#### forehead

n. the part of the face above the eyebrows and below the hairline; the upper part of the face that extends from the eyes to the hairline

*synonym*: brow, frontal bone, temple

(1) forehead wrinkles, (2) kiss on the forehead

The athlete had sweat dripping down her **forehead** after the intense workout.

#### disheveled

adj. in a state of disorder or disarray, often related to one's appearance, such as messy or untidy hair, clothing, or personal hygiene

synonym: messy, tousled, unkempt

(1) disheveled hair, (2) disheveled appearance

The hotel room was in **disheveled** condition after the wild party last night.

#### pale

adj. having skin that is very light colored; lacking in vitality or interest or effectiveness

synonym: sallow, faint, ashen

(1) a pale complexion, (2) pale pink

She turned **pale** when she heard the news.

# intelligence

*n.* the ability to learn, comprehend, or make judgments or conclusions based on reasons

synonym: brains, brightness, cleverness

(1) an **intelligence** test, (2) field of artificial **intelligence** In terms of **intelligence**, he was head and shoulders above his classmates.

#### exhaustion

 the state of being extremely tired and lacking energy or strength

synonym: fatigue, weariness, tiredness

(1) **exhaustion** of energy, (2) emotional **exhaustion** The long work hours were taking a toll on her mental **exhaustion**.

#### sink

 to submerge or go down below the surface of a liquid or substance; to decline or deteriorate; to cause something to go down into a liquid substance or sink into something else

synonym: descend, drop, plummet

(1) **sink** a lot of capital, (2) **sink** a buzzer-beater The abandoned ship slowly began to **sink** into the murky waters of the harbor.

# instantly

adv. immediately

synonym: immediately, right away, directly

(1) **instantly** cope with, (2) be killed **instantly** I remembered that person **instantly** and never forgot.

# recognizable

adj. easy to become aware of or identify synonym: noticeable, perceptible, definite

(1) to a **recognizable** degree, (2) **recognizable** landmark His car was easily **recognizable** in the parking lot.

#### suited

 adj. appropriate, fitting, or acceptable for a particular purpose or occasion; matched or corresponding to a specific person, dress, or circumstances

*synonym*: appropriate, fitting, suitable

(1) **suited** for the job, (2) well-**suited** personality The job offer was perfectly **suited** to her skills and experience.

# reputation

 n. the general opinion that people have about someone or something, especially when this is based on their previous experiences or behaviors

synonym: fame, standing, esteem

(1) reputation risk, (2) cloud his reputation

She has a good **reputation** for being one of the best chefs in the city.

strap

n. a long, narrow strip or belt of leather, fabric, or another material used for binding, fastening, or supporting something or someone; a band or string that attaches one object to another, often used to secure items during transport

synonym: band, belt, sling

(1) leather **strap**, (2) camera **strap** 

The athlete tightened the **strap** on his running shoes before the race.

descend

v. to move downward and lower; to come from, or to be connected by a relationship of blood

synonym: dip, drop, come down

(1) **descend** a steep hill, (2) **descend** by elevator She was **descended** from an old Italian noble family.

pendulum

 a weight hung from a fixed point used to regulate the movement of a clock or other mechanism

synonym: oscillator, balance, clock

(1) **pendulum** swings, (2) political **pendulum** 

The **pendulum** clock was a familiar sight in the old house.

blade

 the flat part of a knife, weapon, or machine with a very thin edge used for cutting

synonym: knife, sword, cutter

(1) a <b>blade</b> of grass,	(2) the <b>blade</b> of a turbine
The <b>blade</b> of the kata	na itself is still in excellent condition.

#### raven

 a large, glossy black bird that is a species of a crow; a person with jet-black hair, sometimes used as an adjective to describe such hair

synonym: crow, blackbird, corvid

(1) raven feather, (2) raven in flight

The **raven's** distinctive croaking call echoed through the forest.

#### refuse

- v. to show that one is not willing to do or accept something synonym: turn down, deny, decline
- (1) **refuse** a request, (2) **refuse** the company My initial reaction was to **refuse**.

