### therapy

the act of caring for someone through medication, remedial training, etc.

synonym: antidote, medicine, treatment

(1) therapy for a patient, (2) field of gene therapy

I underwent aversion **therapy** for my addiction to alcohol.

#### universal

adj. existing or affecting everywhere or everyone synonym: common, broad, worldwide

(1) universal life, (2) principles of universal design

The picture earned near- universal acclaim from critics.

#### relate

to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

synonym: connect, link, associate

(1) **relate** a story, (2) **relate** a message

He tried to **relate** his experience to the group, but they couldn't understand.

#### protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

(1) hold a **protest**, (2) a silent **protest** 

He left the party in **protest** at its radical political stance.

#### rattle

to make or cause to make short, successive, sharp, and ν. loud sounds

synonym: jolt, shake, babble

(1) rattle along a road, (2) rattle and bang at the door

The vast earthquake caused the house to **rattle**.

#### attest

v. to provide evidence or proof of something; to confirm or certify the authenticity of something; to bear witness to the truth of something

synonym: verify, confirm, certify

#### grief

- n. a very great sadness, especially when somebody diessynonym: anguish, desperation, dismay

#### occasion

 a time or event that is suitable or appropriate for something to happen or be done; a particular event or circumstance that requires or allows for something to be done

synonym: event, time, occurrence

#### vacation

 a period in which someone does not have to attend work or school and is free to do whatever they choose, such as travel or leisure

synonym: leave, recess, break

#### marred

adj. damaged, disfigured, or spoiled; impaired or diminished in value or quality

synonym: blemished, damaged, flawed

(1) marred reputation, (2) marred relationship

Even though the building was now in ruins, there was an undeniable charm about its **marred** beauty.

#### frustration

- n. the feeling of being upset or annoyed as a result of being unable to change or achieve somethingsynonym: disappointment, discouragement, dissatisfaction

### delay

- v. to cause something to happen at a later time than originally intended or expectedsynonym: block, adjourn, detain

#### horrible

- adj. extremely unpleasant or bad; causing fear or disgust synonym: dreadful, terrible, awful

#### ultimate

- adj. furthest or highest in degree or order synonym: highest, maximum, foremost
- (1) the **ultimate** goal in life, (2) the **ultimate** luxury Management must take **ultimate** responsibility for the accident.

#### conversation

- n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.
- synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

bet

- v. to risk money on the result of an event or a competition, such as a race or game, to get more money; to have faith or confidence in something

#### interfere

v. to get involved in and prevent a process or activity from continuing

#### damage

*adj.* full of difficulties; difficult to deal with or solve *synonym*: inappropriate, inconvenient, worrisome

### provoke

to stimulate or give rise to a particular reaction or have a particular effect

to do something or to make something dirty or untidy

synonym: stimulate, incite, encourage

- mess n. a state of confusion, dirtiness, or untidiness; (verb) to fail

### **spirit**

n. the part of a person which is the seat of their mind, feelings, and character rather than their physical body; the general atmosphere of a place or situation and the effect that it has on people

synonym: soul, attitude, enthusiasm

(1) **spirit** and the letter of the law, (2) an indomitable **spirit** Despite their tragic loss, the family is showing great **spirit**.

### provocation

 action or speech that intentionally causes someone to become angry, irritated, or frustrated; a reason or motive for something, often negative or undesired

synonym: agitation, incitement, stimulus

(1) **provocation** tactics, (2) verbal **provocation**The politician's speech was seen as a **provocation** to the opposition party.

### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

collaborate with colleagues,

 decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

#### advantage

 a condition or circumstance that puts one in a favorable or superior position; a beneficial feature or asset that someone or something has

synonym: benefit, edge, asset

(1) score an **advantage**, (2) take **advantage** of his weak points

One of the main **advantages** of the new product is its increased efficiency.

