#### caustic

rank

#### hesitation

 n. the act of pausing or being slow before saying or doing something, especially because you feel uncertain or nervous

synonym: unwillingness, indecision, uncertainty

### glance

- v. to give a quick or brief look; to hit something at an angle synonym: glimpse, peek, flash

#### lean

#### emotion

### reign
