dilute

synonym: weaken, thin, reduce

- liquefy to turn a solid substance into a liquid state; to make something fluid or easier to flow

synonym: melt, dissolve, thaw

(1) **liquefy** the soil, (2) **liquefy** cement

The butter began to **liquefy** during the heat wave and drip off the countertop.

regenerate

- to improve or renew an area, institution, system, etc., especially by making it more active or successful synonym: renew, revive, improve
- (1) **regenerate** bone tissue, (2) a **regenerate** sinner The new CEO's primary mission is to regenerate the company on the verge of bankruptcy.

- to state or give order with total authority; to say or read aloud for somebody else to write down or to be recorded *synonym*: read out, prescribe, order

synonym: give off, radiate, expel

thermostat

 a device that automatically regulates temperature by controlling the heating or cooling system based on the temperature in a room or building

synonym: thermoregulator, climate control

(1) thermostat settings, (2) smart thermostat

The digital **thermostat** has a programmable feature, and it can be controlled through your smartphone.

geothermal

adj. relating to or produced by the internal heat of the earth; often used to refer to energy produced by tapping into the natural heat of the earth

synonym: underground, thermal, subterranean

The town is exploring using **geothermal** energy to power its homes and buildings.

rainforest

- a forest rich in biodiversity that is generally found in tropical settings with heavy annual rainfall

arable
