synonym: rudeness, impoliteness, disrespect

belittle

v. to speak or write about someone or something in a way that shows a lack of respect

synonym: degrade, demean, disparage

He **belittled** her in front of the office, making her feel small and insignificant.

tease

v. to make fun of someone or make jokes about them, either in a playful way or to upset them; to separate the fibers of something; to ruffle a person's or animal's hair by combing

synonym: bully, annoy, provoke

(1) tease the children, (2) tease wool

This ad is intended to **tease** a competing product.

uncivil

 adj. rude or impolite; lacking in courtesy or consideration for others; violating commonly accepted social norms or expectations

synonym: rude, impolite, discourteous

(1) **uncivil** political climate, (2) **uncivil** remark
Her **uncivil** behavior at the meeting caused much tension among the group.

stuffy

adj. lacking fresh air or ventilation; oppressively warm;
 lacking in excitement or variety; formal in manner or behavior

synonym: stuffy, suffocating, oppressive

heartbreak

coworker

a person who works with another in the same company or organization

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

alumni

 n. (the plural form of "alumnus" or "alumna") former students or graduates of an educational institution or program

synonym: graduates, former students, alum

insensitive

adj. not showing or feeling concern for the needs and feelings of others

synonym: unfeeling, unaware, indifferent

- a phrase or slogan that expresses a guiding principle or goal

synonym: slogan, catchphrase, phrase

brainpower

intellectual or cognitive ability; mental capacity or intelligence

synonym: intelligence, smarts, intellect

sneaky

adj. behaving in a deceptive or underhanded way;characterized by stealth or secretiveness

synonym: sly, crafty, deceitful
