#### overwhelm

Too much variety may **overwhelm** and confuse viewers.

ace

 a playing card with a single symbol or mark that is typically the highest in value or rank in a particular card game; a person who is very skilled or successful in a specific activity or field

#### dentist

a person who is qualified and licensed to treat people's teeth

### veterinarian

### perceive

# perception

 a belief, opinion, or image you have based on how you regard, understand, or interpret something; the ability to see, hear, or notice something through the senses

#### universal

adj. existing or affecting everywhere or everyone

synonym: common, broad, worldwide

# anxiety

 a feeling of worry, nervousness, or unease about something that is happening or might happen in the future

synonym: concern, dread, agita

# inexcusable

adj. impossible to excuse or justify; reprehensible or unforgivable

synonym: unforgivable, unjustifiable, indefensible

### define

 to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

synonym: characterize, depict, express

# premed

- n. (an abbreviation for "pre-medical") a course of study or preparation undertaken by students planning to enter medical school or pursue a career in medicine
- (1) **premed** class, (2) **premed** coursework

frank

- adj. honest and sincere; open and candid in expressionsynonym: candid, direct, freehearted

#### anxious

adj. worried and nervous

synonym: nervous, uneasy, afraid

### adrenaline

n. (also "epinephrine") a substance secreted by the adrenal medulla in response to stress, which makes the heart beat faster and prepares the body to react to danger

synonym: epinephrine

#### restart

## allergic

 (in chemistry) a process in which one or more substances are changed into others synonym: response, reply, answer

# injection

n. the act of introducing a liquid, especially a drug, into the body using a needle and a syringe

synonym: shot, infusion, dose

# ignition

n. the act of starting a fire, engine, or other device; the beginning or starting point of a process or event

#### flee

v. to leave by running away, especially out of fear or danger

# machinery

 a group of large machines or the components of a machine that make it work; social institution functions or structure for doing something

synonym: apparatus, appliance, equipment

## pupil

 the black circular opening in the center of the iris of the eye, through which light enters the eye; a student in school or university

*synonym*: iris, eye aperture, student

The <b>pupil</b> of your eye dilates in response to different light
levels.

#### dilate

- v. to make something wider, larger, or more open synonym: widen, open, enlarge

# strength

 the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

synonym: resilience, power, muscles

 an act or occurrence that is not explicable by natural or scientific laws and is therefore believed to be caused by God

synonym: wonder, marvel, phenomenon

# chemical

adj. relating to or connected with chemistry;

synonym: chemic, synthetic

toxic chemicals, (2) a chemical compound
 The firm has grown into a large chemical manufacturing.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

# depth

the distance between the top and bottom of something;
 between the top surface and a distance below it

synonym: deepness, profoundness, extent

(1) depth camera, (2) the depth of the water

rot ν. to decay, or cause something to decay, naturally and gradually

synonym: perish, decay, corrode

# compound

 an item composed of two or more distinct elements combined; a chemical formed by the combination of two or more elements

synonym: combination, mixture, blend

#### molecule

 a group of two or more atoms held together by attractive forces known as chemical bonds

synonym: particle, element, atom

#### atom

 n. the smallest unit of ordinary matter that forms a chemical element, composed of a nucleus and one or more electrons bound to the nucleus

The outermost electron shell of an **atom** determines its chemical characteristics.

#### stitch

- one of the tiny thread lines visible on a piece of fabric after it has been sewn

# arrangement

 a plan or preparation for the future event; the action or process of placing things in a particular order

synonym: placement, configuration, account

# identity

n. the fact of being who or what somebody or something is; the features, emotions, or ideas that distinguish persons from one another

synonym: character, personality, individuality

(1) mistaken **identity**, (2) **identity** as an individual The terrorist's **identity** remains unknown.

### artistic

adj. of or relating to art or artist; satisfying aesthetic standards and sensibilities

synonym: beautiful, aesthetic, creative

(1) an **artistic** photograph, (2) cultural and **artistic** activity Promising entrepreneurs often have a high **artistic** sensibility.