#### narrator

- n. a person who tells a story, especially in a book or film synonym: teller, storyteller
- (1) first-person **narrator**, (2) the **narrator** of the TV program. The **narrator** makes use of the local dialect.

#### chamber

 a large room used for a formal, public, or particular purpose; one of the parts of a parliament

synonym: association, cabin, legislature

(1) a gas **chamber**, (2) the lower **chamber**The surgeon made an incision in the **chambers** of the patient's heart.

#### macabre

- adj. gruesome, grisly; relating to death synonym: grotesque, gruesome, sinister
- (1) macabre tales of war, (2) macabre art

The **macabre** scene in the horror movie gave her nightmares for weeks.

#### innovative

adj. introducing or using new methods, ideas, etc.

*synonym*: creative, ingenious, inventive

(1) use of **innovative** technology, (2) stylistically **innovative** works

The Prime Minister stressed the need to create **innovative** industries.

#### **Gothic**

adj. of or relating to a style of architecture and art characterized by pointed arches, ribbed vaults, and flying buttresses, popular in Europe in the 12th-16th centuries

synonym: medieval, mysterious, eerie

(1) a **Gothic** cathedral, (2) **Gothic** novel

The **Gothic** architecture of the cathedral was awe-inspiring.

#### horror

 intense fear or disgust, especially at something shocking or terrifying

synonym: fear, terror, dread

(1) horror movie, (2) horror-struck look

The stories of war crimes filled her with **horror**.

#### timeless

adj. not seeming to be altered by the passage of time or changes in fashion

synonym: dateless, everlasting, imperishable

(1) **timeless** masterpiece, (2) **timeless** topic

There is a **timeless** aspect to his most remarkable work.

#### genre

 a particular type or style of literature, art, music, or film that involves a particular set of characteristics

synonym: type, category, style

(1) genre of music, (2) a literary genre

He is known for creating genre-busting paintings.

# practitioner

*n*. a person who works in a profession or occupation, such as a doctor, lawyer, or teacher

synonym: professional, expert, specialist

(1) **practitioner** of Buddhism, (2) **practitioner** of law She is a **practitioner** of traditional Chinese medicine.

#### critic

 someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

(1) art critic, (2) severe critic

Advocates for legal reform hear less harsh words from their **critics**.

# identify

to recognize someone or something and say or prove who or what they are

synonym: determine, specify, recognize

- (1) **identify** handwriting, (2) **identify** gene sequences I will introduce you to how to **identify** the leading causes of the malfunction.
- cardinal n. a high-rai

 a high-ranking official in the Roman Catholic Church, appointed by the Pope; a deep or bright red color; a bird of the finch family with a distinctive crest on its head; (adjective) of or relating to the highest or most important things

synonym: bishop, archbishop, carmine

(1) cardinal rule, (2) cardinal red

The cardinal's robes were made of rich red silk.

#### contribute

- v. to give something, especially money or goods, to provide or achieve something together with other people synonym: donate, devote, commit
- (1) **contribute** a large sum of money to the fund,
- (2) **contribute** to society

Government workers cannot **contribute** to political campaigns.

#### command

n. authority, control, or mastery over something, often referring to military or leadership contexts; a directive, order, or instruction; expertise or confidence in a specific area; (verb) to give an authoritative order or instruction, or to be in charge or control of something

synonym: control, authority, leadership

(1) **command** and control, (2) **command** a battery The general gave a **command** to his troops to prepare for battle.

#### reward

 a thing given in acknowledgment of service, hard work, achievement, etc.

*synonym*: compensation, gratuity, bonus

(1) the **reward** for good works, (2) shopping **rewards** cards Night fishing has a lot of **rewards**.

#### intense

adj. (especially of a feeling) very strong; extremely sharp or severe

synonym: extreme, fierce, harsh

(1) **intense** heat, (2) develop **intense** itching That statement by the prime minister drew **intense** international criticism.

