solo

adv. without anybody else or anything else; alone

synonym: alone

(1) a **solo** vocal recital, (2) a **solo** flight

I would love to **solo** camping someday.

trombone

n. a musical instrument in the brass family that is played by sliding a telescoping tube in and out to change the pitch while blowing air through the mouthpiece

synonym: horn, brass instrument, bugle

(1) play the **trombone**, (2) a jazz **trombone** player

The jazz band featured a spectacular **trombone** solo during the performance.

saxophone

n. a musical instrument of the woodwind family with a single-reed mouthpiece and a curved metal or brass body; known for its mellow and smooth tone

synonym: sax, soprano, alto

(1) **saxophone** player, (2) **saxophone** music

The **saxophone** solo was the highlight of the concert.

tune

n. a musical composition or set of musical notes that are played or sung; (verb) to adjust or set something to a specific condition or standard

synonym: melody, harmony, (verb) adjust

participate

v. to take part in something

synonym: take part, partake, enter

singe

synonym: sear, char, burn

I didn't realize the iron was still hot and **singed** my dress.

hop

v. to jump lightly and quickly on one foot or both feet; to move rapidly from one place to another; to travel using an aircraft, bus, etc.

synonym: jump, bounce, skip

The rabbit **hopped** over the fence.

snare

n. a trap or device used to catch animals by means of a noose or wire loop; a type of drum consisting of a head stretched over a hollow shell, usually played with drumsticks

synonym: trap, noose, entanglement

(1) **snare** drum, (2) fall into a **snare**

The thief was caught in a **snare** set by the police.

derrick

n. a tall tower-like structure or framework used for hoisting and moving heavy objects, especially in the context of oil drilling or in shipyards

synonym: crane, hoist, lift

(1) **derrick** crane, (2) oil **derrick**

The company invested in a hydraulic **derrick** system to speed up its construction projects.

moss

n. a small, soft plant that grows in a low, compact layer, often on the ground or on rocks

synonym: plant, foliage, greenery

(1) green **moss**, (2) **moss** garden

Moss grows in damp, shaded areas and is often found on the forest floor.

bass

n. the lowest part in polyphonic music; a type of fish belonging to the large order Perciformes, or perch-like fishes

synonym: low-pitch, resonance

percussion