# impressive

adj. arousing admiration due to size, quality, or skill synonym: impactful, remarkable, exceptional

#### gram

- n. a metric unit of weight equal to one-thousandth of a kilogram

# galaxy

n. an independent group of stars, interstellar gas, dark matter, etc., in the universe, bound together by gravity

synonym: star cluster, nebula, star system

The Milky Way **galaxy** has numerous water-bearing planets.

# ballpark

v. a place or facility where baseball is played; a rough estimation of something

#### shrink

v. to become smaller, or to make something smaller in size or amount

# microscope

 an instrument used to see objects or substances that are too small to be seen with the naked eye

# sophisticated

adj. having a great deal of worldly experience and knowledge of people's behavior, culture, and fashionsynonym: refined, cultured, worldly

# fancy

v. to want to do or have something; (noun) something that many people believe but that is false, or that does not exist; imagination or fantasy

#### nuclear

adj. of or relating to or constituting the nucleus of an atom; deriving destructive energy from the release of atomic energy

synonym: atomic

Many countries have now agreed to a treaty banning the use of **nuclear** weapons.

## magnetic

adj. having the properties of attracting or repelling certain materials containing iron or steel

synonym: attractive, drawing, hypnotic

#### resonance

 a deep, full, or reverberating sound or tone; a quality or feeling of a particular emotional or mental vibration or significance; a mutual or sympathetic connection or correspondence between two things

# spectrometer

 a scientific device used to measure the properties of light or other radiation, often used in chemistry and physics to analyze the composition of materials

synonym: spectroscope, analyzer, detector

(1) **spectrometer** measurement, (2) optical **spectrometer** The infrared **spectrometer** helped identify the chemical composition of the sample.

#### visible

adj. capable of being seen; or open to easy view synonym: clear, observable, seeable

# hydrogen

- the chemical element that is the lightest gas is colorless, odorless, tasteless, and combines with oxygen to form water
- (1) hydrogen gas, (2) heavy hydrogenThe hydrogen and the oxygen react and then form water.

#### carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emission
   Trees absorb carbon dioxide and give off oxygen.

# oxygen

n. the chemical element with the symbol O that is present in air and water and is necessary for people, animals, and plants to live

### nitrogen

- a chemical element with the symbol N and atomic number 7, which is a highly reactive element that forms part of many compounds, including amino acids and proteins

# typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

# universe

 everything that exists, especially all physical matter, including planets, stars, galaxies, and all other forms of matter and energy

synonym: cosmos, macrocosm

(1) theory of the **universe**, (2) expansion of the **universe** The **universe** is about 13.8 billion years old.

# sphere

 a round object or geometric shape that is three-dimensional and symmetrical around a central point; a particular aspect or scope of life or activity

synonym: ball, globe, scope

(1) **sphere** of influence, (2) business **sphere**The **sphere** of the earth is divided into several layers including the crust, mantle, and core.

# ingredient

- n. one of the things used to make something, especially one of the foods used to make a particular dishsynonym: element, component
- secret ingredients, (2) compound the ingredients
   Greed is the primary ingredient in the making of criminals.

## particle

- n. a small piece of something; a word or piece of a term with grammatical function but little or no significance synonym: atom, grain, bit

### proton

- a very small particle with a positive charge equal to the negative charge of an electron that forms part of the nucleus of all atoms

# misspell

v. to spell incorrectly or wrongly; to use an incorrect spelling for a word

synonym: miscopy, mismark

#### honk

 a loud, harsh sound made by a vehicle's horn to signal a warning or attract attention

synonym: beep, toot, blare

(1) **honk** sound, (2) **honk** for attention

The incessant **honk** of the car's horn woke me from sleep.

#### handshake

a greeting or form of introduction in which two people grasp each other's hands and briefly grip and shake them; (of computer science) a process by which two devices or software applications establish a connection and exchange information to ensure that they can communicate effectively

synonym: greeting, handclasp, welcome

(1) handshake protocol, (2) virtual handshake

The two business partners sealed the deal with a **handshake**.

