### economy

### spur

 a thing that encourages someone to do something; any sharply pointed projection; (verb) to incite or stimulate someone or something

*synonym*: encouragement, motivation, stimulus

The threat of losing his job was the **spur** he needed to work harder.

### climate

n. the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

### recipe

### revolutionary

adj. relating to or characterized by a complete or dramatic change

synonym: radical, innovative, groundbreaking

### victory

 success in a game, competition, election, or battle, or the knowledge that you have won

synonym: win, triumph, success

### brutality

- n. the quality or state of being cruel or savagesynonym: cruelty, ferocity, savagery

### laissez-faire

 an economic theory advocating minimal government intervention in the economy, allowing market forces to regulate production, supply, and prices

synonym: hands-off, free

The **laissez-faire** economic policy allowed businesses to operate with minimal government intervention.

#### tremendous

adj. very great in degree or extent or amount or impact;extremely good

### ideological

adj. relating to or concerned with ideas and theories rather than practical matters

synonym: theoretical, abstract, philosophical

### dare

- v. to have the courage to do something
- synonym: challenge, risk, attempt

### radical

- synonym: extreme, revolutionary

### egalitarian

#### crush