# singular

- n. being only one of its kind; uniquesynonym: unique, sole, individual
- (1) singular purpose, (2) singular goal

The **singular** beauty of the night sky never ceases to amaze him.

# frightening

adj. causing fear or alarm, or very surprising and alarmingsynonym: scary, terrifying, alarming

(1) cast **frightening** eyes, (2) **frightening** experience The news of the pandemic was a **frightening** reminder of the fragility of human health.

#### violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

# paradox

 a statement, situation, or person that has two opposite facts or features and therefore seems impossible, is difficult to understand, or is strange;

synonym: incongruity, dichotomy, contradiction

(1) French **paradox**, (2) the **paradox** of the heap There are many theories to explain this **paradox**.

# mystery

n. something difficult to understand or explain; a secret or enigmatic quality that adds to the fascination or interest of something; a genre of fiction that involves the solution of a crime or a puzzle

synonym: enigma, puzzle, secret

(1) mystery novel, (2) unsolved mystery

The **mystery** surrounding the disappearance of the traveler has yet to be solved by authorities.

# grief

- n. a very great sadness, especially when somebody diessynonym: anguish, desperation, dismay
- (1) have **grief** and sorrow, (2) a lot of **grief** Each person has a unique **grief** experience.

# guilt

n. the fact of having committed something illegal; the negative feelings caused by believing or knowing that you have done something wrong

synonym: regret, remorse, blame

(1) criminal **guilt**, (2) feeling of **guilt** 

Shame and guilt have significant social influences.

#### resist

v. to refuse to accept something and attempt to prevent it from happening

synonym: fight, defy, revolt

(1) resist temptation, (2) resist being kissed

I chose to **resist** cancer by trying every possible treatment.

# interpretation

 an explanation or opinion of something, especially that is not immediately obvious

synonym: rendering, explanation, understanding

(1) the **interpretation** of history, (2) open to **interpretation** His **interpretations** of literary works are often unique.

#### moral

adj. concerned with the principles of what is right and wrong, fairness, honesty, etc.

synonym: honest, ethical, conscientious

(1) moral hazard, (2) moral burden

Ethics deals with **moral** conduct.

#### hint

an indirect suggestion; a slight but appreciable amount of something

synonym: clue, indication, suggestion

(1) **hint** of trouble, (2) helpful **hints** 

There was no **hint** of a problem.

# supernatural

adj. of or relating to existence outside the natural world; not able to be explained by natural laws

synonym: paranormal, otherworldly, preternatural

(1) **supernatural** beings, (2) **supernatural** intuition The **supernatural** powers of the witch were the stuff of legends.

# propensity

 a natural inclination, preference, or tendency toward a particular activity, behavior, or opinion

synonym: tendency, inclination, disposition

(1) **propensity** for violence, (2) **propensity** to procrastinate His **propensity** for lying caused him to lose many friends.

#### destruction

n. the act of causing so much damage to something

synonym: devastation, annihilation, ruin

(1) path of **destruction**, (2) cyclonic **destruction**The extinction of several subspecies has been linked to climate change and habitat **destruction**.

# ghastly

adj. causing great horror or fear; shockingly unpleasant or bad

synonym:

horrifying, dreadful, terrifying

(1) **ghastly** sight, (2) **ghastly** mistake

The child's **ghastly** scream echoed through the haunted house.

#### murder

- n. the crime of killing somebody intentionally
- *synonym*: slaying, killing
- (1) **murder** in the second degree, (2) attempted **murder** This intriguing **murder** mystery remains unsolved.

# juxtapose

 to place two or more things side by side, often to compare or contrast them or to create an effect of surprise or incongruity

synonym: place side by side, compare, contrast

(1) juxtapose images, (2) juxtapose two ideas

The artist likes to **juxtapose** different styles and colors in her paintings.

# empathy

n. the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

*synonym*: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

(1) full of **empathy**, (2) **empathy** for patients **Empathy** is also necessary to understand history.

#### victim

 a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

synonym: prey, target, sufferer

(1) **victim** support, (2) **victim** compensation

The **victim** of the crime deserves justice and support to recover from the trauma.

