#### chemical

adj. relating to or connected with chemistry;

synonym: chemic, synthetic

(1) toxic chemicals, (2) a chemical compound

The firm has grown into a large chemical manufacturing.

#### substance

 n. the real physical material of which a thing or person consist; the most important or main part of some idea or experience; an illegal drug

synonym: essence, core, material

- (1) an explosive **substance**, (2) **substance** abuse problem The **substance** of the argument was well-presented.
- an ensemble of similar cells of the animal or plant that together carry out a specific function

synonym: structure, texture, anatomy

(1) a facial tissue, (2) loss of muscle tissue

The researcher separated the nervous **tissue** for microscopic examinations.

tar

tissue

 a thick, sticky substance that is dark in color and is commonly used for road surfacing or as a material for roofing; a common byproduct of burning coal or wood

synonym: asphalt, pitch, bitumen

(1) tar residue, (2) tar component

The road workers spread **tar** over the cracks in the pavement to prevent water and ice from causing further damage.

resin

n. a sticky, viscous substance typically obtained from trees and plants, particularly conifers and evergreens; a material used in the manufacture of adhesives, plastics, and other products, particularly those that require stiffness or abrasion resistance

synonym: sap, gum, pitch

(1) tree **resin**, (2) synthetic **resin** 

The guitar was coated with a **resin** layer to protect the wood and enhance the tone.

gum

n. a soft, sticky substance that is chewed to freshen the breath or to clean the teeth; the flesh that surrounds the teeth in the mouth

synonym: mucilage, glue, alveolar arch

(1) bubble gum, (2) chewing gum

I always like having a pack of **gum** to freshen my breath.

dam

 a wall constructed over a river to block the flow of water, mainly used to generate energy

synonym: barricade, barrier, embankment

(1) dam-building program, (2) dam collapsing

The break in the **dam** threatened the valley.

enamel

 a hard, glossy coating that is applied to surfaces such as metal, glass, or ceramics to protect them from wear, corrosion, or weathering; the hard, white outer layer of teeth

synonym: glaze, varnish, coating

(1) **enamel** coating, (2) **enamel** mugs

The dentist recommended using toothpaste with extra **enamel** protection to prevent cavities.

eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

*synonym*: finally, someday, ultimately

(1) **eventually** become obsolete, (2) **eventually** succeed The corporation **eventually** dominated the entire tobacco business.

decay

 n. the process or state of rotting or decomposition by natural causes such as the action of bacteria and fungi; (verb) to rot or decompose through natural causes

synonym: corrosion, decomposition, deterioration

radioactive decay, (2) prevent tooth decay
 The dead body was in an advanced state of decay.

### damage

v. to harm or cause injury to something or someone, often resulting in decreased value or functionality; to impair or negatively affect something, such as a reputation or relationship; (noun) harm or injury that is caused to a person, thing, or entity

synonym: harm, impair, injure

(1) **damage** a relationship, (2) **damage** assessment During the surgery, the doctor had to be extremely cautious not to **damage** a blood vessel.

#### nervous

adj. worried and anxious about something; relating to the nerves

synonym: neural, anxious, uneasy

(1) development of the **nervous** system, (2) get **nervous** He suffers from **nervous** breakdowns.

### airway

n. the air passage from the nose and throat to the lungs; a designated route followed by airplanes flying from one airport to another

synonym: air passage, air duct, skyway

(1) airway blockage, (2) airway beacon

When performing lifesaving, the first step is to secure the **airway**.

### lung

- *n*. either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing
- Iung capacity, (2) do lung transplantation
   He has terminal lung cancer.

#### likelihood

 the probability or chance that something will happen or be the case

synonym: probability, chance, possibility

(1) **likelihood** of the success, (2) improve the **likelihood** of a cure

The **likelihood** of the project being completed on time is uncertain.

#### infection

 a condition in which pathogenic microorganisms or viruses have entered the body

*synonym*: contagion, disease, transmission

(1) a bacterial **infection**, (2) treat the **infection** with antibiotics

Hospitals must meet various standards to prevent nosocomial **infections**.