### comprehensive

*adj.* complete and including all or everything necessary *synonym*: complete, encyclopedic, thorough

(1) a comprehensive explanation, (2) conduct a comprehensive survey

We have a **comprehensive** grasp of this topic.

#### irritate

v. to annoy, provoke, or cause resentment or anger in someone; to inflame or make sore

synonym: annoy, vex, bother

(1) irritate skin, (2) irritate my partner

The sound of his chewing loudly irritates me during dinner.

#### fascinating

adj. extremely interesting

synonym: alluring, intriguing, captivating

(1) **fascinating** story, (2) completely **fascinating** to me The museum houses a **fascinating** collection of Celtic artifacts.

#### chew

v. to crush or grind something, especially food, with the teeth and then swallow it

synonym: masticate, crush, grind

(1) **chew** each word, (2) **chew** a stick of gum My dog loves to **chew** on bones.

#### surprisingly

adv. in a way that causes amazement or wonder synonym: exceptionally, notably, unusually

(1) **surprisingly** advanced culture, (2) have **surprisingly** little effect

The exam was **surprisingly** tricky for everyone.

#### roundabout

 a circuitous or indirect route or path; a traffic circle or rotary used to regulate the flow of traffic

synonym: detour, circuitous route, indirect path

(1) **roundabout** junction, (2) traffic **roundabout**Because of the road closure, we had to take a **roundabout**route to reach the destination.

### rage

n. a strong feeling of anger or violence

synonym: fury, anger, outrage

(1) uncontrollable **rage**, (2) fall into a **rage**She was filled with a burning **rage** at the injustice she had witnessed.

racism

n. prejudice, discrimination, or antagonism directed against a person or people based on their membership in a particular ethnic group, typically one that is a minority or marginalized

synonym: prejudice, discrimination, bias

(1) systemic **racism**, (2) research on anti- **racism**The school's lack of diversity was a clear indication of the **racism** present in the community.

bully

 a person who uses strength or power to harm or intimidate those who are weaker; (verb) to intimidate, harass, or mistreat someone weaker or less powerful

synonym: tormentor, intimidator, aggressor

(1) bully bystander, (2) bully the weak

The schoolyard **bully** terrorized the other children and made their lives miserable.

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment

Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's **environment**.

#### destruction

- n. the act of causing so much damage to somethingsynonym: devastation, annihilation, ruin
- (1) path of **destruction**, (2) cyclonic **destruction**The extinction of several subspecies has been linked to climate change and habitat **destruction**.

#### specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

synonym: particular, definite, distinct

(1) **specific** instructions, (2) industry- **specific** regulations
The scientist conducted a study that provided **specific** details about the species' behavior.

#### oddly

- adv. in a way that is unexpected, strange, or peculiar synonym: strangely, peculiarly, weirdly
- (1) behave oddly, (2) oddly familiar

He walked into the party with an **oddly** dressed companion, causing everyone to stare.

### accidentally

adv. by chance or without planning

synonym: by chance, unintentionally, unwittingly

(1) they met **accidentally**, (2) **accidentally** coincide He was **accidentally** killed by friendly fire.

#### lean

adj. having a noticeably small amount of body fat; (verb) to bend or move from a straight to a sloping posture

synonym: skinny, slender, (verb) slant

(1) a **lean** horse, (2) **lean** athletic figure

Lean operational improvements often lead to better

environmental performance.

#### gross

adj. being the total amount of something before any deductions; obese and ugly or unpleasant

synonym: before tax, total, abhorrent

(1) the **gross** amount, (2) **gross** injustice

The drastic reorganization has significantly increased this company's gross profits.

#### flash

a sudden intense burst of radiant energy; a momentary brightness

synonym: sparkle, gleam, glimmer

(1) a flash of lightning, (2) brilliant flash

These heavy rains caused **flash** floods on several islands.

#### tease

to make fun of someone or make jokes about them, either in a playful way or to upset them; to separate the fibers of something; to ruffle a person's or animal's hair by combing

synonym: bully, annoy, provoke

This ad is intended to **tease** a competing product.