#### haunt

v. to frequent or visit repeatedly, often in a way that is disturbing or unsettling; to occupy or fill the mind, often in a way that is unpleasant or persistent

synonym: stalk, spook, obsess

(1) **haunt** memories, (2) **haunt** my conscience

The crowd's boos and jeers continued to **haunt** the performer long after the show ended.

#### corpse

- n. the dead body of a human being
- *synonym*: body, remains, cadaver
- desiccated corpse, (2) the corpse of an animal
   The police found the corpse in the abandoned building.

# protagonist

- the main character in a literary work, film, or other stories
- synonym: hero, central figure, leading character
- (1) **protagonist** of drama, (2) play a **protagonist**The **protagonist's** triumph over adversity was the theme of this play.

#### confront

- to face, meet or deal with a problem or difficult situation or person
- synonym: engage, encounter, contend
- (1) **confront** a global warming, (2) **confront** the issue He finally decided to **confront** problems directly.

## pioneering

- adj. involving new ideas or methods; being the first of their kind; leading the way in a particular field
- synonym: innovative, groundbreaking, trailblazing
- (1) **pioneering** research, (2) **pioneering** spirit The **pioneering** scientist developed a breakthrough technology that revolutionized the industry.

#### unreliable

- adj. not able to be trusted or depended onsynonym: inconsistent, erratic, undependable
- (1) prove **unreliable**, (2) **unreliable** source of information By incorrect assumption, statistics can be notoriously **unreliable**.

## participate

- v. to take part in somethingsynonym: take part, partake, enter
- (1) **participate** fully in conversation, (2) **participate** in the program

The majority of students actively **participated** in the college's intramural sports program.

#### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering optionssynonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

# storytelling

- n. the act or art of narrating or writing storiessynonym: narrating, relating, recounting
- (1) **storytelling** performance, (2) courtroom **storytelling** She was skilled in **storytelling** techniques, such as using different voices for other characters.

# misinterpret

- v. to understand or explain something in the wrong way synonym: misunderstand, falsify, misconstrue
- (1) **misinterpret** the purpose, (2) **misinterpret** the data He **misinterpreted** her statement and got the wrong idea.

#### relate

to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

synonym: connect, link, associate

(1) **relate** a story, (2) **relate** a message He tried to **relate** his experience to the group, but they couldn't understand.

#### versatile

adj. able to do many things in different fields; having many talents

*synonym*: adaptable, protean, universal

(1) provide a **versatile** solution, (2) a **versatile** writer He's a **versatile** actor who has acted in various parts.

# experimental

adj. relating to or based on new ideas, forms, methods, etc. that have not been tried before, usually to find out what effect they have

synonym: empirical, exploratory, observed

(1) **experimental** data, (2) **experimental** design The product is still in the **experimental** stage.

## invention

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventing

*synonym*: creation, design, innovation

(1) the **invention** of new techniques, (2) common **invention** Necessity is the mother of **invention**.

#### detective

 a person whose job it is to find out information about crimes and find out who did them

synonym: gumshoe, investigator, hawkshaw

(1) detective work, (2) detective movieThe detective diligently pursued his cases.

#### rue

v. to feel regret or remorse over something that one has done or failed to do; to feel sorrow or pity for someone or something

*synonym*: regret, repent, lament

(1) **rue** the day, (2) **rue** my mistake

I **rue** not having studied harder when I was younger.

#### morgue

 a place where dead bodies are kept, particularly in preparation for burial or identification by their relatives or authorities

synonym: mortuary, funeral home, charnel house

(1) clinical morgue, (2) overcrowded morgue

The attendant at the **morgue** was responsible for cataloging the bodies and their respective information.

feat

*n.* a notable or impressive achievement, especially one that requires great skill or bravery

synonym: achievement, accomplishment, exploit

(1) intellectual **feat**, (2) **feat** accomplishment It is an incredible **feat** to climb Mount Everest, the highest mountain in the world.