## permanent

adj. lasting for a long time without essential change synonym: lasting, ceaseless, endless

#### grab

v. to take hold of something or someone suddenly with a hand, especially in a violent way

synonym: clutch, snatch, grasp

## exchange

to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

*synonym*: trade, swap, interchange

(1) **exchange** rate, (2) **exchange** a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.

#### backbone

the spinal column of a vertebrate; a symbolic representation of strength and resilience

*synonym*: spine, courage, fortitude

(1) backbone of society, (2) backbone curve She showed great **backbone** when standing up for her beliefs in opposition.

#### structural

adj. associated with the way on construction or organization of anything

synonym: architectural, basic, anatomical

- (1) **structural** analyses, (2) **structural** reorganization The earthquake resulted in significant **structural** destruction.
- the act of holding onto something firmly with your hands, or the ability to do so; (verb) to hold fast or firmly

synonym: grasp, clasp, (verb) hold

(1) grip of fear, (2) lose my grip

He had a firm **grip** on the rope as he climbed the mountain.

# highlight

to make something prominent, mainly so that people give it more attention

*synonym*: feature, emphasize, stress

(1) **highlight** a string in red, (2) **highlight** an important difference

The introduction **highlighted** the speaker's distinguished career as a consultant

# grip

#### ammonia

- a compound of nitrogen and hydrogen that forms a gas with a strong smell, used as cleaning substances, fertilizers, and explosives
- (1) **ammonia** water, (2) inhale **ammonia** fumes
  The advent of **ammonia** fertilizers markedly increased agricultural productivity.

#### methane

- a chemical compound with the chemical formula CH4 with no smell or color, often used as a fuel
- (1) atmospheric **methane**, (2) reduce **methane** emissions The ignition of **methane** gas in the plant killed five employees.

#### combustion

- n. the act or process of burning somethingsynonym: burning, burst

#### oxide

- a chemical compound that contains at least one oxygen atom and one other element

#### flammable

fuel

 a substance that is typically burned to generate heat or energy

synonym: energy, power, gas

#### sector

# hydrocarbon

- an organic compound consisting entirely of hydrogen and carbon
- (1) **hydrocarbon** production, (2) **hydrocarbon** molecules in crude oil

Burning **hydrocarbons** releases water vapor and carbon dioxide.

#### creative

adj. relating to or involving the use of skill and original and unusual ideas to create something

synonym: imaginative, innovative, inventive

All the supervisor has to do is assign tasks that make his subordinates more **creative**.

# engine

 a machine that converts thermal energy to mechanical work; something that has an important role used to achieve a purpose

synonym: motor, locomotive, driver

(1) a steam engine, (2) an air-cooled engine

The policies he announces can be the **engine** of economic growth in the country.

#### barbecue

 a cooking method or apparatus that uses open flames or heated coals to grill or smoke meat, fish, or vegetables; a social gathering or meal characterized by outdoor grilling or barbecuing of food

synonym: grill, cookout, outdoor cooking

(1) barbecue sauce, (2) barbecue grill

The **barbecue** at the park was a hit with all the families who attended.

#### release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) release a prisoner, (2) release CO2 into the air

The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

#### assemble

- v. to collect in one place as a single group synonym: gather, congregate, collect
- (1) **assemble** your colleagues, (2) **assemble** a jigsaw puzzle

The president began to **assemble** an army.

#### vitamin

 any of a group of organic compounds that are essential in small quantities to the diet and are present in natural foodstuffs or sometimes produced within the body

synonym: nutrient, micronutrient, dietary supplement

(1) rich in vitamin D, (2) vitamin deficiency

**Vitamin** C is important for immune system function and skin health.

# morphine

 a powerful narcotic drug used to relieve pain and induce sleep

synonym: narcotic, painkiller, sedative

(1) **morphine** addiction, (2) synthetic **morphine**Long-term use of **morphine** can lead to tolerance, physical dependence, and addiction.
