#### whisper

v. to speak very quietly to somebody using the breath rather than the voice so that only those close to you can hear you

synonym: murmur, rumor, mutter

(1) answer in a **whisper**, (2) the **whisper** of the leaves He took me aside and **whispered** in my ear.

#### shush

 to silence or quiet someone or something, particularly by making a "shh" or "hush" sound

synonym: silence, hush, quiet

(1) shush the baby, (2) shush the crowdI had to shush my chatty friend during the movie.

#### grandparent

- n. a parent of one's father or mother
- (1) great- **grandparent**, (2) person of **grandparent** age She was close to her paternal **grandparents** and often spent summers with them.

### jumble

synonym: mix, scramble, mess up

*synonym*: fudge, deform, contort

#### scatter

- v. to cause to separate and go in different directions synonym: disperse, spread, bestrew

#### reunite

 to bring two or more people together again after a period of separation

synonym: reconcile, reunify, reconvene

(1) **reunite** after five years, (2) **reunite** with my friend The band will **reunite** only for this show.

#### numb

adj. unable to feel physical sensation and movement; not showing human feeling or sensitivity

synonym: dazed, insensitive, emotionless

numb with cold, (2) a numb mind
 My left arm became numb.

#### quantify

- v. to express or measure something in numerical terms synonym: measure, express, determine
- (1) **quantify** the results, (2) **quantify** blood flow He tried to **quantify** the amount of product that was needed to complete the job.

#### heartbeat

 the regular movement or sound of the heart as it sends blood around the body; an animating or vital unifying force

*synonym*: beat, pulse, force
