very painful and requires medical attention.

toenail

n. the hard, flat covering on the end of a toe, made of layers of dead skin cells; often requires regular grooming and trimming to maintain proper hygiene and appearance

synonym: nail, claw, hoof

astonishing

apparition

- n. the appearance of a ghost or ghost-like image; a sudden and unexpected appearance of something or someonesynonym: ghost, phantom, specter

amputation

- n. the act of cutting off a part of the body surgically

Amputation of the limb is a last resort for the patient.

neuron

 a cell that is specialized to carry information within the brain and between the brain and other parts of the body

synonym: nerve cell

(1) excite the **neurons**, (2) **neuron** cell body

Our body transfers information along each **neuron** using an electrical impulse.

fingertip

dorsal

synonym: abaxial, spinal, back

The shark's **dorsal** fin is a distinguishing feature.

intensify

v. to increase or make something increase in extent or strength

synonym: amplify, boost, strengthen

somatosensor

n. a type of sensory receptor in the skin, muscles, tendons, and joints that respond to touch, pressure, temperature, or pain stimuli and sends signals to the brain for processing in the somatosensory cortex

synonym: mechanoreceptor, touch receptor, sensory receptor

prosthetic
