industrious

the condition of being unable to sleep or having difficulty sleeping

synonym: insomnia, wakefulness, restlessness

spaceship

 n. (especially in science fiction) a spacecraft designed to carry a crew into interstellar space

synonym: starship, rocket, spacecraft

propellant

 a substance that provides the force to propel (= to cause something to move forwards) something, such as a rocket or spray can

synonym: fuel, driving force, impelling agent

The **propellant** in the rocket provided the force needed to reach outer space.

propel

intermediary