genius

someone who has exceptional intellectual ability and originality

*synonym*: brilliance, brainiac, acumen

(1) a person of **genius**, (2) a **genius** for music Mozart was a musical **genius**.

observation

n. the act or activity of carefully examining or monitoring something or someone

synonym: watching, notice, reflection

- (1) class **observation** day, (2) **observation** instrument In the hospital, she will remain under constant **observation**.
- v. to take away an amount or part of the money, points, etc. from a total

synonym: remove, subtract, withdraw

(1) **deduct** the interest, (2) **deduct** \$100 from the price The bank **deducted** the premium amount from his bank account.

baffle

deduct

v. to bewilder or perplex someone completely and to be unable to understand or explain something

synonym: perplex, astound, hinder

(1) **baffle** his plan, (2) **baffle** outside noises The paradox **baffled** most philosophers.

satire

 a literary or artistic work that uses irony, sarcasm, humor, ridicule, or exaggeration to criticize human vices, follies, or shortcomings; a genre of literature or art that uses such techniques

synonym: irony, mockery, ridicule

(1) satire magazine, (2) a pungent satire

The comedian's **satire** on politics had the audience laughing and thinking.

trend

hoax

 a general direction in which something is changing or developing

synonym: direction, movement, tendency

- (1) an international **trend**, (2) the **trend** away from television The oil price continued their downward **trend**.
- a deliberately fabricated deception, often intended to trick or mislead people into believing something that is not true; a practical joke or prank

synonym: deception, fraud, trick

(1) suspect a hoax, (2) hoax email

The newspaper article was revealed to be a **hoax**.

anticipate

v. to expect or predict that something will happen; to tell in advance

*synonym*: forecast, predict, expect

(1) **anticipate** your kind cooperation, (2) **anticipate** a black future

We anticipate heavy snowfall tomorrow.

fiction

 n. the type of book or story, especially novels, that describes imaginary events and people; anything made up or imagined that is not true

synonym: fantasy, fable, invention

(1) stuff of science **fiction**, (2) non- **fiction** bestseller Truth is stranger than **fiction**.

balloon

 a small bag made of thin rubber or other light material that can be inflated with air or gas, used as a toy or as a decoration; (verb) to become inflated

synonym: aerostat, blimp, (verb) billow out

(1) **balloon** ride, (2) **balloon** into a severe political problem The satellite **balloon** slowly ascended into the sky.

# patient

 a person who is receiving medical treatment, care, or attention from a healthcare professional, such as a doctor, nurse, or therapist; a personal quality or characteristic

synonym: client, recipient, subject

(1) **patient** in the hospital, (2) **patient** with weight loss. The doctor carefully examined the **patient's** medical history.

# hypnotic

adj. inducing sleep; causing sleepiness, mainly as a result of a repetitive noise or motion

synonym: soothing, soporific, slumberous

(1) mild **hypnotic**, (2) **hypnotic** effect

His voice had a hypnotic quality for me.

#### trance

n. a state of altered consciousness in which a person may seem to be asleep or unconscious but, in reality, is highly responsive to suggestion; a state of being deeply absorbed in thought or feeling, often characterized by a heightened awareness of one's surroundings and emotions

synonym: stupor, hypnosis, daydreaming

(1) **trance** state, (2) meditative **trance** 

The rhythmic beat of the drums kept the audience in a trance.

#### adventure

n. a journey or a series of events that is unusual, exciting, or dangerous

synonym: experience, happening, incident

(1) gastronomic **adventures**, (2) **adventure** film He sailed the Atlantic Ocean multiple times during his **adventures**.

novel

 an extended fictional work in prose; usually in the form of a story; (adjective) original and of a kind not seen before

synonym: fiction, story, (adjective) innovative

(1) historical novel, (2) novel effect

The **novel** has largely gotten positive feedback.

## pole

one of two antipodal points where the Earth's axis of rotation intersects the Earth's surface; a long, slender, rounded rod, typically of wood or metal, used as a support or to hang something

synonym: rod, staff, shaft

(1) a fishing **pole**, (2) the plus **pole** 

The North **Pole** is the northernmost point on Earth.