#### chronic

adj. being long-lasting and recurrent or characterized by long suffering; habitual

synonym: established, regular, constant

(1) risk of **chronic** disease, (2) **chronic** alcohol consumption

**Chronic** hyperglycemia is a trigger for a variety of serious diseases.

#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

(1) disease prevention, (2) disease control

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

#### bronchitis

an inflammation of the bronchial tubes, often resulting in cough, chest discomfort, and difficulty breathing, can be caused by viral or bacterial infections, environmental irritants, or other factors

synonym: chest cold, respiratory infection, bronchial inflammation

(1) viral **bronchitis**, (2) chronic **bronchitis** 

I have a terrible case of **bronchitis** and need to see a doctor.

### emphysema

n. a chronic respiratory disease often caused by smoking or exposure to air pollutants, characterized by damage to the lungs over time, which results in shortness of breath and other respiratory symptoms

synonym: COPD, lung disease, respiratory disorder

(1) **emphysema** treatment, (2) chronic **emphysema**The onset of **emphysema** can be gradual, with symptoms appearing over several years.

#### cilium

 a microscopic, hair-like cellular projection that is found on the surface of many cells in the body, helping them to move or trap debris

synonym: eyelash, flagellum

(1) **cilium** movement, (2) primary **cilium** 

The microscopic analysis revealed a **cilium's** presence on the single-celled organism's surface.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

#### alveolus

 n. (in the plural, "alveoli") a small, hollow cavity, pit, or socket; the small sacs in the lungs, where gas exchange with the blood occurs

synonym: cavity, air sac, socket

(1) tooth alveolus, (2) alveolus function

Damage to the walls of an **alveolus** can lead to reduced lung function.

sac

 a bag or pouch, typically made of fabric or leather, used to hold something valuable or important; a structure resembling a bag in an animal or plant

synonym: bag, pouch, knapsack

(1) sac contents, (2) abdominal sac

I placed my valuables in the **sac** before heading out on my hike.

### exchange

v. to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

*synonym*: trade, swap, interchange

(1) **exchange** rate, (2) **exchange** a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.

### oxygen

- the chemical element with the symbol O that is present in air and water and is necessary for people, animals, and plants to live
- (1) the hydrogen binds the **oxygen**, (2) lack of **oxygen** The passenger grabbed for the **oxygen** mask.

#### carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- (1) carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emissionTrees absorb carbon dioxide and give off oxygen.

#### oxide

- a chemical compound that contains at least one oxygen atom and one other element
- (1) silver oxide, (2) combined oxideThe blood's red coloring comes from iron oxide.

toxic

adj. of or relating to or caused by a poison; poisonous synonym: poisonous, harmful, contaminated

(1) **toxic** molecule, (2) exposure to **toxic** chemicals

This chemical compound is a thousand-fold more **toxic**.

### monoxide

- a compound containing one oxygen atom and one other element, such as carbon monoxide (CO) or nitrogen monoxide (NO)
- (1) sulfur monoxide, (2) nitrogen monoxide

Carbon **monoxide** is a deadly gas released by cars and other machinery.

#### membrane

- n. a soft, thin layer that forms animal or vegetable tissuesynonym: tissue layer
- (1) cell membranes,(2) nuclear membraneLoud noises might harm the fragile ear membrane.

### bind

v. to tie or fasten someone or something tightly with rope, string, etc. so that they cannot move or are held together strongly

synonym: tie, stick to, adhere

(1) **bind** the man's hands, (2) **bind** old letters into a bundle The company's rules **bind** the employee's working hours.

### hemoglobin

 a protein-based molecule found in red blood cells that transports oxygen throughout the body

synonym: red cell pigment, oxygen carrier

(1) **hemoglobin** level, (2) abnormal **hemoglobin**The **hemoglobin** gene mutation can cause genetic disorders such as sickle cell disease.

### displace

v. to force someone or something to leave their home or place of origin, especially as a result of conflict, natural disaster, or manipulation

synonym: evict, exile, remove

(1) **displace** workers, (2) **displace** the explosive power The construction of the new dam will **displace** hundreds of families living downstream.

### transport

- a system for moving people or products from one location to another using automobiles, roads, and so on synonym: shipment, transit, conveyance
- (1) **transport** facilities, (2) access to public **transport** Enhanced rail **transportation** is crucial for our business.

### deprivation

*n.* a state of not having something, such as food or money, that you need for a pleasant life

synonym: poverty, destitution, forfeiture

(1) chronic sleep **deprivation**, (2) **deprivation** of liberty Losing him is great **deprivation** to our team.

