#### homebound

adj. confined to one's home or place of residence due to illness, disability, or age; referring to someone who is returning or traveling towards their home

### security

#### maintain

v. to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

mechanical issues.

### apologize

v. to express regret for committing wrongdoing or causing a problem

synonym: excuse, justify, atone

#### messy

adj. disorganized and untidy

synonym: cluttered, disorganized, untidy

(1) messy data, (2) messy handling

His **messy** bedroom is always a source of frustration for his mother.

#### scrub

v. to clean something thoroughly, typically with a brush and soap or detergent

synonym: clean, wash, sanitize

#### cabinet

n. a piece of furniture with doors, shelves, and drawers used for storage or display; a small group of senior members of a government who act as official advisers for the President or Prime Minister

### desperately

#### transit

 the act or process of passing through or across a place or state; transportation

synonym: transportation, passage, transfer

(1) a transit visa, (2) mass transit

Public **transit** is an essential service for many cities.

#### homeless

adj. without a home, and therefore typically living on the streets

synonym: destitute, displaced, transient

(1) **homeless** shelter, (2) a **homeless** cat

He became **homeless** after losing his job.

#### bench

 a long, flat surface, often elevated and supported by legs, used for sitting, working, or displaying objects; persons who administer justice

synonym: seat, terrace, judiciary

(1) bench conference, (2) bench board

I sat on the **bench** in the park and enjoyed the beautiful scenery.

#### closure

n. the situation that a company, organization, etc. has ceased operations permanently

synonym: shutdown, stoppage, termination

(1) public school **closures**, (2) **closure** of a road They regretted the **closure** of their restaurant.

### cycle

 an interval during which a recurring sequence of events occurs; a bicycle or motorcycle

synonym: revolution, rotation, bike

(1) the **cycle** of the seasons, (2) go to the workplace by **cycle** 

The food chain causes a material cycle.

### instability

 the state of being unstable or uncertain and likely to change suddenly

synonym: imbalance, fluctuation, unstableness

(1) political **instability**, (2) **instability** in currency markets Lack of sleep and overwork often lead to emotional **instability**.

#### extend

v. to broaden in scope, range, or area

synonym: prolong, lengthen, advance

(1) **extend** the warranty, (2) **extend** a line Her visit will **extend** from Monday to Friday.

#### influx

n. the arrival or entry of a large number of people, objects, or ideas into a place or system

synonym: inflow, arrival, impression

(1) influx of capital, (2) influx of tourists

The **influx** of immigrants into urban areas can create significant social, economic, and political challenges for local communities.

### provider

*n.* a person or an organization that supplies somebody with something needed or wanted

*synonym*: supplier

#### stretch

 to make or be capable of making anything longer or broader without hurting or breaking

synonym: lengthen, prolong, extend

#### caseload

### employee

#### vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

### spotlight

### journalist