# astrophysics

- n. the branch of physics concerned with the study of the properties and behavior of celestial objects and the physical processes that govern the behavior and evolution of the universe
- (1) **astrophysics** research, (2) neutrino **astrophysics**He was studying **astrophysics** in an attempt to understand the origins of the universe.

#### edit

v. to prepare written material for publication by correcting, condensing, or otherwise modifying it

*synonym*: revise, modify, adjust

(1) edit a history book, (2) edit a video

I need to edit this document before submitting it to my boss.

# appreciation

 the act of recognizing and valuing the worth or importance of something or someone; gratitude or thankfulness; an increase in value over time

synonym: recognition, admiration, esteem

(1) express my **appreciation**, (2) **appreciation** for diversity The artist received a lot of **appreciation** for his latest work.

#### poetry

- n. poems in general as a genre of literature
- *synonym*: ode, poesy, verse
- (1) modern **poetry**, (2) book of **poetry**

Different cultures have different comfortable word rhythms, so the composition of **poetry** varies greatly.

# haunting

adj. lingering in the mind or memory, often in a disturbing or unsettling way; (noun) something difficult to forget or

#### shake off

*synonym*: lingering, disturbing, unsettling

(1) **haunting** memory, (2) a **haunting** sense of fear The song's **haunting** melody stayed with me long after I heard it.

## poem

 a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas by paying particular attention to diction (sometimes rhyme), rhythm, and imagery

synonym: ballad, lyric, verse

(1) a narrative **poem**, (2) **poem** to the dead A great **poem** is a fountain forever overflowing with the waters of wisdom and delight.

#### mournful

adj. expressing or showing sorrow or grief; sad; melancholy synonym: melancholy, doleful, mournsome

(1) **mournful** tears, (2) **mournful** expression

The **mournful** sound of the trumpet echoed through the church during the funeral service.

## remembrance

- n. the act of remembering or honoring a person, event, or thing from the past; a memory or mementosynonym: memory, recollection, commemoration
- (1) **remembrance** day, (2) eternal **remembrance**The annual **remembrance** ceremony honors those who sacrificed their lives for the country.

mere

 adj. used to emphasize how insignificant or minor someone or something is

*synonym*: bare, minor, sheer

(1) mere acquaintance, (2) mere incidentHe lost the election by mere votes.

## poverty

- n. the condition of being extremely poorsynonym: deprivation, destitution, poorness
- (1) **poverty** alleviation, (2) the cycle of **poverty**

Many studies have investigated the relationship between **poverty** and academic achievement.

#### haunted

adj. inhabited, visited, or frequented by ghosts or spirits;
 disturbed or troubled by persistent or disturbing
 memories or emotions

synonym: spooky, eerie, ghostly

(1) haunted house, (2) haunted by memories

The old mansion was known to be **haunted**, with strange noises and eerie sightings reported by visitors.

## tuberculosis

- an infectious disease usually caused by tubercle bacteria that can attack many parts of a person's body, especially their lungs
- (1) died of **tuberculosis**, (2) a medicine for **tuberculosis Tuberculosis** used to be considered a fatal disease.

# struggle

 to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

#### alcoholism

 a chronic disorder characterized by dependence on alcohol and repeated excessive use of alcoholic beverages

*synonym*: alcohol dependency, alcohol addiction, drunkenness

(1) acute **alcoholism**, (2) **alcoholism** recovery He lost everything due to his **alcoholism**.

## frequent

adj. happening constantly

synonym: periodic, recurring, routine

(1) **frequent** absence, (2) **frequent** use His heartaches are less **frequent** now.

# antagonize

v. to cause someone to feel anger or hostility; to provoke or irritate

synonym: provoke, annoy, irritate

(1) **antagonize** an enemy, (2) **antagonize** a rival team His constant nitpicking and criticism only served to **antagonize** his coworkers.

#### fame

 n. the condition of being well-known and discussed by a large number of people as a result of one's accomplishments, abilities, and so on

synonym: celebrity, renown, stardom