#### breath

the air that is taken into and expelled from your lungs;
 the process of taking into and expelling air from your lungs

synonym: air, puff, whiff

(1) hold your breath, (2) breath of windHe bated his breath when talking about this affair.

#### bloodstream

- *n.* the blood flowing through the body
- (1) **bloodstream** in an artery, (2) **bloodstream** to the brain Cancer cells are often carried throughout the body by the **bloodstream**.

#### stimulant

 a substance or drug that increases or heightens physiological or nervous system activity typically used to improve alertness, attention, or concentration

synonym: upper, energizer, booster

(1) memory **stimulant**, (2) prescription **stimulant**Many athletes use **stimulants** like caffeine to boost their energy before a competition.

nicotine

 a colorless, oily, poisonous chemical compound found in tobacco leaves, which is highly addictive and acts as a stimulant, affecting the nervous system

synonym: tobacco, smoke

(1) **nicotine** patch, (2) **nicotine** replacement therapy Smoking cigarettes exposes the body to high levels of **nicotine**, which can be addictive.

brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

*synonym*: intellect, mind, encephalon

(1) basic **brain** function, (2) permanent **brain** damage X-rays revealed a small tumor in his **brain**.

### trigger

- v. to make something happen suddenly; to cause something such as a device, machine, etc. to functionsynonym: activate, spark, drive
- (1) **trigger** a biochemical response, (2) **trigger** inflation The incident **triggered** a political controversy.

#### release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge
- (1) **release** a prisoner, (2) **release** CO2 into the air
  The animal rights group worked to **release** the dolphins back into the wild.

### dopamine

- a chemical substance produced by nerve cells as a neurotransmitter; as a drug, it is used to treat shock and hypotension
- (1) **dopamine-inhibiting** agent, (2) antagonism of **dopamine**

The drug controls the level of **dopamine** in the brain.

#### neurotransmitter

- a chemical that carries nerve impulses between neurons or between neurons and muscles
- (1) **neurotransmitter** receptor, (2) **neurotransmitters** released from the brain

Endorphins are a type of **neurotransmitter** that gives a sense of well-being.

### endorphin

 a natural hormone-like substance that is produced by the body and that acts on the nervous system to reduce pain and induce a feeling of well-being

synonym: pain reliever, mood elevator

(1) beta- endorphin, (2) endorphin rush

The release of **endorphins** during exercise can provide a natural high and help to relieve stress.

### pleasurable

adj. giving satisfaction or pleasure; enjoyable

synonym: comforting, enjoyable, gratifying

(1) a **pleasurable** experience, (2) have a very **pleasurable** 

time

Our marital life was full of happiness and **pleasurable** excitement.

### addictive

adj. causing a strong desire or compulsion to use or consume repeatedly, often to the point of dependency or harm; habit-forming

synonym: habit-forming, captivating, compelling

(1) highly addictive, (2) addictive substance

The new video game was so **addictive** that he stayed up all night playing it.

### simultaneously

adv. at the same time

*synonym*: concurrently, coincidently, together

(1) **simultaneously** affected, (2) take several inputs **simultaneously** 

Two students answered the teacher's question **simultaneously**.

#### constrict

v. to make something narrow or tight, often restricting movement or flow; to become narrow or tighter

*synonym*: squeeze, compress, tighten

(1) **constrict** blood vessels, (2) **constrict** freedom

The snake's muscles began to **constrict** around its prey.

#### vessel

n. a ship or large boat

synonym: boat, ship, craft

(1) blood vessels, (2) naval vessels

The **vessel** arrived in port the following day.

#### endothelium

 the thin layer of cells that lines the interior surface of blood vessels and plays a critical role in regulating blood flow and blood clotting (1) **endothelium** layer, (2) **endothelium** function

The **endothelium** damage caused by smoking can lead to several health complications.

#### restrict

- v. to limit someone's actions or movements, or to limit something to lessen its size or prevent it from increasing synonym: limit, confine, hinder
- (1) **restrict** an Internet access, (2) **restrict** the use of this parking lot

We **restrict** the number of students per course to twenty.

### vascular

- adj. of or relating to blood vessels, especially the veins and arteries that carry blood throughout the body
- synonym: circulatory, cardiovascular, arterial
- (1) **vascular** disease, (2) **vascular** surgery

  The doctor detected a blockage in the patient's **vascular** system.

