synonym: candidly, openly, honestly

immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately**

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

jail

 a facility where criminals are kept to be punished for their crimes; a prison

synonym: prison, slammer, penitentiary

(1) county jail, (2) be in jail

The police escorted the prisoner to the **jail**.

beret

 a soft, round, flat-crowned felt or woolen hat, typically worn by men and associated with French or Basque culture

synonym: cap, tam, military hat

The French painter wore a black **beret** as a symbol of his artistic identity.

extreme

adj. very great in amount or degree

synonym: farthermost, outermost, fierce

pun

 a humorous play on words or use of words that sound similar but have different meanings, often for a comedic effect; a form of wordplay

entrepreneur

 an individual who creates or invests in one or more businesses, especially when this involves taking financial risks

synonym: founder, executive

incentivize

v. to make someone want to do in a particular way by offering them a reward

synonym: encourage, motivate

innovation

rural

to obtain, acquire, or secure something, often by effort or skill

synonym: obtain, acquire, secure

rookie

procure

a newcomer or beginner, specifically in a particular profession, sport, or activity; an inexperienced or naive person

synonym: beginner, novice, greenhorn

(1) rookie mistake, (2) rookie teacher

The **rookie** player showed promise in the preseason games.

realistic

adj. having or showing a sensible and practical idea that is possible to achieve

synonym: practical, pragmatic, down-to-earth

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salary

 a fixed amount of money that employees, especially those who work in an office, receive for doing their job, usually paid every month

negative

adj. having the quality of something bad or harmful; expressing refusal

synonym: minus, adverse, pessimistic

guilty

adj. feeling responsible for or having done something wrong or criminal

synonym: culpable, blameworthy, at fault

After much contemplation, the suspect decided to plead **guilty** to the theft charge.

résumé

 a summary of a person's education, work experience, and qualifications, often used in job applications as a way to showcase their skills and achievements

synonym: summary, outline, recap

You need to update your **résumé** before submitting it for the job application.

conversation

 an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

topic

- n. a subject that is being discussed or written aboutsynonym: subject, theme, issue
- a serious topic,

confess

exorcism

lift

authentic

institute

 an organization that has a specific purpose, particularly one dealing with science, education, or a particular profession; (verb) to initiate, introduce, or establish something

awesome

adj. inspiring fear, admiration, or respect; very good, nice, fun, etc.

synonym: miraculous, marvelous, astounding

dedicate

 to give all of your energy, time, etc., entirely to a specific person, activity, or cause; to set apart for a particular purpose or use

He dedicated his life to helping others.

consequence

n. the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

gratify

v. to give pleasure or satisfaction to; to provide someone with what they want or need; to indulge or satisfy a desire or appetite

humiliation

sham

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

 the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation synonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

collaboration

bond

 a close emotional connection between two or more people; a certificate of debt that a government or corporation issues to raise money

sector

attribute

suffer

impostor

n. someone who pretends to be someone or something else to deceive others; a fraud

syndrome

 a group of signs and symptoms that occur together and are characteristic of a particular condition or disorder

recuperate

- v. to recover, heal, or regain health, strength, or well-being after an illness, injury, or period of stress or exhaustion synonym: heal, recover, recuperate

therapy

 the act of caring for someone through medication, remedial training, etc.

emotional

adj. relating to people's feelingssynonym: affecting, impactful, impressive

profound

- adj. extremely great; sensed or experienced very strongly;displaying a high level of knowledge or comprehensionsynonym: deep, unsounded, far-reaching

policy

n. a set of rules, guidelines, principles, or procedures that govern decision-making or action, often used in the context of business or government; a course of action or plan of action adopted or followed by an organization or individual to achieve a goal or objective

regulatory

strict

adj. strongly limiting someone's freedom; allowing no deviation from a standard, rule, belief, etc.

compliance

 the act of following rules or regulations, often willingly or voluntarily; the act of conforming to a set of standards or guidelines

involve

association

 a people or groups of people who have joined in a single organization together for a particular purpose; a social or business connection or relationship

synonym: affiliation, collaboration, society

(1) word associations, (2) a scholarship association

His membership in the **association** provided him with numerous benefits.

congress

 a formal meeting of the representatives of different countries, constituent states, organizations, trade unions, political parties, or other groups

synonym: legislature, parliament, assembly

legislation

- a law or a set of laws suggested and then passed by a parliament, or the act of making or enacting laws

process

insist

v. to say something clearly or demand something forcefully, especially when other people disagree with or oppose what you say

synonym: demand, assert, claim

mediocrity

n. the state or quality of being average or of having only moderate ability, success, or value; the state or quality of being uninspired or unoriginal

synonym: averageness, ordinariness, unoriginality

maximum

adj. the largest or greatest amount or value attainable or attained
