bay

 a part of the coast that is partially enclosed by land; a compartment or section of a ship or building

architecture

the art and science of designing and constructing buildings

synonym: design, structure, layout

synonym: musical, operetta, oratorio

opera

institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

disrepair

 to renovate or improve something old or worn out, typically by cleaning, repairing, or replacing parts to restore its original condition or appearance

coop

- v. a farm building or enclosure for housing poultry synonym: birdcage, enclosure, cage

hay

n. grass that has been cut and dried for use as animal feed or bedding; a stack or bale of this dried grass

synonym: straw, fodder, forage

bale

 a large bundle of goods such as cotton, hay, or paper; a bundle of goods used to weigh a product, especially wool, hay, etc

disability

underneath

adv. under or below something else

synonym: below, under, beneath

(1) **underneath** the surface of the water, (2) **underneath** the laughter

discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important **discovery**.

wharf

 a landing place or platform built along the shore of a body of water, typically used for loading and unloading goods and passengers from ships or boats

synonym: dock, pier, quay

(1) wharf crane, (2) riverfront wharf

The workers loaded the barrels of wine onto the truck at the wharf.

diaspora

n. the scattering of a people who have left their traditional homeland

synonym: scattering, dispersion, migration

(1) **diaspora** migration, (2) **diaspora** community

The **diaspora** of the Jewish people has led to a worldwide community.

harry

v. to persistently harass, badger, or bother someone or something; to persistently attack or pursue an opposing force or target

synonym: bother, pester, annoy

celebrate

v. to acknowledge a memorable or good day or event with a social gathering or enjoyable activity

synonym: praise, glorify, honor

beneath

adv. in or to a lower place than someone or something synonym: down, under, low

(1) the ground **beneath** my feet, (2) **beneath** contempt A great stretch of the lake lay **beneath** them.

chain

 a series of connected links or objects; a system or group of interconnected elements; a restraint or shackle

synonym: series, string, link

(1) chain reaction, (2) supply chain

The **chain** on my bike broke, leaving me stranded.

shark

 a long-bodied, mostly predatory marine fish that has sharp teeth and a pointed fin on its back; a person who is ruthless, greedy, and dishonest

synonym: swindler, con artist, crook

(1) a man-eating **shark**, (2) card **shark**

He borrowed money from a loan **shark**.

slave

 a person who is, either legally or illegally, owned by someone; a person entirely dominated by some influence or a person

synonym: captive, bondservant, hard worker

hallowed

adj. considered holy or sacred; deserving of reverence or respect

column

tabby

The little girl couldn't resist the **tabby's** purr as the cat curled up in her lap.

shale

 a sedimentary rock formed from the accumulation of fine-grained clay, silt, or mud, often used in construction or as a source of fuel

The geologist studied the **shale** layers in the rock formations to determine their age.

scoop

 a tool for lifting or moving substances in bulk, typically using a concave or spoon-shaped end; a piece of news that is obtained or published before anyone else

Atlantic

awful

 adj. hot, humid, and oppressively close; having a certain sensuality or sexual allure

marsh

a type of land that is always wet and has soft soil;
 swamp or bog

sickle

 a tool consisting of a short curved blade with a handle, used for cutting grass or grain; also a symbol associated with harvest or death

trait

1. a particular feature of your nature