### unpleasant

adj. not enjoyable or comfortable

synonym: disagreeable, displeasing, distasteful

adj. not giving equal treatment or opportunities to people involved; marked by injustice, partiality, or deception synonym: wrongful, biased, dishonest

In a democracy, it is necessary to monitor the judiciary to see if it is making unfair decisions.

#### unfair

#### powerless

adj. lacking power, strength, or authority; unable to act or affect change

#### recipe

 a set of instructions for preparing a dish, including the ingredients and the method of cooking

synonym: instructions, formula, method

(1) recipe book, (2) recipe collection

The **recipe** for the cake is passed down from generation to generation in her family.

#### vacuum

 a space empty of matter; a device or tool used for cleaning or removing debris by creating suction

synonym: void, emptiness, gap

(1) vacuum cleaner, (2) vacuum packing

Please use the **vacuum** to clean up the mess on the floor.

#### scared

adj. afraid or frightened

synonym: frightened, fearful, dreading

(1) scared all the time, (2) scared dog

I'm scared of insects.

#### emotion

 a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with others

*synonym*: feeling, sentiment, passion

(1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

#### anxious

adj. worried and nervous

synonym: nervous, uneasy, afraid

(1) **anxious** about his health, (2) an **anxious** look He cast **anxious** glances behind her.

#### interpret

v. to explain or assign the meaning of information, actions, etc.

synonym: decode, decipher, analyze

(1) **interpret** a graph, (2) **interpret** the question Different people might **interpret** this news differently.

decide

blame

- to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
   synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.
- v. to think or say that someone or something did something wrong or is responsible for something badsynonym: condemn, rebuke, find fault with
- (1) **blame** circumstances for the failure, (2) **blame** the lack of knowledge

We **blamed** our impeded progress on lack of money.

pun

 a humorous play on words or use of words that sound similar but have different meanings, often for a comedic effect; a form of wordplay

synonym: joke, quip, wordplay

(1) witty pun, (2) silly pun

The comedian's pun had the audience laughing out loud.

primary

adj. first or highest in rank, order, or importance; most fundamental or essential; pertaining to the initial or introductory stage of something, such as a school year or election cycle

synonym: chief, main, fundamental

(1) **primary** school, (2) **primary** education

The **primary** cause of the accident was due to the icy road conditions.

#### appraisal

 an evaluation or assessment of the value, quality, or condition of something or someone, often in a professional or organized manner

synonym: assessment, evaluation, judgment

(1) performance **appraisal**, (2) real estate **appraisal**She received a positive **appraisal** from her boss for her outstanding performance at work.

#### evaluate

context

v. to assess or estimate the quality, significance, quantity, or value of something

synonym: assess, estimate, consider

- (1) **evaluate** the grant proposal, (2) **evaluate** a situation The meeting aims to **evaluate** possible choices.
- the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical **context**, (2) legal **context**It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

### illustrate

v. to provide pictures, photographs, diagrams, etc. in a book or something for explanation

synonym: demonstrate, explain, exemplify

(1) **illustrate** a key point, (2) **illustrate** a story

The company's financial records **illustrate** how successful it has been.

#### evil

adj. profoundly immoral, cruel, and wicked; having or exerting a harmful effect on people

*synonym*: malign, corruption, immorality

(1) evil ways, (2) a charm against evil

Corruption is an **evil** act for any reason.

#### genius

someone who has exceptional intellectual ability and originality

synonym: brilliance, brainiac, acumen

(1) a person of **genius**, (2) a **genius** for music Mozart was a musical **genius**.

#### definition

traffic

 a concise explanation of the meaning of a word, phrase, or symbol

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

- (1) a precise **definition**, (2) the **definition** of a word Parallel lines are, by **definition**, lines on the same plane that never cross.
- n. the movement of vehicles, people, or goods along a route or through a transport system; the amount of such movement in a particular place or at a particular time

synonym: congestion, jam, flow

(1) traffic jam, (2) heavy traffic

We decided to take a detour to avoid the construction **traffic** on the main road.