#### enhance

v. to increase or improve the quality, amount, or strength of someone or something

synonym: improve, enrich, refine

(1) **enhance** value, (2) **enhance** the flavor of the vanilla The new strategy will **enhance** the profitability of our company.

### platelet

 a small, disc-shaped blood cell that is involved in the formation of blood clots and the maintenance of hemostasis (the process by which the body stops bleeding)

synonym: thrombocyte, clotting cell

(1) **platelet-rich** plasma, (2) **platelet** transfusion My doctor said that my **platelet** count is a little low.

### sticky

adj. made of or covered with an adhesive substance; hot or warm and humid

synonym: adhesive, gluey, clingy

(1) **sticky** weather, (2) **sticky** situation

A peculiar **sticky** material coated the foliage.

clot

 a thick mass or lump of coagulated liquid, especially blood; a group of people or things that form an obstructive, unsympathetic, or resistant force

*synonym*: clump, coagulation, thrombus

(1) blood **clot**, (2) **clot** prevention

The **clot** in the blood vessel required immediate medical attention.

stroke

 a medical condition in which poor blood flow to the brain causes cell death; the act of swinging or striking at a ball with a club, racket, etc.

*synonym*: blow

(1) suffer **stroke**, (2) a **stroke** of the putter

This year's extreme heat has resulted in many heat **stroke** cases.

mutation

 the way in which genes of a person, plant, animal, or other organism change and produce permanent differences

synonym: metamorphosis, transformation, alteration

(1) mutation of DNA, (2) hereditary mutation

Radiation often promotes genetic **mutations** in plants and animals.

cancer

 abnormal growth of cells that can invade and destroy surrounding tissues and organs; a disease characterized by the uncontrolled growth and spread of abnormal cells

synonym: tumor, carcinoma, malignancy

(1) cancer diagnosis, (2) cancer research

Breast **cancer** is the most common type of cancer in women.

addition

 the act or process of adding something to something else; the process of adding numbers

synonym: accumulation, expansion, addendum

(1) chemical **addition**, (2) **addition** of vectors

In addition, private corporations provide healthcare services.

#### arsenic

 a poisonous chemical element that occurs naturally in some rocks and minerals and is sometimes used in pesticides and wood preservatives

*synonym*: poison, toxin

- (1) **arsenic** poisoning, (2) **arsenic** contamination Exposure to **arsenic** in drinking water can cause serious health problems.
- a silver-white metallic element with the symbol Ni, used in many alloys and as a coin; a United States coin worth one-twentieth of a dollar

synonym: metal, coin, alloy

nickel ore, (2) nickel plate
 The nickel in my pocket jingled as I walked.

### disrupt

nickel

v. to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

*synonym*: interrupt, disturb, break into

(1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

- (1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.
- compromise

v. to settle a problem or disagreement by mutual concession

synonym: agree, settle, negotiate

(1) **compromise** the matter, (2) cannot **compromise** anymore

They never **compromised** on development despite the lack of funds.

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data
- (1) **statistics** for cancer, (2) official **statistics**

The **statistics** demonstrate that poverty and unemployment are genuine problems.

### eyesight

- n. the ability to see; visual acuity or sharpnesssynonym: vision, sight, eyes
- (1) impaired **eyesight**, (2) acute **eyesight**His excellent **eyesight** allowed him to spot the bird in the dense foliage.

### pregnant

- adj. having a baby or young animal developing in the uterus synonym: expectant
- (1) needs of **pregnant** women, (2) a silence **pregnant** with suspense

She vacated the position when she got pregnant.

#### erectile

adj. characterized by the ability to become physically erect, particularly in sexual function

synonym: raised, standing, cavernous

(1) erectile dysfunction, (2) erectile tissues

The drug was found to have significant **erectile** side effects in clinical trials.

# dysfunction

 a problem or fault in a system, organism, or part of the body or machine

synonym: malfunction, disorder, disfunction

(1) **dysfunction** of kidneys, (2) brain **dysfunction**The **dysfunction** in the relationship was causing problems

for both partners.

### quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

(1) easy quitter, (2) serial quitter

He was labeled as a **quitter** after he abandoned the project halfway.