#### construct

v. to build or create something; to assemble or combine different parts to form something whole

synonym: build, assemble, create

(1) **construct** a 3D image, (2) **construct** a dam He **constructs** hypotheses that no mathematician has ever imagined before.

#### routinely

adv. on a regular or habitual basis; in a manner that is customary or expected

synonym: habitually, regularly, customarily

- (1) **routinely** check, (2) **routinely** scheduled maintenance They **routinely** conduct fire drills to ensure everyone in the building knows what to do in an emergency.
- n. a stringed instrument, typically with six strings and frets, played with a bow, also called a viola da gambasynonym: viola, viola da gamba, string instrument

#### viol

#### consequence

n. the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

#### anonymous

adj. having no known name, identity, or known source synonym: nameless, unidentified, unnamed

(1) **anonymous** letter, (2) **anonymous** house She received several **anonymous** calls.

#### wrath

n. extreme anger

synonym: fury, irritation, anger

(1) wrath of God, (2) a high person's wrathHe finally exploded with wrath due to the team's repeated

failures.

#### frustrate

to hinder or prevent efforts, plans, or desires from doing, succeeding, or being fulfilled; to make someone feel upset or annoyed because they are unable to change or achieve something

synonym: hinder, thwart, dishearten

(1) **frustrate** the advancement, (2) **frustrate** other team members

The coach explained a strategy to **frustrate** the opponent's schemes to the players.

pile

a collection of objects positioned one on top of another;
 a large sum of something, such as money

synonym: accumulation, heap, stack

(1) a sand pile, (2) the height of a pile

After the party, they had to clean up **piles** of dirty dishes.

#### destitute

adj. lacking basic material necessities such as food, shelter, and clothing; impoverished

synonym: poor, impoverished, needy

(1) **destitute** refugees, (2) living in **destitute** conditions The hurricane left many families **destitute** and without homes.

#### scratch

v. to cut or damage the surface of something or the skin with a sharp or pointed object

synonym: claw, rub, scrape

(1) **scratch** off a name, (2) **scratch** my signature Don't **scratch** your mosquito bites.

#### monster

 an imaginary creature that is large and has various human and animal parts; someone or something large and powerful

synonym: giant, freak, behemoth

(1) horde of **monsters**, (2) **monster** film This car has a **monster** engine.

#### ruin

v. to damage, spoil, or demolish something; (noun) an unrecoverable state of devastation and destruction,

synonym: bankrupt, demolish, destroy

(1) ruin the plan, (2) ruin the reputation

He knocked over the red wine and ruined the tablecloth.

#### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process**The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

#### catastrophe

- n. a sudden event that causes extreme ruin and misfortunesynonym: disaster, calamity, cataclysm
- (1) **catastrophe** risk management, (2) avoid climate **catastrophe**

The lack of funds has resulted in a **catastrophe** for our university system.

#### associate

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

(1) **associate** alcohol with gambling, (2) **associate** with people widely

The majority of consumers **associate** this brand with quality.

#### chronic

adj. being long-lasting and recurrent or characterized by long suffering; habitual

synonym: established, regular, constant

(1) risk of **chronic** disease, (2) **chronic** alcohol consumption

**Chronic** hyperglycemia is a trigger for a variety of serious diseases.

#### attribute

 to say or regard that something is the result of a particular thing; (noun) a quality or feature that someone or something possesses;

synonym: ascribe, blame, (noun) feature

(1) **attribute** the change to their marriage, (2) **attribute** directly to sales

He **attributes** the disappointing results to the economic downturn.

#### causation

 the action or relationship between an event or action and its effect or consequence; the explanation for why something happens

synonym: cause, reason, origin

(1) causation analysis, (2) direct causation

The **causation** of the disease is still under investigation by medical researchers.