### upside

*n.* the positive aspect or potential of something; the upper side of something

synonym: advantage, benefit, top

(1) have no **upside**, (2) market **upside** 

Many people see the **upside** of traveling as an opportunity to experience new cultures and broaden their horizons.

#### immediate

adj. happening or done without delay or occurring shortly after something else

synonym: prompt, quick, instantaneous

(1) take **immediate** effect, (2) the **immediate** past Both forts were subject to **immediate** attacks.

### long-lasting

adj. existing or continuing for a long time

synonym: enduring, abiding, durable

(1) **long-lasting** battery, (2) a **long-lasting** friendship They finally decided to solve the **long-lasting** problem.

#### smoker

- a person who smokes tobacco regularly, or a device used for smoking
- (1) **smoker** behavior, (2) an inveterate **smoker**Many **smokers** are aware of the health risks associated with smoking but find it difficult to quit.

#### norm

- n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standard synonym: criterion, mean, standard
- (1) **norm** of action, (2) cultural **norm**

The systems we have developed has accepted as industry **norms**.

#### stabilize

v. to become or cause to become steady or unlikely to give way

synonym: brace, steady, secure

(1) **stabilize** prices, (2) **stabilize** blood sugar levels

The raising of interest rates **stabilizes** the inflation rate.

#### cease

### responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

#### recover

- v. to return to a former condition, health, mind, or strength synonym: come back, convalesce, heal
- (1) **recover** a loss, (2) **recover** approval ratings She is still **recovering** from a shot to her shoulder.

### cough

to expel air from the lungs suddenly and noisily, often as a reaction to irritation, illness, or some other physical condition; (noun) a sudden, forceful expulsion of air from the lungs, often accompanied by a distinctive sound

synonym: hack, clear throat, wheeze

(1) cough several times, (2) persistent coughI can't stop coughing and think I might have caught a cold.

### improvisation

 the act of making something up on the spot or creating or performing something without preparation

*synonym*: spontaneity, ad-lib, extemporization

(1) improvisation on stage, (2) jazz improvisation

He created a beautiful piece of music using only improvisation.

#### resistance

n. the act of defending oneself from an aggressor or refusing to accept something

synonym: opposition, antagonism, defiance

(1) **resistance** movement, (2) **resistance** to insulin The bill to increase the consumption tax had passed despite much **resistance** from the public.

### anniversary

 n. the annual recurrence of a date marking a notable event; a date on which an event occurred in a previous year

synonym: commemoration, celebration, observance

(1) **anniversary** celebration, (2) a bicentennial **anniversary** They celebrated their 10th **anniversary** with a romantic dinner.

### plummet

 to fall or drop suddenly and steeply; to decline rapidly or sharply

synonym: drop, plunge, fall

(1) **plummeting** sales, (2) **plummet** against other major currencies

The stock prices have **plummeted** in the last hour, causing concern for investors.

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

### dramatically

adv. in a very impressive manner

*synonym*: greatly, noticeably, suddenly

(1) he confessed **dramatically**, (2) the cabin pressure fell **dramatically** 

Life expectancy has grown **dramatically** this century.

#### decline

v. to become gradually smaller, fewer, worse, etc.; to refuse to accept

synonym: descend, drop, deny

(1) **decline** a job offer, (2) **decline** in quality
As people age, their digestive capacity also gradually **declines**.

### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) develop a strategy, (2) develop a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

#### corona

 a crown-shaped structure, often referring to the outermost layer of the Sun's atmosphere; a family of viruses known as coronaviruses; a halo or aura around a celestial body; a circular pattern or shape

synonym: crown, halo, circle

(1) corona layer, (2) corona outbreak

The **corona** virus has caused a global pandemic.

### essentially

adv. relating to the essential features or concepts of anything synonym: fundamentally, basically, virtually

(1) **essentially** correct, (2) become **essentially** same **Essentially**, a society is an organism.

### pretension

 n. the act of claiming or asserting something, especially without good reason or without evidence; an unfounded or excessive claim or ambition

synonym: presumption, pretense, affectation

- (1) **pretension** to authority, (2) baseless **pretension**His **pretensions** of being a gourmet were quickly exposed when he could not identify basic herbs and spices.
- v. to successfully complete a task or goal, often through hard work, perseverance, and dedication; to attain or accomplish something that one has set out to do

synonym: accomplish, attain, reach