### belong

 to be the property of someone or something; to be a member or part of a group; to be in the proper or appropriate place

synonym: fit, be appropriate, be suitable

(1) **belong** to different species, (2) **belong** to a group All the books in this section **belong** to the library's rare collection and must be handled carefully.

#### inanimate

adj. not having life or spirit; not animate

synonym: lifeless, inert, passive

(1) **inanimate** nature, (2) **inanimate** matter

The **inanimate** object was not capable of movement or feeling.

#### ridiculous

adj. very silly or unreasonable and deserving to be laughed at

synonym: absurd, fatuous, foolish

(1) a **ridiculous** amount of money, (2) a **ridiculous** suggestion

Everyone regarded the theory he advocated as **ridiculous** but was later proven correct.

### generalize

v. to make something, such as a theory, idea, etc., more widespread or widely applicable based on what is true in some cases

synonym: conclude, derive, extrapolate

(1) **generalize** Kepler's first law, (2) **generalize** sophisticatedly

It's dangerous to generalize about people.

#### inflame

v. to cause very strong feelings such as anger or excitement in a person or a group of people

synonym: agitate, arouse, enrage

(1) **inflame** skin, (2) **inflame** his passion

Her eyes **inflamed** with crying.

label

idiot

 a small piece of paper, fabric, or other material attached to an object and giving information about it; (verb) to assign to a category

synonym: tag, mark, identifier

(1) a mailing **label**, (2) **label** a bag with my name The **label** on the food package lists the ingredients and nutritional information.

 a foolish or stupid person who lacks common sense or judgment; a derogatory term used to describe someone who is mentally deficient

synonym: dummy, imbecile, bubblehead

(1) idiot driver, (2) what an idiot

He acted like an **idiot** and spilled his drink all over the floor.

bunch

 a grouping of several similar things which are growing or fastened together

synonym: group, assemblage, bundle

(1) a **bunch** of trees, (2) a **bunch** of schoolgirls One bad apple spoils the whole **bunch**.

### psychology

- n. the scientific study of mind and behavior
- (1) **psychology** experiment, (2) **psychology** of crowd She had a master's degree in **psychology**.

refer

v. to direct someone's attention, thoughts, or questions to another source or person; to mention, cite, or allude to something as evidence or support

synonym: cite, allude, mention

(1) refer to a book, (2) refer to a map

Please **refer** to the instruction manual for further assistance.

### cognitive

adj. of or relating to mental processes of understanding synonym: perceivable, mind, mental

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(1) improve **cognitive** function, (2) research on **cognitive** psychology

His **cognitive** faculties were getting worse because of a lack of sleep.

#### distortion

 the alteration or misrepresentation of something so that it is no longer true or accurate; the way in which a sound or image is changed or distorted

synonym: twist, deformity, misrepresentation

(1) **distortion** of the earth's surface, (2) horizontal **distortion** 

Her report was criticized as a gross distortion of the truth.

#### irrational

adj. not based on, or not using reason or clear thinking;(mathematics) a real number that cannot be expressed as the ratio of two integers

synonym: illogical, ludicrous, senseless

(1) an **irrational** request, (2) **irrational** numbers They continued to endure **irrational** treatment by the dictatorship.

#### cruel

adj. feeling or showing pleasure in causing pain or suffering to others

synonym: heartless, sadistic, vicious

(1) a **cruel** and unusual punishment, (2) **cruel** joke The dictator was known for his **cruel** and oppressive regime.

#### ancestor

- n. a person from whom one is descended; a forefathersynonym: forebear, forefather, progenitor
- (1) **ancestor** language, (2) earliest human **ancestor**My remote **ancestor** immigrated to the United States from Ireland in the 1800s.

### evolutionary

adj. relating to or denoting how living things develop or change from earlier forms

synonym: developmental, mutative, transformative
